### 听力部分录音稿

(Text 1)

21. D 细节理解题。根据 **Festival of Light, Longleat Safari Park, Wiltshire** 一节“Huge lanterns take the shape of some of the park's animals. . .”可知,在 Longleat Safari Park 可以欣赏动物造型的灯笼。

22. B 细节理解题。根据 **Enchanted Park, Gateshead** 一节“... walk through Saltwell Park... along a road of light with performances.”及“11 Dec. to 27 Dec.”可知,在 12 月 11 日至 12 月 27 日期间可前往 Saltwell Park 观赏表演。

23. C 细节理解题。根据 **Christmas at Kew Gardens, London** 一节“£16.00, adult/£10.00, child/under-fours, free.”可知,一对夫妇和一个三岁孩子去 Kew Gardens 参观灯光秀需支付 16+16=32 英镑。

24. C 推理判断题。根据第二段“When I was 13... because I was bored with everything... my mother didn't understand me.”可推知, Lucy 在 13 岁时生活过得不开心。

25. C 细节理解题。根据第三段“My friend encouraged me to learn music. . .”可知,最先将 Lucy 引上音乐之路的人是她的朋友。
26. A 推理判断题。根据第四段“During the next year, I practised my skills in dancing, singing and flexibility. . . To get what I wanted, I had that academy’s photos all over my room. . .”和最后一段“It was not surprising that I finally got the chance. . . as I believed everything was going to work out as long as I held on to my dream.”可推知,Lucy 的努力和决心让她最终获得成功。
27. B 细节理解题。根据第四段“During the next year, I practised my skills in dancing, singing and flexibility. . .”和最后一段“It was not surprising that I finally got the chance to live in the city of my dream and train in the academy of my dream. . .”可知,Lucy 的成功完全在她的意料之中。
28. D 细节理解题。根据第二段“The treatment is based on the TCM principle of *yin* and *yang*, which believes the balance of both elements(要素) in the body is important for good health.”可知,三伏贴的治疗原理是保持阴阳平衡。
29. C 推理判断题。根据第三段“As the weather in Changsha. . . is hot with heavy rainfall in summer, people there eat chicken especially a rooster. . . believe that the rooster is ‘*yang*’ and can clear the damp(湿气). There is an old saying that goes ‘A rooster at the start of *sanfu*, a healthy body the whole year.’”可推知,这个谚语的引用是为了证明在三伏天吃公鸡有利于身体健康。
30. B 细节理解题。根据第四段“The second stage of *sanfu* is called *zhongfu*, which traditionally is a time for eating noodles because it is believed to help people sweat and remove internal heat.”可知,中伏吃面条是为了把身体内的热量释放出来。
31. A 标题判断题。全文介绍了中国人在三伏天贴三伏贴,并在不同的时间吃不同的食物,因此最佳标题是:三伏的习俗。
32. A 细节理解题。根据第一段“That’s faster than a cheetah, the fastest animal on land.”可知,这里提到猎豹是为了说明飓风的速度快。
33. C 词义猜测题。根据画线词前“... causing a huge economic loss. . .”和画线词后内容可推知,画线词词义与 Destroyed 接近。
34. A 推理判断题。根据第一段“Ranking(排名) the most. . . usually, economic cost or lives lost.”和第二段“Katrina was the most expensive hurricane of all time. . . The cost was over \$186 billion. . . Katrina’s losses swallowed 1% of the US GDP. . .”可推知,第二段用数据来证明为什么飓风 Katrina 位于榜首。
35. D 推理判断题。根据第一段“Ranking(排名) the most. . . usually, economic cost or lives lost.”和最后一段“Developing countries also suffered a lot from hurricanes.”可推知,接下来的文章最有可能要介绍的是在发展中国家飓风带来的损失。
36. E 根据空前“Everyone has bad days.”可知,E 项“即使是最乐观的人有时也会经历悲伤和愤怒”符合。
37. B 根据空后“It could be something as simple as a beautiful, sunny day or a small gift received from your friend.”可知,B 项“它们不必是特别的或伟大的东西”符合。
38. A 根据空后“Even if you’re not feeling happy, forcing yourself to smile can actually make you feel better.”可知,A 项“你可以练习微笑”符合。
39. F 根据空前“Whether visiting your favorite bookstore or enjoying a cup of coffee with your friends, make sure to find something to look forward to each day.”可知,F 项“这将帮助你保持积极的态度,即使事情不是按照你想的方式发展的”符合。
40. G 根据空前“You can use positive self-talk.”可知,G 项“你對自己说的话会影响你對自己的看法”符合。
