31. A 推理判断题。根据全文,如第二段中的“‘He analyses exactly what goes on in our heads when we make split-second decisions and compares this to the thought processes involved when we take longer to come to a decision’”可知答案。
32. B 细节理解题。根据第三段中的“... and told *the Financial Times* newspaper it was even faster in Germany, where wages rose by 7.1 percent. Wage growth in France was 4.7 percent, in Ireland it was 4 percent, and in Italy and Spain it was 3.9 percent. In the Netherlands it stood at 3.8 percent”可得答案。
