**21.C** 细节理解题,题干问:哪些学生可将 IC 卡作饭卡使用?原文第一个小标题下对此进行了具体说明: The degree-program students, including the **undergraduate and graduate students**, shall apply for a student IC card which can be used as the dining card, 由此选择答案 C. Undergraduate students.

**22.B** 细节理解题,题干问:学生在哪可以找到充值机给 IC 卡充值?原文第二个小标题下对此进行了具体说明: The recharging machines are located **around Taoliyuan Dining Hall, Zijingyuan Dining Hall, Guanchouyuan Dining Hall**, teaching building No. 6 as well as the Student Service Center, 由此选择答案 B. Around Guanchouyuan Dining Hall.

**23.C** 细节理解题。题干问:如果有人想吃披萨,下列哪一个是最优的用餐时间建议?原文图表中对各个餐厅的用餐时间进行了说明,找到 Qingqing Pizza 一栏,锁定时间 10:30-20:30,通过对比得出选项 C.18:00—19:00 在披萨店的用餐时间内,故选 C。

**24.D** 推理判断题。题干问:作者家的墙壁为什么变成了黑色?文章在第一段第三句话中说到家中墙壁起初是灰的后来变黑了 At first they were grey, then turning black,紧接着在其后解释到他父亲在家制作木炭 He made charcoal in our house, 并在这段末尾强调 it's a very dirty business 这不是件干净活儿,由此可推断是父亲在家制碳把墙壁弄脏了,故选 D。

**25.A** 细节理解题。题干询问关于 Graciela 的信息, Graciela 出现在第三段末尾和第四段。

27.D 推理判断题，考查学生对文章的整体理解，从而进行深层含义的领悟和推断。

A 选项 In time of test, family is best. 直译为在面对考验时，家人才是最好的；意译为患难见真情，强调经历磨难时家人陪在身边的可贵。文中虽提到父母亲的辛苦，但同时也描述了作者本人不向命运低头、努力实现理想的决心和毅力，更关键的是全文的文眼在于文章后半部分的四个 they don't know

“they don't know the journey.

They don't know about ...

They don't know about ...

They don't know about ...”

这四个反复的句型表现出作者迫切地希望大家知道他作为世界杯冠军队运动员成长的艰辛，渴望大家了解到成功背后的不易，而非单一地停留在亲情层面。

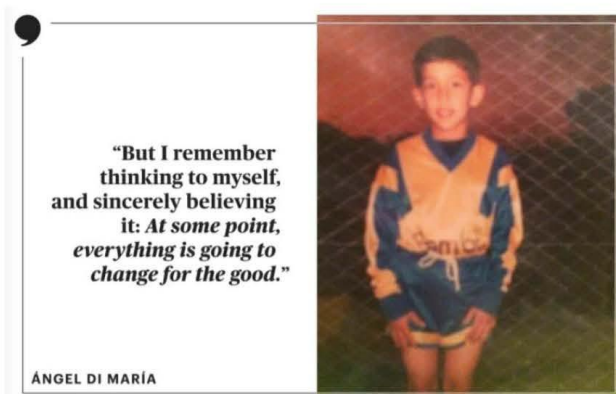

28. C 细节理解题，题干问到研究者们发明纸电池的目的，通过关键词定位到文章第二段最后一句话 They developed the paper battery aiming to reduce the environmental impact of single-use electronics by turning to more environmentally friendly materials 他们开发纸电池，旨在通过转向（使用）更环保的材料来减少一次性电子产品对环境的影响，故选 C。

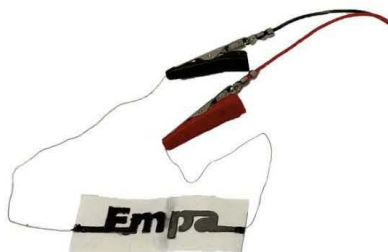
29. A 细节理解题，题干问：研究者们如何增长纸电池的电力？文章第二段详细描述了研究者们对纸电池性能的检测分析。纸电池由两种含有不同矿物质的墨水作正负极。在检测中，研究人员往纸电池上滴两滴水，20秒内，纸电池开始工作。一小时后，随着纸变干，缺少水导电，纸电池的电力明显下降。此时研究者们又加了两滴水，使纸再次湿润，纸电池的电力又延续了一小时。故选 A。

30. D 细节理解题，题干问到 Gustav Nyström 口中研究人员们的下一步计划，通过关键词定位到第四段的最后两句话...EMPA's Gustav Nyström, the inventor. He told TIME magazine they wanted to improve the efficiency of the battery in the future and get it working for longer, 故选 D。

31. B 主旨大意题，考查学生对文章整体意义的把握。本文为新闻报道，文章第一段就介绍了纸电池入选时代周刊年度最佳发明，并在最后一段再次提到年度发明的评选，故选 B。

### Passage D

[语篇解读] 本文是一篇科普说明文，主题语境是人与自然——自然生态，主题语境内容为冻

成冰块冬眠的木蛙。这种具有超强耐冻能力的动物在冬眠时甚至连呼吸、心跳都停止了，看起来就像被冻死了，但一到春天，它们也会像其他冬眠动物一样苏醒过来。木蛙这种冬眠的方式的确对人类很有启发，比如在医学上应用于对人体器官的低温保存，让病人可以顺利进行器官移植，从而有更大几率存活下来。大自然无时无刻不在给人类以启迪，本文引导学生培养对自然生态的敬畏与好奇，重视对自然生态的探索和保护。

**32. C** 推理判断题，题干问到作者的大学老师为什么带只青蛙去上课。根据关键词定位到第一段可知，该教师将一直冻硬的木蛙带到课堂，并假意将木蛙摔碎，实际摔出时已将木蛙换成了冰块，借此来向同学们展示木蛙过冬时确实将自己冻得像冰块一样硬。通过文章，可了解到教授是想讲授关于木蛙的知识，所以选 C。

**33. B** 猜测词义题，考查学生根据上下文推测单词的含义的能力。解答此题需先弄清划线词 *thaws* 前的代词 *it* 指代什么，据上文可知 *it* 指代的是结冰冬眠的木蛙，故选 B，指木蛙过完冬后在春天苏醒。

**34. D** 细节理解题，题干问：是什么使木蛙结冰却不至冻死？通过关键词回到文章第二段最后一句话 *the frog's liver pumps out incredible amounts of glucose—a sugary liquid that acts like antifreeze for vital organs—that flows everywhere including the insides of cells to keep them from dying*，木蛙的肝脏会泵出数量惊人的葡萄糖——一种糖状液体，对重要器官起到防冻作用——渗入各处，包括细胞内部，以防止细胞死亡，故选 D。**35. A** 推理判断题，题干问到据 Shannon Tessier 所说，谁将有可能从木蛙的生存原理中受益。根据关键词定位到最后一段引号部分 *So we're trying to use the principles from wood frogs with high amounts of glucose and freeze a whole heart or other organ, keep it in suspended animation, safely awake it, and transplant it* 因此我们正试图利用木蛙借大量葡萄糖过冬的原理，冷冻整个心脏或其他器官，使其处于假死状态，安全地复活并移植，可知 Shannon Tessier 准备将木蛙原理运用到器官移植的技术中，故选 A。

答案与解析：

36. C 承接下文。设空后半句话为 “which was confirmed in a study of Pediatric Obesity.” 直译为 “这在一项关于儿童肥胖的研究中得到了证实。” 因而此处应该填写半句话且是实验结论。因而正确选项为 C，直译为 “欺凌可能会产生持续的后果。”

37. G 承接上文。设空上句话为 “To assess the link between teasing and weight gain, the authors recruited 110 children and young teens who were either overweight themselves or who had two parents with overweight.” 直译为 “为了评估取笑和体重增加之间的联系，作者招募了 110 名儿童和青少年，他们要么自己超重，要么父母都超重。” 讲述的是研究对象的特点。各选项应当描述相关特点。因而正确选项为 G，直译为 “超重的父母使孩子面临超重风险” 来解释选择此研究对象的原因。

38. B 承上启下。设空上句话为 “Among participants with overweight, 62% reported they had been teased at least once, while 21% of straight-size, at-risk participants

reported they had been.”直译为“在超重的参与者中，62%的人表示自己至少被戏弄过一次，而在身材笔直、有风险的参与者中有21%的人表示曾经被戏弄过”；设空下句话为“Whether they had overweight at the study’s start or not, those who reported being teased often for their weight gained 33% more body mass, on average, and 91% more fat per year than their peers who weren’t teased.”直译为“无论他们在研究开始时是否超重，那些经常因体重而被取笑的人平均每年比没有被取笑的同龄人多增33%的体重，多增91%的脂肪。”前后都提到了实验的具体细节。所以此处选项是关于实验的具体细节。正确选项为B，直译为“研究人员随访了约8.5年。”

39.F承接下文。设空下句话为“*But we can say weight-based teasing was significantly linked with weight gain over time,*” she says.”直译为“但我们可以说，基于体重的嘲讽与随着时间的推移体重增加有着显著的联系，”她说。”是对实验结论的描述。所以正确选项F，直译为“研究表明，戏弄可能会增加体重。”下文是对上文的补充解释。

40.D主旨大意题。设空应为本段话的概括。设空后两句的语义为“嘲笑也会导致应激激素皮质醇水平升高，这会刺激食欲，并增加抑郁和焦虑的风险，这两者都会导致饮食紊乱。这也可能会让孩子们远离体育活动，比如体育课和健身课，在那里他们可能会因为自己的体型而被取笑。”正确选项D直译为“其他人表现出羞耻感可能会导致过度进食。”

41题：考察名词。选C。下文提到The year before, Carl had lost his job, and now our 42 situation was serious, so we had finally put our home on the 43.可以推断出，作者家庭出现经济危机，需要将房子卖掉。

42题：考察名词。选D。上文提到The year before, Carl had lost his job 可以推断出，作者家庭出现经济危机，另外从上下文卖自家房子也能推断出。

43题：考察名词。选A。上文提到The year before, Carl had lost his job 可以推断出，作者家庭出现经济危机；上文My husband, Carl, had just cleaned up the pool in preparation for selling our 41.可以推断出，需要将房子卖掉，即“放到市场上”。

44题：考察名词。选B。B作者家庭出现经济危机，需要将房子卖掉。卖房换钱这件事令作者很难过，难过到绝望。

45题：考察动词。选C。从下文可知，孩子落水，因此狗在喊叫示警。

46题：考察动词。选D。上文提到Nana, began 45 violently and running back and forth, overlooking our pool, 狗在嚎叫，作者跑去看发什了什么。

47题：考察动词短语。选A。上文提到作者跑去看发什了什么，令作者惊恐的是，她看见(caught sight of) 孩子的黄色睡衣在水池里。

48题：考察副词。选A。作者的两条狗，一只在示警，另一只在水池中抢救作者的孩子，可以看出狗的勇敢。干扰项fiercely 英文释义为violently and angrily...情感色彩并不合适。

49题：考察形容词。选C。孩子对于父母来说是宝贵的(precious)。

50题：考察名词。选D。上文提到，I realized Forrest wasn’t breathing, 孩子没了呼吸，作者感到震撼。此处考察shock的用法，例如：The news of his mother's death was a terrible shock to

him. 他母亲去世的噩耗使他非常震惊。

51 题：考察动词短语。选 B。作者陷入震惊，幸亏丈夫及时赶到，接手（take over）对孩子的急救。

52 题：考察名词。选 A。孩子没了呼吸，丈夫正在抢救，此时作者应当十分担忧。短语 one's heart was in one's mouth (throat) 可以译为某人的心提到了嗓子眼了，符合此处作者的心理感受。

53 题：考察动词。选 A。上文中提到 I realized Forrest wasn't breathing, 作者的丈夫曾经接受过 CPR 训练 (Carl, who was trained in CPR), 将孩子抢救了回来，孩子重新有了呼吸。

54 题：考察动词。选 C。上文提到 The thought of losing our beautiful home was almost more than I could bear. 可以看出作者对于卖房这件事十分难过。此处 almost losing Forrest—and then getting him back— 54 any despair I might have had about losing our home 可译为，孩子的“失而复得”、家人平安的经历，让作者感悟到家人团圆是人间幸事，这种想法减轻了作者的难过。本题 erase 用法比较灵活，再如：She couldn't erase the incident from her memory. 她难以忘却那次事故。

55 题：考察名词。选 D。孩子不慎落水，幸得家中爱犬相救，孩子的“失而复得”。这次经历，让绝望中的作者感悟到家人安康，是人生幸事 (blessing: thing that one is glad of; thing that brings happiness, 例如 What a blessing you weren't hurt in the accident! 你在这次事故中没有受伤，真是幸运!)。

#### 语法填空

[语篇解读] 主题语境为“人与社会-艺术”，介绍了海南国际电影节，体现了中国影视国际影响力。

The fourth Hainan Island International Film Festival opened Sunday in Sanya, a resort city in South China's Hainan province.

This year's film festival features 3,761 films from 116 countries and regions for the Golden Coconut Awards, with over 80 percent of the films from overseas, said the organizing committee.

Eighty to 100 films are expected to be screened during the festival scheduled from Dec 18 to Dec 25, and nine forums will also take place.

Zhang Jun, secretary-general of the event organizing committee, said the festival is committed to strengthening international film cultural exchanges and cooperation, promoting the development of the film industry, and fostering the prosperity of film creation.

A total of 11 feature films, eight documentaries, and ten short films were nominated to compete for the various categories under Golden Coconut Awards this year, Zhang added.

First held in 2018, the film festival is jointly hosted by the China Media Group and the Hainan provincial government. This year's festival will end on Dec 25.

Text 10 世界上最大的冰屋咖啡馆

W: A hotel in India has created the largest igloo cafe in the world, but it won't be around for long. The cafe is made of snow and ice. It's expected to melt in March. ⑪Mr. Shah, who created the cafe, got the idea from an igloo village he'd seen in Switzerland. Last year's igloo cafe could hold about 16 people. This year, the hotel decided to go for something bigger. ⑫They began to work in early December and didn't finish until two months later. It has 10 tables and can hold up to 40 people at a time. The benches and tables are all made out of packed snow. Sheep skins cover the icy benches to make them more comfortable. It is separated into two different sections. One part holds artwork made out of snow and ice. The other part is a working cafe, selling coffee, hot chocolate, and snacks. ⑬The hotel manager says the cafe focuses on items that can be served quickly, since it's so cold in the igloo that most guests don't want to stay too long. There are between 300 and 400 visitors every day. Mr. Shah has big plans for the future. Next year he plans to rebuild the cafe. He also wants to create an igloo village, with rooms where people can spend the night.
