【详解】

1. 段落续写：

①由第一段首句内容“这一天不是在自怜中度过的，而是非常快乐”可知，第一段可描写当

Jayce 在遇见 Trashaun 之后激动的表情，然后 Trashaun 十分感动并和 Jayce 进行交流互动，甚至还送了一件球衣给他。

②由第二段首句内容“Trashaun 盯着他送给 Jayce 的球衣，开始谈论他们的左臂”。可知，第二段可描写两个孩子就自己的手臂进行交流。Trashaun 鼓励 Jayce 勇于面对自己的缺陷，相信自己。
