21. 根据第一段的 Seconds later, our lizard emerged from its tank with its old skin flowing behind it. (几秒钟后，我们的蜥蜴从水箱里钻了出来，它的旧皮肤在它身后流动)可知，旧的皮肤脱落了。故选 B。

22. 根据第六段的内容“在我丈夫参加另一个工作面试回家的两个小时前，我女儿爬上去从一个高高的架子上拿了一个玻璃花瓶。它掉下来，摔在蛋糕旁边。到处都是小玻璃碎片。我把蛋糕扔掉时，她大声抽泣。我丈夫生日时吃了香蕉布丁。”可知，作者的丈夫过生日吃了香蕉布丁是因为生日蛋糕毁了。故选 A。

23. 根据倒数第三段的内容“乔丹从他热爱的篮球退役去打棒球的辛楚，是什么促使他做出如此艰难的决定，这让我很惊讶。当我看着他脱下篮球服，换上棒球服时，我看到他留下了那层不再适合他的衣服，就像我们的蜥蜴一样。他们谁也没有选择改变他们的那个时刻。但在一切都变了之后，他们不得不接受原来的自己。就像我们一样。我意识到我们必须学会把过去抛在脑后。”以及最后一段内容“乔丹说，无论结局如何，都要从希望开始。我们拥有柔嫩、充满希望的皮肤，这就是我们开始的地方。”可推知，作者在文章中提到《最后的舞蹈》是为了展开文章关于放手过去，重新开始的主题。故选 C。

【文章大意】文章是一篇说明文，旨在告诉读者催眠在医学成像程序中的应用在医疗过程中的作用。

24. 根据原文第一段中 The project also resulted in a reduction in the amount of medicines used to perform medical-imaging(医学影像) procedures. (该项目还减少了用于执行医学影像程序的药物数量) B 选项 (某种药物的减少使用) 符合题意。故选 B。

25. 根据原文第四段 A French medical-imaging technologist—also a hypnotist—was invited to train a few members in the medical-imaging department of the children's hospital. (法国医学影像技师——也是催眠师——应邀在儿童医院医学影像科培训了几名成员。)可知这位法国技术专家来到了儿童医院是为了进行催眠训练。故选 B。

26. 根据原文第五段 The technologist will guide the patient to this modified state—an imaginary world that will disassociate itself more and more from the procedure that follows. (技术人员将引导患者进入这种改变的状态——一个虚构的世界，它将越来越多地与随后的过程失去联系。) D 选项 (导致病人的意识远离现实) 符合题意，故选 D。

27. 根据原文第六段 "The technologist must build up a story with the patient," Ms. L'Ecuyer said.

(“技术人员必须与病人建立一个故事,” L'Ecuyer 女士说。)可知整个过程中医生和病人应该是同步的。A 选项 (它应该跟进相关的医疗成像程序), 故选 A。

【文章大意】本文介绍了作者从中国搬到美国之后, 因为“尊老”的观念和中美文化差异的不同, 导致工作中产生了一些误会, 之后作者改变了自己对待老人的方式。

28. 根据第二段中的 I told her that I had made sure they got their food quickly because I always respect the elderly. (我告诉她我已经确保他们会很快得到食物, 因为我总是尊重老人。)可知, 故选 B。

29. 根据第二段中的 I told her that I had made sure they got their food quickly because I always respect the elderly. As soon as I said that, her face showed great displeasure. (我告诉她, 我确保他们能很快拿到食物, 因为我一向尊重老年人。我刚说完, 她的脸上就露出非常不高兴的表情。)可知, 听到 Jack 称他们为老人时, 他们一点也不高兴。故选 C。

30. 根据第三段中的 In my village in China, people are proud of being old. (在我的中国家乡, 人们以老为自豪。)可知, 故选 B。

31. 根据最后一段中的 After that, I changed the way I had been with older people. (从那之后, 我改变了对待老年人的方式。)可知, 故选 D。

32. C. 细节理解题。根据文章第一段

"the example the parent wants him to follow is ignored while he takes over contrary patterns from some other example" 父母希望他效仿却被他忽视因为他从其他一些例子接管了相反的模式, 可知后面是解决办法, 即让孩子模仿父母让他做的; 故选 C。

33. A. 推理判断题。根据文章第三段

"One of the early things the child learns is that he gets more affection and approval when his parents like his response", 最早的事情, 孩子学习是他得到更多的爱和认可当他的父母喜欢他的反应; 可知第一元素是需要找到一个方法来达到预期的目标; 故选 A。

34. D. 细节理解题。根据文章第三段

"the desire to solve any objective situation is overlaid with the desire to solve it properly", 想要解决任何客观情况应该被妥善解决的渴望覆盖, 因此孩子应学会合理表现; 故选 D.

35. B . 推理判断题。根据文章第四段

"the learner does not choose models at random. He imitates the person who seems a good person to be like", 学习者不是随机选择模型的。他模仿的是一个很好的人是怎样的, 可推测孩子们模仿的是他们喜欢的人; 故选 B.
