21.B 细节理解题。根据文中的“All entries are to be submitted electronically. Web form will be made available beginning February 1, 2023.”可知，参赛作品应该通过网络提交。

22.D 细节理解题。根据文中的“Each art entry must also include a short explanation (3-5 sentences) as to why saving your chosen species from extinction is important.”可知，参赛作品中，要包含简单叙述为什么保护你选择的这个物种。

23.A 细节理解题。根据文中的“An adopt-an-animal package of your choice”可知选A。

【解题导语】本文是一篇记叙文。主要介绍了作者的儿子 Joe 要参加学校的实地考察旅行，但是这次不希望作者再次充当监护人陪他一起去，作者明白了儿子日渐长大，变得更加独立了。

24.D 细节理解题。根据第三段中的“What was surprising was how much I minded being so impolitely removed from the short list of willing chaperones by my own son.”可知，作者对于自己被无礼地从监护人的名单上去掉非常的在意。

- 25.A 细节理解题。根据第六段中的“He doesn't want to go to Norway without you.”可知,当时 Joe 对于母亲没有陪他去挪威,感到不高兴。
- 26.B 词义猜测题。根据划线词前面的内容,儿子即将进入到青少年时期,青春期的孩子不再凡事听父母的话,作者夫妇为此作准备,再结合划线词后面的内容,某人穿着高跟鞋即将爬上冰雪覆盖的高山时的那种紧张不安的心情,可推知选 B。
- 27.C 推理判断题。根据最后一段内容可知,作者明白儿子日渐长大,变得更加独立了。
【解题导语】本文是一篇说明文。主要介绍了现在人工智能,尤其是 ChatGPT 的语言模型,能够像人类一样写作,以及人们对此不同的看法等。
- 28.A 推理判断题。第一段介绍了 ChatGPT 这种语言模型可以根据用户提供的简单提示,能够以著名作家的风格创作新故事,撰写关于自己的新闻文章,并撰写论文等,由此说明了它的功能和作用。
- 29.B 细节理解题。根据第三段内容可知,ChatGPT 写出来的是它自己原创的东西。
- 30.C 推理判断题。根据第五段内容可推知, Peter 认为使用人工智能使得我们失去了学习过程中所带来的乐趣。
- 31.A 推理判断题。根据最后一段内容可推知,他对于使用人工智能技术是支持的,乐意见到 ChatGPT 的发布。
【解题导语】本文是一篇说明文。网上旧货店 thredUP 发布了第十份年度转售报告,评估了二手服装行业的趋势,表明转售在美国和全球都在蓬勃发展。
- 32.A 细节理解题。根据第二段内容可知,这对购物者来说意味着减少开支。
- 33.A 细节理解题。根据第三段中的“*As resale becomes more accessible thanks to mobile technology and online platforms, increasing numbers of customers are keen to turn over their closets, which fuels the industry and keeps the market full of fresh finds, bringing people back for more.*”可知,科技发展使转售变得越来越方便和容易。
- 34.D 推理判断题。根据最后一段内容可推知,作者对于二手服装的销售是赞同的。
- 35.D 标题归纳题。文章由第一段内容进行展开,判断“二手服装是一个热门市场”最适合作为文章标题。
【解题导语】本文是一篇说明文。主要介绍了几个通过改变自己的习惯,从而实现快乐的具体做法。
- 36.B 根据空格下面的内容可知,人们喜欢自己的生活,不愿意尝试新事物,因此说明这是一个人的舒适区,而作者建议人们要脱离舒适区,寻找快乐,因此与 B 的意义呼应。
- 37.A 根据空格后面的内容可知,这些都是些小事,因此与 A 的意义一致。
- 38.G 根据空格前面的“*Hobbies often have the added bonus of building and strengthening relationships with others*”可知,爱好往往具有建立和加强与他人关系的额外好处,其中的 hobbies 与 G 项的 doing something you enjoy 所指的事实一致。
- 39.F 根据本段的小标题“**Unplug from social media**”可知,与社交媒体隔绝,因此与 F 的意义呼应。
- 40.C 根据本段的小标题“**Give back to others**”可知,是回馈他人,与 C 项的意义呼应。
【解题导语】本文是一篇记叙文。主要介绍了平时依靠轮椅的残疾人 Brittany McCormick 通过走路为残疾儿童募捐的故事。
- 41.A 根据下文描述可知, Brittany McCormick 不仅学会了走路,还通过走路为残疾儿童募捐。
- 42.A 根据下文“*I 48 I'd walk 100 km to raise funds for kids with disabilities*”可知,作为一个年轻的青少年,她想为社会做出贡献。
- 43.B 根据上下文可知,她想为社会做贡献的机会出现了。
- 44.C 根据下文“*she was without it for two weeks*”可知,她有两星期没有使用轮椅,推测她的轮椅去维修了。
- 45.D 根据上文“*when her wheelchair needed 44 and she was without it for two weeks*”可知,由于没有轮椅使用,她感到很无助。
- 46.A 根据下文“*it must be for people who can't 47 wheelchairs*”可知,从自己没有轮椅使用的经历,她想到了那些买不起轮椅的残疾人的生活之艰难。
- 47.B 根据下文可知,她给残疾儿童筹集资金,说明有些人是买不起轮椅的。
- 48.C Brittany McCormick 决定要通过走路为残疾儿童募捐。
- 49.D 根据下文“*set herself the target of walking 100 km in six months and to raise R80,000 for the school*”可知,她最初给自己设立的目标是在六个月内步行 100 公里,并为残疾儿童筹集 80 万卢比。
- 50.A 根据下文 117.77 km 可知,她已经打破了她的 100 公里目标。
- 51.D 除了为残疾儿童筹集资金外, Brittany McCormick 还在学校和公司担任励志演说家。
- 52.C Brittany McCormick 演讲时,说的是能力,而不是残疾。
- 53.C Brittany McCormick 的故事告诉人们他们的内在能力是什么,以及他们认为自己可以是什么。
- 54.B 对残疾儿童来说,重要的是要知道,无论怎样,他们都可以用自己的生活做些什么,并有所作为。
- 55.D 这可能需要几年时间,但他们最终会实现。

【解题导语】本文是一篇说明文。主要介绍了作为一项非物质文化遗产的胶南年画，随着时代的发展，人们把非物质文化遗产与人们的日常生活结合起来，创新年画艺术的情况。

56. who/that 考查定语从句。先行词是 visitors，在从句中作主语，故填 who/that。
57. have included 考查时态。结合前面的时间状语 in recent years 可知，此处表示动作已经完成，使用现在完成时。
58. an 考查冠词。后面的 instant 是一个以元音音素开头的单词，故填 an。
59. to create 考查动词不定式。此处是动词不定式作目的状语。
60. making 考查非谓语动词。分析句子的结构和意义，此处是非谓语动词作结果状语。
61. between 考查介词。between...and，固定搭配。
62. truly 考查副词。此处修饰后面的动词，使用副词作状语。
63. combined 考查非谓语动词。分析句子结构，前面省略了 it is，其中 it 和 combine 构成被动关系，表示被动意义。
64. were 考查时态。由时间状语 in the past 可知，用一般过去式，且主语 patterns of feather and flowers 是复数。
65. images 考查名词复数。这里说的是众多不同的形象，应使用复数名词。
