More than 150 artists and other creatives live in the area; their galleries line historic Main Street in the creative district. Book lovers, take note: This area was home to the late Western author, Louis L'Amour.

Jason Ahn's favorite parts of Marvel's Iron Man movies are scenes showing inventions being developed. Many of these scenes are similar to the experiences he went through himself before winning national recognition for an innovative classroom whiteboard design.

For Ahn, 17, a rising senior at Ames High School in Iowa in the US, there was a good month's worth of nights staying up until 4 am—before going to school the next day—during which he first gained the idea for an auto rolling and erasing whiteboard, or ARE Board. He then submitted it to the Raytheon Technologies Invention Convention US Nationals.

All that work paid off for Ahn in 2022 when he was among inventors from across the country to win awards at the competition.

In his advanced placement physics class—and throughout most of his time in school—he noticed his teachers struggle with having to write and erase the same notes for each of their classes; that was if they could even reach the top of their traditional whiteboards. However, electronic whiteboards are too expensive.

He made a working prototype (原型) of a whiteboard on a motorized conveyor belt system that can be scrolled (滚动) up and down. It is more time and space efficient than a traditional whiteboard. He wanted to make something similar to an electronic whiteboard but far cheaper and easy to use.

"I've seen my friends kind of joking, 'Isn't this kind of a step backward? We've evolved all the way to electronic whiteboards'." Ahn said.

"In some cases, it's good to keep the traditional aspects and characteristics of some fundamental tools," because markers and erasers are more tangible (有形的) and accessible to people, he added.

Separation, money troubles, and transitional (过渡的) adjustments are all stressful events to the members of a family. Learning effective skills is key to solving the disagreements.

Schedule a time to talk as a group. When working together, you are more likely to solve family differences. 36 . Then, once tempers are cooled, everyone needs to plan to come together and think out a solution to the problem.

Focus on the issue at hand. When disagreements occur, people tend to bring up any and every unresolved issue they have ever faced with the other parties. This blurs (使模糊) the point of the discussion. Try to uncover what is important about the current problem. 37 .

Have everyone state what they truly mean. Direct communication is essential to effective conflict resolution. 38 . Such "I" statements allow everyone to express themselves while they show respect for other's listening.

39 . Let another know you recognize, value, and accept his thoughts, opinions, or beliefs. Of course, your own opinions may differ greatly, but using validation (确认) demonstrates that you see the other as a human, worthy of respect. Validate your family members by saying something like "I'm really glad that you feel comfortable enough to share this with me" or "I appreciate your willingness to work towards a solution".

Decide on a solution together. Once everyone has shared their needs, wants, and concerns, consider all the suggestions that each party has provided and look for a middle ground. 40 . If necessary, develop a contract or written agreement.

Acting was, is and always will be the first love of the National Peking Opera Company's new vice-president, Tian Lei, Chen Nan reports.

Hyguosi Street was one of Beijing's busiest commercial roads in the olden days. It also was (house) the residence of Peking Opera master Mei Lanfang (1894-1961). Not far from Mei's address, the first theater for Peking Opera was built in 1954, five years after the founding of the People's Republic of China.

The neighborhood has (change) over the decades, but the theater still stands tall and is now (current) managed by the National Peking Opera Company. Tian Lei treasure the hours he spends there, training and rehearsing (排练). Costume-clad and armed (arm) with a prop spear (道具长矛), the 42-year-old walks confidently across the stage, practicing (practice) variety of martial art movements, before ending the drill with a liangxiang (striking a pose on the stage).

Tian has been working with the opera company for 10 years. Its premises (处所) are a 10-minute drive from the theater and his colleagues train there. He, however, prefers the quiet (history) stage. "I come to the theater almost every day. I enjoy the peace and emptiness this building offers. Rehearsing here helps me feel closer to the Peking Opera masters who once graced the stage," he says.
