- 24. B 【解析】作出判断推理。根据第二段的"In general, beach sand is not suitable for sand sculpting, because its grains have rounded due to tidal wash and wind, and it contains no clay. (一般来说,沙滩沙不适合沙雕,因为它的颗粒因潮汐冲刷和风而变圆,而且不含黏土。)"可知,沙滩沙不能很好地结合在一起。故选B项。

When the phone is not being used, the cover screen, which is sizable enough to function as a standalone smartphone, can be employed instead.
