评分原则

各档次的给分范围和要求

第五档 (13-15 分)

完全完成了试题规定的任务。

—覆盖所有内容要点。

—应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。

—语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误，但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致；具备较强的语言运用能力。

—有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使全文结构紧凑。

完全达到了预期的写作目的。

第四档 (10-12 分)

完成了试题规定的任务。

—虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点，但覆盖所有主要内容。

—应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

—语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确，些许错误主要是尝试使用较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。

—应用简单的语句间的连接成分，使全文结构紧凑。

达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档 (7-9 分)

基本完成了试题规定的任务。

—虽漏掉一些内容，但覆盖所有主要内容。

—应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

—有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误，但不影响理解。

—应用简单的语句间的连接成分，使全文内容连贯。

整体而言，基本达到了预期的写作目的。

第二档 (4-6 分)

未恰当完成试题规定的任务。

—漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容，写了一些无关内容。

—语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。

—有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响了对写作内容的理解。

—较少使用语句间的连接成分，内容缺少连贯性。

信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

第一档 (1-3 分)

未完成试题规定的任务。

- 明显遗漏主要内容，写了一些无关内容，原因可能是未理解试题要求。
- 语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。
- 较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响对写作内容的理解。
- 缺乏语句间的连接成分，内容不连贯。
信息未能传达给读者。

0分

- 未能传达给读者任何信息；
- 内容太少，无法评判；
- 写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。

第二节：读后续写

评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分，按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量，确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 所续写短文的词数应为 150 左右（词数少于 130 的，从总分中减去 2 分）。
4. 阅卷评分时，主要从以下四个方面考虑：
 - （1）与所给短文及段落开头语的衔接程度；
 - （2）内容的丰富性；
 - （3）应用语法结构和词汇的丰富性和准确性；
 - （4）故事发展的合理性和上下文的连贯性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面。评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
6. 如书写较差以致影响交际，可将分数降低一个档次。

各档次给分范围及要求

第五档（21-25分）

- 与所给短文融洽度高，与所提供各段落开头语衔接合理；
- 所使用语法结构和词汇丰富、准确，可能有些许错误，但完全不影响意义表达；
- 有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使所续写短文结构紧凑。

第四档（16-20分）

- 与所给短文融洽度较高，与所提供各段落开头语衔接较为合理；
- 所使用语法结构和词汇较为丰富、准确，可能有些许错误，但完全不影响意义表达；
- 比较有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使所续写短文结构紧凑。

第三档（11-15分）

- 与所给短文关系较为密切，与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接；

—应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求，虽有一些错误，但不影响意义的表达；

—应用简单的语句间的连接成分，使全文内容连贯。

第二档（6-10分）

—与所给短文有一定的关系，与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接；

—语法结构单调、词汇项目有限，有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误，影响了意义的表达；

—较少使用语句间的连接成分，全文内容缺少连贯性。

第一档（1-5分）

—与所给短文和开头语的衔接较差；

—语法结构单调、词汇项目很有限，有较多语法结构和词汇方面的错误，严重影响了意义的表达；

—缺乏语句间的连接成分，全文内容不连贯。
