A篇:本文是一篇应用文。文章主要介绍了几个现代雕塑作品。

21. B 【解析】细节理解题。根据第一个作品的简介可知,这位艺术家的作品探索了童年记忆和丧失的主题。对他来说,蜘蛛让人联想到一位母亲的形象。

22. A 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二个作品的简介可知,Smith将多面体结合在一起,创造了五个独立但相关的物体,刻意避免了他早期作品中宏大而写实的手法。由此可知,这个作品不是一个写实的作品。

23. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据这几个作品的创作年份可知,Barry Flanagan的作品 *Thinker on a Rock* 是在1997被创造的,出现得最晚。

B篇:本文是一篇记叙文。自我学习伴随人的终生。Evelyn Uba 经过十多年的坚持与努力,终于通过了当地的法律考试。

24. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据文章第二段可知,Evelyn Uba 的父亲生病,她的律师梦不得不被推迟。由此推断,她是因为家庭经济困难而辍学。

25. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第一段倒数第二句可知,尽管她每次考试都失败了,但她从未放弃,因为她在父亲去世前几年对自己和父亲做出了承诺:要成为一名律师。

26. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据上下文可知,Evelyn Uba 经过十多年的坚持与努力,终于梦想成真。

27. A 【解析】推理判断题。文章通过 Evelyn Uba 的坚持向读者传达一个道理:坚韧是意志最好的助手。

C篇:本文是一篇说明文。爱尔兰戈尔韦国立大学(National University of Ireland, Galway)的 John Breslin 和 Sarah-Anne Buckley 教授将数字技术与历史研究相结合,已经能够将原本的黑白照片转换成丰富的彩色图像。

28. A 【解析】推理判断题。第二段主要说明这项技术的应用事实,由此可推断,作者主要陈述了一些事实。

29. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段第四句可知,研究工程和计算机科学的 Breslin 解释说,“训练”包括分析数千张正常的彩色照片,以及相同图片的黑白版本,以帮助它理解哪些颜色与不同的形状和质地相关。

30. B 【解析】词义猜测题。根据后面一句的提示:你总是可以回去找到原始照片,我们在整本书中提供了相关原始照片集的链接,可知,此句句意为“我们不是在破坏底片”。

31. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据上下文可知,本文主要介绍了能够让黑白照片变成彩色照片的新的人工智能摄影项目。

D篇:本文是一篇说明文。科学研究发现,在零重力状态下,人类的心脏会随着时间的推移而萎缩。

32. B 【解析】推理判断题。根据上下文可知,文章开头提及 NASA 与亿万富翁是为了引出本文的话题。

33. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段第二句可知,这意味着你的心脏必须更努力地工作来抵消重力,确保血液在全身流动。而在失重状态下,心脏不需要那么努力地工作。

34. A 【解析】主旨大意题。根据第三段第一句可知,因为研究人员在地球上,所以研究小组以一种独特而创新的方式得出了他们的结论。此句为本段的中心句。

35. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据第四段第五句可知,游泳运动员 Lecomte 的左心室重量每周减少 0.72 克。

36. G 【解析】根据前面一句“知道手放在哪里”可知,此句主要说明手的位置:大多数美国手语的标识都是从你的眼睛延伸到你的腰部。

37. F 【解析】根据前面主旨句大意“要知道,美国手语不仅仅是一种手和手指的语言”可知,此处是对主旨句的解释说明:例如,在手语中抬高眉毛意味着一个人在问问题。

38. C 【解析】根据前面一句“别着急”可知，此处意为：在你学习的时候，以缓慢的、从容不迫的方式进行。
39. A 【解析】本段主要介绍学会用手指拼美国手语字母的作用。
40. D 【解析】根据后面转折连词“but”可知，本段主要内容是逐步增加词汇量和短语到你的知识库。

41. B 【解析】考查动词。年复一年，每隔一段时间，一篮子自制的比萨会突然出现在警局大楼的主桌上，没有任何关于神秘面包师的线索。
42. D 【解析】考查形容词。参见上一解析。
43. A 【解析】考查副词。人们亲切地称她为“比萨夫人”。
44. B 【解析】考查动词短语。直到最近，警方才弄清楚这位神秘的面包师名叫 Antonietta Manganiello，而她生病了。
45. C 【解析】考查名词。她做这些比萨是为了感谢警局所有人的辛勤工作。

53. D 【解析】考查形容词。Buckley 局长告诉她，“我们非常感激你为我们所做的一切。”
54. B 【解析】考查动词。这看起来可能不算什么，但显然对 Antonietta Manganiello 意义重大。

语法填空：

61. exactly 【解析】考查词性转换。此处用副词作状语修饰谓语动词。你听说过“能源积极型”吗？这正是北极圈内的一家新酒店所承诺的。
62. opens 【解析】考查动词时态。主句是一般将来时，其状语从句用一般现在时代替将来时。
63. a 【解析】考查冠词。“a world first”世界首创。Svart 是一家漂浮在挪威斯瓦尔蒂森冰川附近的海湾边缘的圆形酒店。2022 年酒店建成后，它生产的能源将超过其消耗的能源——这在世界上尚属首次。
64. surroundings 【解析】考查名词复数。surroundings“环境”。这家酒店的设计与它优美的环境很协调。
65. is being built 【解析】考查动词时态和语态。根据时间状语 now 可知，此处用现在进行时的被动语态。现在，正在用当地的材料建造它。
66. consumption 【解析】考查词性转换。此处用名词作宾语。该酒店将节省 85% 的年能源消耗，并将收获足够的太阳能来满足酒店运营和建筑建造所需的能源。

67. associated 【解析】考查非谓语动词。此处用过去分词短语作后置定语修饰不定代词 everything 并与其构成被动关系。接下来的计划是让酒店和与之相关的一切都完全实现自给自足。
68. which 【解析】考查定语从句的关系代词。此处用“数量词+介词+关系代词”表整体当中的一部分。Svart 将拥有大约 100 间卧室。由于酒店的圆形设计和优越的地理位置,其中许多卧室将拥有令人羡慕的海湾景观。
69. advantageous 【解析】考查词性转换。此处用形容词作定语。
70. like 【解析】考查介词。此处 like 做介词,意为“就像……”。至于你在此期间可以做些什么,酒店会举办一些活动,比如在冰川上攀冰,在午夜阳光下上瑜伽课,观赏野生动物,潜水和钓鱼。

74. joined 后去掉 in 【解析】考查介词。join sb 意为“加入某人”。
75. hearing—hear 【解析】考查非谓语动词。此处 to 为动词不定式,故动词使用原形。
76. what—which 【解析】考查定语从句。引导定语从句,先行词为前面的整个句子,故使用关系代词 which。
77. goes—went 【解析】考查谓语动词。根据上下文可知,此处应该使用过去时态,与全文保持一致。

79. friend—friends 【解析】考查名词。我们是复数,故 friend 使用复数形式。
80. sharing—shared 【解析】考查非谓语动词。修饰名词 love 且与其为逻辑上的动宾关系,应使用其过去分词形式。虽然我们不了解对方,但我们对音乐的共同热爱让我们感觉像亲密的朋友一样。

5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面。评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。

6. 如书写较差以致影响交际,可将分数降低一个档次。

(二)评分标准:

第五档(21~25 分):完全完成了试题规定的任务,完全达到了预期的写作目的。

——覆盖所有内容要点。

——应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。

——语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误,但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致;具备较强的语言运用能力。

——有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。

第四档(16~20 分):完全完成了试题规定的任务,达到了预期的写作目的。

——虽漏掉一两个次重点,但覆盖所有主要内容。

——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

——语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。

——应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。

第三档(11~15 分):基本完成了试题规定的任务,整体而言,基本达到了预期的写作目的。

——虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖所有主要内容。

——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

——有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,但不影响理解。

——应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文内容连贯。

第二档(6~10 分):未恰当完成试题规定的任务,信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

——漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容。

——语法结构单调,词汇知识有限。

——有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误。

——较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性。

第一档(1~5 分):未完成试题规定的任务,信息未能传达给读者。

——明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,原因可能是未理解试题要求。

——语法结构单调,词汇知识有限。

——较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解。

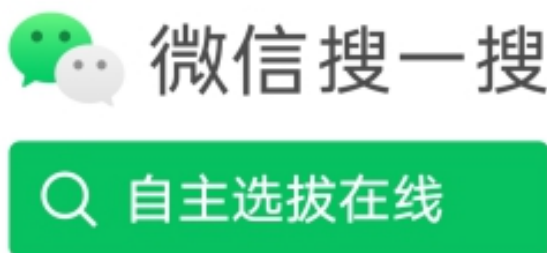
——缺乏语句间的连接成分,内容不连贯。
