21. A 细节理解题。根据 Portland Marathon 中第二句 It's a great event for first-timers because everyone is cheered on with enthusiasm no matter how long it takes to cross the finish line. 可知刚跑马拉松的新人不管花多长时间通过终点, 都能得到热情的欢呼。故选 A。
22. C 细节理解题。在波士顿举行的马拉松比赛是五月, 这比其他几个赛事都要早, 故选 C。
23. D 文章出处题。本文介绍了四场马拉松赛事, 故选自报纸的体育栏。故选 D。
24. B 细节理解题。根据第一段的 "So, it may not be surprising that the pandemic(疫情) has led to a major

- increase in bicycle sales.”可知，疫情大流行导致自行车销量大幅度增长并不奇怪。即冠状病毒爆发导致了自行车销量的增加。故选 B。
25. D 细节理解题。根据第三段的“Italy has created bicycle paths for the growing number of people who want to avoid public transportation.”可知，意大利为越来越多希望避免使用公共交通工具的人们建造了自行车道。即疫情大流行使意大利政府为民众新建了自行车道。故选 D。
26. C 细节理解题。根据第四段的“The increase in bicycle demand began in March as countries began to close down.”可知，随着国家开始实施封闭措施，民众对于自行车需求的增长开始于三月份。即民众对自行车的大量需求始于三月份。故选 C。
27. B 推理判断题。根据最后一段的 He said he hoped the increased sales meant a change in the way people think about transportation. “People are having a chance to rethink things,” he said, “Maybe we’ll all learn something out of this, and something really good will happen.”可知，Joe Minutolo 说，他希望自行车销量的增加意味着人们对出行方式的看法发生了变化。他说：人们有机会重新思考一些事情，也许我们都会从中学到一些东西，并且某些真正好的事情将会发生。由此可知，Joe Minutolo 对自行车销量增加持肯定的态度。故选 B。
28. D 事实细节题。根据第二段最后两句 He loved to play cards and did not want to stop a game even to eat. By putting cold meat between two pieces of bread, he could eat while he played 可知答案。
29. B 事实细节题。根据第五段中的 She wore a dress that came only to the knees. Under it she wore loose pants that fitted close at the ankles 可知答案。
30. A 事实细节题。根据文章内容可知这些词今天仍在被广泛使用。
31. B 标题概括题。文章主要介绍了英语中由人名转化而来的英文单词，从第一段以及最后一段的第一句话可得知答案。
32. B 细节理解题。根据第一段中“microscopic algae blooms(藻类爆发) across the surface of the snow is slowly turning Antarctica’s winter white landscape green.”可知，遍布雪表面的微生物藻类的爆发正在慢慢地将南极洲冬天的白色景观变成绿色。所以南极洲的雪变绿的是藻类的爆发，故选 B。
33. A 细节理解题。根据第二段中“Researchers say larger blooms of algae can be found north of the Antarctic and South Shetland Islands”可知，调查者们说更大的藻类的爆发会在南极洲北部和南设得兰群岛被发现，A 项符合，故选 A。
34. C 词义猜测题。根据词后句子“this may be due to their droppings”中的 may(也许)和 due to(因为)可知，科学家们是在推测和假设原因，故选 C。
35. D 细节理解题。文中并未提到企鹅以藻类为食，故 A 错，排除选项 A；根据“across the surface of the snow”可知藻类覆盖在雪的表面，故 B 错，排除选项 B；根据“on-the-ground observations over the course of two summers”可知，地面观察持续了两个夏天，故 C 错，排除选项 C；根据“this may be due to their droppings”可知，藻类的爆发可能是由于企鹅等动物的粪便，故选 D。

41. C 根据空后的从句部分的意思可以推知，此处指善意的语言(words)。
42. B 作者在第二段讲述了一次面试经历，主要是说明语言的影响力，因此，接受者会一辈子都珍视这些善意的语言。
43. D 阅读到卡耐基的话，作者决定回忆自己的一次活动。
44. A 根据下一段第一句可知，此处指前面过去的几天。
45. C 在作者看来，自己所说的话对另一个(another)人产生了改变一生的影响力。
46. D 从上一段第三句“to reflect upon one of my activities”可知，作者回忆前几天上午的一次会面。
47. B 句中的 interview 说明，辅导机构面试是为了招聘人员，因此此处指职位。
48. A 此处谈到的是一次面试的场面，对方是一个刚毕业的大学生，所以作者和对方应该是“从未”见过。
49. B 从下文中“all the people in the room”可知，房间里的人很多，因此很拥挤。
50. C 当他们坐下来谈话的时候，作者向对方做出了解释。

51. A 从语境可以看出, 作者认为对方“出类拔萃(stood out)”。stood up 站起来; stood by 袖手旁观; stood aside 站开。
52. C 从上文作者所说的话可知, 这些评论都是“积极的”。
53. B 作者的上述评论是基于她所展示的仪态及所带有的气质。
54. D 从本段第一句“ I had a meeting”可知, 他们继续面试的会议。
55. D 从下一段可知, 她有信心, 继续追求自己的梦想, 这说明作者的话对对方产生了影响, 所以说作者的评价对她很有意义。
56. A 作者和对方会面之前对方是刚毕业的大学生, 刚开始追求教师职业, 因此说她还远没有成功。
57. D 从下一句句意可知, 她变得很自信, 因此已经受到(received)作者的鼓舞。
58. B 对方想当一名老师, 因此此处指在课堂前面, 也就是同学们前面。
59. C 根据固定搭配 make a choice 可知, 该词意为“做出选择”。

To sum up, I would be more than grateful if you could take my application into account. I am looking forward to your reply.

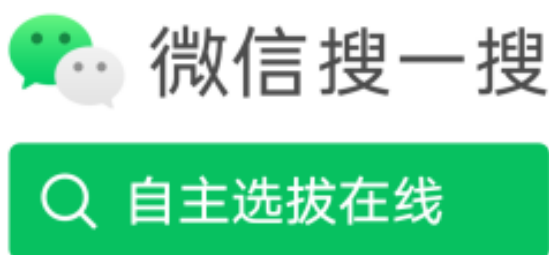
