【文章大意】文章介绍了密歇根北部地区庆祝夏天的四项活动。

21. A 根据第二段中“This year brings back a popular program that lets visitors learn to drill like an 1880s soldier...”可知答案选 A。

22. C 根据第四段中“Nothing says season opener of summer like Honor’s chance to catch the family-friendly double feature at The Cherry Bowl Drive-in. Pre-movie...”可知答案选 C。

23. A 根据第二段中“You may even share a ferry over to the island...”和第五段中“Even first-time sailors on this four-hour Lake Michigan ferry will find it hard to resist the quiz (with prizes!)...”可知两项活动中都包含乘坐游轮，故选 A。

【文章大意】文章讲述了作者曾经因为过于在乎别人对自己的看法而对他人任何要求都接受，最终作者的身体因为繁忙的生活而不堪重负。同时疫情导致的隔离以及自己的失业让作者开始反思自己的生活方式，并决心做出改变，不再凡事以别人为先。

24. D 根据第一段最后一句话可知，作者接受自己不喜欢做的事情是为了让别人认为自己无所不能，在他人心目中树立起好的名声，故选 D。

25. B 根据第二段中“I had severely swollen joints and brain fog but I pushed through so that I could look in the mirror at the end of the day and feel ‘accomplished.’”可知作者在身体出现问题后依然硬撑，只为了让自己在一天结束的时候有所谓的“成就感”，故选 B。

26. C 根据文章内容可知作者在疫情和失业后对自己的生活方式进行了反思并作出改变，故可知她是一个具有反思意识的人，故选 C。

27. B 根据最后一段中“I take a breath, do a quick count of my energy and ability before jumping in.”可知作者现在在帮助别人之前会先衡量一下自己的经历和能力，故选 B。

【文章大意】文章介绍了科研人员在某次研究中意外发现大黄蜂跟许多哺乳动物和鸟类一样喜欢玩耍。

28. C 根据第一段中“...is voluntary and rewarding in and of itself and appears to be pleasant and conducted when the animal is relaxed.”可知这种行为本身能够让动物们感到开心，故选 C。

29. D 根据第二段描述可知 Chittka 原本的研究目的是为了训练大黄蜂滚木球，

但是意外发现大黄蜂会自发地滚木球,并且很享受这一过程,从而催生了新研究,故选 D。

30. B 根据第二、三段的描述可知 Galpayage Dona 认为 Chittka 原先研究中的意外发现很适合作为自己的博士项目,于是加入了 Chittka 的研究,故选 B。

31. D 本文主要介绍了研究者发现大黄蜂喜欢玩的过程,结合第一段中提到很多哺乳动物和鸟类很喜欢玩,可知喜欢玩这一特性并不仅仅局限于哺乳动物和鸟类,故选 D。

【文章大意】文章介绍了英国高考 A-levels 的利弊以及英国教育目前的困境。

32. D 根据第一段中 Julian Metcalf 校长的话可知,学校的办学宗旨不仅限于让学生考上大学,更重要的是他们未来 60 年的人生,即学生的长期发展,故选 D。

33. C 根据第二段中 “Britain’s prime minister is the latest person to give it who warned that England was unusual in letting youngsters drop maths and their native language at 16.” 可知参加 A-levels 的考生可以选择不学数学和英语,故选 C。

34. B 根据第四段中 “Yet A-levels may not be handing English teenagers the breadth of skills they need.” 可知 A-levels 考试在学生技能广度的培养上做得并不好,故选 B。

35. D 根据第五段中 “For no good reason, England’s schools get less funding for pupils aged 16-19 than they do for younger children.” 可知英国对 16-19 岁阶段学生的教育投入少于对更低年龄段学生教育的投入,而这样的现象并没有一个合理的理由可以解释,故选 D。

【文章大意】文章介绍了几种应对焦虑的方法。

36. E 根据空前内容可知焦虑对于我们很重要,其重要性表现在它会阻止我们做某些事情,故焦虑是我们身体向我们发出危险警告的一种方式,故选 E。

37. G 根据空前 “...ask yourself, ‘What are some things that help me feel safer?’ ” 以及空后 “A lot of people will find that being surrounded by familiar people or things is comforting.” 可知作者建议人们想一些让自己有安全感的熟悉的人或事,与选项中的 “...a person you feel comfortable around or a TV show you love rewatching” 相呼应,故选 G。

38. A 根据第三段大意可知作者建议读者利用自己的各种感官来让自己放松,故选 A。

39. F 第三段中作者建议读者利用各种激发自己感官的小技巧让自己放松,缓解焦虑,这样大脑才能够不再被焦虑困扰,恢复理智,故选 F。

40. C 根据小标题 “Acknowledge your physical sensations” 以及空前 “For example, let’s say you feel anxiety in your stomach.” 可知作者建议读者承认自己的生理感受,而胃部焦虑时可能的生理感受包括发热或发紧,故选 C。

【文章大意】文章讲述了作者在日本的亲身经历地震,从而引发的感慨。

41. A. 从前文 “reserve a trip” 表达了我预定一个旅程,以及后文我为时尚杂志拍照 (shoot some photos), 故选 A。

42. A. 从前文的 “slightly 轻微地” 和 “mildly 温和地” 两个副词可以知道这里作者想表明的是自己没有感觉到,即忽视了 (ignore), 故选 A。

43. B. 从后文的 “fall over” 跌落,东西摔倒在地上可以证明地震是十分猛烈的,而且后文也有提及 “violently”, 故选 B。



44. B. 从前文“smile 笑”可知, 这个老人是不害怕, 是冷静的 (calmly), 故选 B。
45. D. 第一段告诉了我们地震已经发生了, “我”应该是在逃命地状态, 所以应该是马上冲向门 (rush for), 故选 D。
46. C. 由于地面剧烈的晃动, 所以笔直向前的跑是十分困难地 (challenging), 故选 C。
47. C. 尽管 (though) 我到达了路上, 但是我的心跳仍旧十分的快, 故选 C。
48. B. 我想要找到一片远离建筑的地区, 但是在日本这是不可能的。日本地理面积小, 房屋密集, 故选 B。
49. A. 从后文可知, 我像大多数人那样站在一个公园 (park), 故选 A。
50. D. 但这个时候, 地面仍在晃动 (shake), 但是没有那么剧烈, 故选 D。
51. C. 我之后才知道 (figure out) 是 8.9 级地震, 故选 C。
52. B. 有一些女性因为被吓到了而哭泣 (crying), 故选 B。
