## 第二部分 阅读理解

### 第一节

#### A 篇

【导语】本文是一篇应用文,介绍了 2022 年亚马逊网站最畅销的 4 本书。

21. B 【解析】细节理解题。根据每本书的价格来看, *A Promised Land* 的折扣是 5.3 折, *The Return* 的折扣是 5 折, *Untamed* 的折扣是 5.6 折, *The Ballad of Songbirds and Snakes* 的折扣是 6 折,可知 B 选项正确。
22. C 【解析】细节理解题。根据“If you haven't heard of this book, then you probably don't go on social media. Glennon Doyle's memoir(回忆录) blew up on Instagram and beyond this year”,可知 C 选项正确。

23. A 【解析】写作意图题。从每本书的信息,如 Publisher, Hardcover, Price 以及最后一段 “If you are interested in these books, please visit the website: <https://www.amazon.com>.” ,可知 A 选项正确。

### B 篇

【导语】本文是一篇说明文,主要介绍了日本将使用 AI 婚介服务和机器人解决人口老龄化问题以及中国为解决国内这一问题所采取的措施。

24. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据文章第二段最后 “Although there are some existing matchmaking systems, which consider criteria such as income and age, the more advanced AI system will also take into account factors like hobbies and values”, 可知 AI 婚介除了考虑收入、年龄之外,还会涉及爱好、价值观等更多方面的评估,因此 D 项正确。
25. A 【解析】推理判断题。根据文章第三段内容 “the fast-greying nation has long been searching for ways to improve the situation. Boosting the use of AI tech is one of its latest efforts.” ,可知快速老龄化的国家长期以来一直在寻找改善局势的方法,促进人工智能技术的使用是其最新的努力之一。这个国家就是日本,因此选 A。
26. C 【解析】推理判断题。根据文章第四段 “the world population is expected to reach 9.7 billion in 2050. While by 2050, one in six people in the world will be over age 65. In China, by 2050, the number is expected to increase to 500 million...” ,可知作者使用列数字的说明方式呈现老龄化的严峻形势,故 C 项正确。
27. D 【解析】主旨大意题。本文主要介绍了日本将使用 AI 婚介服务和机器人解决人口老龄化问题以及中国为解决国内这一问题所采取的措施,因此选 D。A、B、C 项只是在文章中提到过,并非主要内容。

### C 篇

【导语】本文是一篇说明文,介绍了现在以男性为导向的经济的蓬勃发展以及其发展起来的原因。

28. A 【解析】细节理解题。根据文章第一段最后 “especially given the fast-rising living standards across the most populous country on the earth and a male population that’s increasingly longing for a better quality of life”, 可知 A 项正确, C 项错误;从第二段最后 “three specific shopping habits of Chinese men in recent years: widened category, improved awareness and increased online consumption” 可以判断出 B 项错误;D 项未提及。
29. D 【解析】细节理解题。根据文章第三段内容 “who have warmly embraced some special-interest consumer culture in other parts of the world through the Internet, such as the sneakerhead subculture, as a way to express their individuality. More importantly, many are willing to spend a fortune on it”, 可知选 D, A、B、C 项与原文不符。
30. C 【解析】词义猜测题。根据文章第四段画线词的下一句 “The desire for ‘refined lives’ has been channeled strongly through the pursuance of a more polished look — lighter skin, longer eyelashes and bigger eyes”, 可知 C 项(优雅的)符合文意。
31. B 【解析】主旨大意题。全文都在介绍现在以男性为导向的经济的蓬勃发展,以及其背后的原因,因此选 B。A、C、D 只是在文章中提到过,并非主要内容。

## D 篇

【导语】本文是一篇报道,主要介绍欧洲将逐步使用可再生资源替代化石燃料发电。

32. B 【解析】细节理解题。A 选项的 38% 是去年使用可再生资源发电的占比,因此 A 选项错误;B 选项的 20% 对应第三段第二句的“one-fifth”;C 选项的 no longer 无法从文章得出;D 选项的 13% 和第三段的“in Europe(欧洲)”对应,但不能对应题干细节“EU countries(欧盟国家)”。因此本题选 B。
33. D 【解析】推理判断题。根据第四段 Dave Jones 所言,燃煤下降是风能和太阳能增长导致的,因此 A 选项错误;B 选项的“is phased out”错误,根据原文应该是 2030 年之前才能达成;原文对核电站的描述是:替代正在关闭的核电站,而不是修更多的核电站,因此 C 选项错误;原文提到 coal 和 gas generation 都最终会被淘汰,因此 D 选项正确。
34. C 【解析】推理判断题。根据第五段第二句可知,疫情对新能源的发展没有影响,故 A 选项错误;第五段最后一句中的“historic”一词是对发电过程中气体排放的描述,不是对电力消耗的描述,因此 B 选项错误;C 选项的 hardly 对应第五段第二句的“had no effect on”;D 选项的“making steady progress”无法从文章得出。因此本题选 C。
35. B 【解析】写作意图题。文章主要报道欧洲逐步使用可再生资源替代化石燃料发电,因此 B 选项正确。

## 第二节

【导语】本文是一篇说明文。文章解释了极端高温导致人类生病或死亡的原因。

36. A 【解析】根据空后的“A study published in the journal *Nature Climate Change* found global warming responsible for 37 percent of heat-related deaths between 1991 and 2022. (发表在《自然气候变化》杂志上的一项研究发现,1991 年至 2022 年期间,37% 的热相关死亡是由全球变暖造成的。)”可知,前文应该强调的是热浪造成死亡,即二者之间的正关系。A 选项“As the heat rises quickly, so does the death number. (随着气温迅速上升,死亡人数也随之上升。)”符合语境,引起下文。故选 A。
37. F 【解析】根据前文“Then your heart starts beating faster to pump blood to the skin while blood flow is directed away from important organs(器官) like your liver, kidneys and gut. (然后你的心跳开始加快,将血液泵入皮肤,而血液则从肝脏、肾脏和肠道等重要器官流向别处。)”可知,此处从热浪对身体各个器官产生影响的机理入手,对热浪造成死亡的原因进行分析,由此后文应该阐述该消极影响所产生的后果。F 选项“Sometimes that alone is enough to create problems for a weak or aging heart. (有时,仅仅这一点就足以给虚弱或衰老的心脏带来问题。)”中的 that 指代的就是前文所提到的情况。故选 F。
38. D 【解析】根据前文“At that temperature, your brain becomes affected. (在那种温度下,你的大脑会受到影响。)”可知此处讲对大脑的影响。后文“Before long, you might lose consciousness.”中的“Before long”与 D 选项的“start”对应。故选 D。
39. G 【解析】根据前文“While you struggle to stay awake and avoid dizzying confusion, the excessive internal heat is damaging your gut, consequently causing an inflammatory(发炎的) response. (当你努力保持清醒,避免眼花缭乱的混乱时,过多的内热正在损害你的肠道,从而导致炎症反应。)”可知,



后文应该承接的是:应该及时治疗由内热损害肠道从而导致的炎症,否则会造成死亡。G 选项“Left untreated, what follows is a flood of organ failure that leads to your death. (如果不及时治疗,随之而来的是大量器官衰竭,最终导致死亡。)”符合语境。故选 G。

40. B 【解析】根据后文“A lot of what we know comes from studies on animal models, like mice and rats, or from examinations of people dying of heat stroke. (我们知道的很多信息都来自于对动物模型的研究,比如小鼠和大鼠,或者来自对中暑死亡者的检查。)”可知,关于极端高温造成人类死亡,我们仅仅知道其中一部分的原因,这是因为我们不能对人类机体本身进行研究,我们所获得的很多信息都来自于对动物模型的研究。故 B 选项“That’s because we can’t study it in humans in the laboratory. (这是因为我们无法在实验室中对人类进行研究。)”承上启下。故选 B。

### 第三部分 语言知识运用

#### 第一节 完形填空

【导语】本文是一篇夹叙夹议文,讲述了作者看到大树遭遇强风暴时,虽然树枝摇摆弯曲,树叶飘落,甚至根部的泥土都有些松动,但是泥土深处的强劲根部,不仅给大树输送营养,还保障了大树的稳固性,使其在狂风肆虐之下得以生存。作者由此联想到人生,当我们遇到残酷的挑战时,应该像大树那样,从根部树立坚定的信念和勇往直前的勇气,坚忍不拔,不被困难打倒。

41. B 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意:我向窗外望去,看见一棵树被狂风肆虐着。根据下文的描述可知,这棵树既没有被折断,也没有被风移走,只是被狂风肆虐。A 项意为“破坏,折断”;B 项意为“虐待”;C 项意为“压破,压碎”;D 项意为“去除,移开”。abused 符合语境,因此 B 项正确。
42. D 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意:树枝弯曲,来回摆动,多亏了它们的柔韧性,才得以避免折断。A 项意为“高度”;B 项意为“厚度”;C 项意为“能量”。根据空前的句子“The branches bent, and swayed back and forth”可知描述的是树的韧性,因此 D 项正确。
43. C 【解析】考查动词词组辨析。句意:树叶紧紧附在树枝上,因为它们的生命依赖于树。A 项意为“符合,对……负责”;B 项意为“就……做决定”;D 项意为“迎合……”。C 项 depended on 意为“依赖于”,符合句意,因此 C 项正确。
44. A 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意:强大的树干支撑着树,使得它在保持自己位置的战斗中,只是稍稍向后弯曲。B 项意为“打结,系住”;C 项意为“拉”;D 项意为“提升,养育”,均与句意不符。held 是 hold 的过去式,在这里意为“支撑”,故 A 项正确。
45. D 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意:强大的树干支撑着树,使得它在保持自己位置的战斗中,只是稍稍向后弯曲。A 项意为“实现”;B 项意为“到达”;C 项意为“建立”;D 项意为“保持”。大树在风暴前就有自己的位置,只是在风暴中努力保持自己的位置,不需要实现、到达或建立,因此 D 项正确。
46. C 【解析】考查形容词词义辨析。句意:这棵树优雅地回到了它原来的位置,高高耸立在一片狼藉中。A 项意为“合适的”;B 项意为“最终的”;C 项意为“最初的,原来的”;D 项意为“舒适的”。根据本句中用 returned(回到)且结合文章大意可知,大树应该是没被风吹倒,又回到了它原来的位置,因此 C 项正确。

47. D 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：它成功在风暴中生存下来。A 项意为“探索”；B 项意为“避免”；C 项意为“竞争”；D 项意为“幸存，存活”。根据句意可知，D 项正确。
48. A 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：但是重要的是，这棵树赢得了这场生存之战。A 项 counts 在此处为不及物动词，意为“重要”；B 项意为“不同于”；C 项意为“关心”；D 项意为“显露”，故 A 项正确。
49. D 【解析】考查动词固定短语。句意：很长一段时间我都不明白，为什么这棵树会以这种方式引起我的注意。catch one's attention 为固定搭配，意为“引起某人的注意”，故 D 项正确。
50. B 【解析】考查形容词词义辨析。句意：随着时间的推移，原因变得很明显了，引起我注意的不仅仅是树本身，还包括它的根，虽然看不见，却深深地扎根于地下，给树提供稳定性（使树牢固地站立）和营养。A 项意为“熟悉的”；C 项意为“重要的”；D 项意为“合理的”。B 项意为“明显的”，符合语境，故 B 项正确。
51. B 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：随着时间的推移，原因变得很明显了，引起我注意的不仅仅是树本身，还包括它的根，虽然看不见，却深深地扎根于地下，给树提供稳定性（使树牢固地站立）和营养。A 项意为“环境，周围的事物”；C 项意为“来源”；D 项意为“可能性”。B 项 stability 意为“稳定性”，符合语境，因此 B 项正确。
52. A 【解析】考查固定短语。句意：树根允许树能够经受挫折，因为有它们在支持它。take a beating 为固定搭配，意为“受打击，经受挫折”，这里挫折具体讲就是上文提到的大风对树枝的击打，因此 A 项正确。
53. B 【解析】考查连词。空格前一句句意为：我不禁问自己，我生命中的根有多深。后一句句意为：下一次当你发现你的孩子行为不端时，当你的工作快把你逼疯时，当你的工资过低，你的钱又很紧张时，当生命的风暴肆虐时，回到你的根部。空格前后两句属于因果关系，思考过自己的根有多深，因此可以在风暴肆虐时回到根部。A 项表转折；B 项表因果；C 项意为“与此同时”；D 项意为“除此之外”，因此 B 项正确。
54. A 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：下一次当你发现孩子行为不端、不礼貌时。A 项 misbehaving 意为“行为不礼貌”；B 项意为“斗争”；C 项意为“撤回，撤销”；D 项意为“误解”，因此 A 项正确。
55. C 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：当你的工资过低，你的钱又很紧张时。A 项意为“安全”；B 项意为“日程安排”；C 项意为“钱”；D 项意为“最后期限”。根据上下文语境可知，money 与前面的单词 underpaid 相对应，即当你感觉报酬不足，用钱紧张时，因此 C 项正确。
56. C 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：人生充满风暴。A 项意为“惊喜”；B 项意为“选择”；C 项意为“风暴”；D 项意为“改变”。C 项与上文“the next time you catch your kids. . . , when the job is driving you crazy, when you are underpaid and the . . . is tight, and when the storms of life are raging”中所提到的各类人生挫折相对应，因此 C 项正确。
57. B 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：它们会使你摇摆，使你弯曲，使你失去一些叶子，但是你的根越深，你站得越稳。A 项意为“崩溃”；B 项意为“弯曲”；C 项意为“犹豫”；D 项意为“疼痛”。前文提到树干被大风刮得有点弯曲，这里指人生中遇到的风暴也会让人如同大树一样，有点弯曲，但是根系越深，人便站得越稳，因此 B 项符合语境。

58. B 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意:面对挑战,你可能会弯曲,但是不要折断。A 项意为“改变”;B 项意为“挑战”;C 项意为“责任”;D 项意为“不同”。challenges 与上一段提到的 storms 相对应,即人生中遇到的各种困难,因此 B 项正确。
59. C 【解析】考查固定短语。句意:无论风暴有多么强烈,都不要让生活逼迫自己处于不舒服的境地。force sb. into 为固定短语,意为“强迫某人进入……”,因此 C 项正确。
60. D 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意:你的力量就在你的根上。A 项意为“勇气”;B 项意为“野心,雄心”;C 项意为“价值”;D 项意为“力量,力气”。上一段最后一句话中的“the deeper your roots the stronger you stand”是对本题答案的提示,即:根系越深,站得越稳,也就是说你的力量来自于你坚实的根基,所以 D 项正确。

61. aged 【解析】aged 可理解为形容词,后接数词,意为“多少岁的”。
62. asked 【解析】when 引导的从句是省略句,完整表达是“when they were asked about...”,省略了主语 they 和 were。
63. whose 【解析】考查定语从句。此处指“他们的家庭关系”,所以是 whose family relationships。
64. what 【解析】what 引导出表语从句,同时作从句的主语,可替换为 something that。
65. children/ children's 【解析】此处可用动名词的复合结构 one's doing,也可用 one doing 作宾语。
66. socializing 【解析】此处和 learning 并列,短语 devote ... to sth. / doing 意为“将……奉献给(做某事)”。
67. best 【解析】考查最高级 the best。
68. necessarily 【解析】这里要用副词 necessarily 修饰动词 need,表示并不非得怎么样。
69. a 【解析】此处指“一种有力的交流形式”,所以是 a powerful form of communication。
70. attentive 【解析】and 并列几个形容词,所以要用对应的形容词 attentive。

73. 第三句:with 改为 to 【解析】固定搭配 much to one's disappointment 意为“非常令某人失望的是”。
74. 第三句:shortly 改为 short 【解析】固定搭配 cut ... short 意为“缩短……”。
75. 第四句:去掉 them 【解析】考查定语从句。先行词是 the same places,用 that 引导这个定语从句,that 在从句中指代先行词,就相当于 them,作 visited 的宾语,可以省略,这里已经省略了,所以不能再使用 them。
76. 第五句:includes 改为 included 【解析】考查时态。这里是一般过去时,所以 includes 改为 included。
