The royal homes of kings or emperors reflect their architecture style and wealth. Visiting such great palaces helps to explore history of kingdoms and the lifestyle of a time.

Mysore Palace, India

Located in the city of Mysore, South India, Mysore Palace was built by different kings in different centuries. A mixture of Indo-Saracenic, Hindu, Muslim, Rajput and Gothic styles of architecture was used for construction of the palace. It was also surrounded by large gardens, lighted by more than 10, 000 bulbs.

Forbidden City, China

Forbidden City is the world's largest palace complex located in Beijing, China, also known as the Imperial Palace or Palace Museum. This palace complex was built from 1406 to 1420, and accommodated 24 different Chinese emperors from 1420 to 1912. It was also decorated with stone animals, rails, arches and dragons. Until 1912, no one was allowed to enter this complex without having permission of the emperor.

Alhambra Palace, Spain

Situated in the city of Andalusia, Spain, the first part of Alhambra Palace was constructed in the 9th century. It was renovated (翻新) by Muhammad ben Al-Ahmar in the 13th century, transformed into the current palace by Sultan of Granada in 1333. The whole sections of Alhambra Palace were whitewashed, and today it appears as reddish one because of centuries of baking in sunlight.

Pena National Palace, Portugal

Located in Portugal, Pena National Palace was protected for centuries by one king after another. But it suffered severely damages by the Lisbon Earthquake of 1755. King Ferdinand II transformed those ruins into a beautiful palace — Pena Palace. The romanticism style was used for the construction of this palace. This beautiful palace is listed on UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

For two co-workers catching up during a chance encounter, a simple “How are you?” check-in between them ballooned into a chance that saved two lives and created an unbreakable bond between two families.

Susan and Tia worked at Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta. Ironically, both Tia’s husband, Rodney, and Susan’s husband, Lance, were suffering from kidney disease and in desperate need of transplants. The women raced against the clock, attempting to find kidney donors before the disease took their husbands’ lives. They didn’t know about their shared struggle at first. But after finding out in 2019, they quickly became friends, always sharing the ups and downs of their husbands’ conditions. Thanks to a piece of random information, the women suddenly realized they might be potential donor matches for the other’s husband.

When the tests were run, it turned out they were indeed good matches for one another’s husbands. Both wives got donor approval last October, but the December surgeries were rescheduled for January, because Lance suffered a setback and had to be hospitalized. Then Susan tested positive for COVID-19, so the procedures were postponed again. After Susan recovered, the operations were rescheduled for March 19th.

As the old saying goes, the third time is a charm. The two thankful husbands, freed from the suffering, are looking forward to spending many happy years of quality time with their loved ones — who now include their extended “kidney families”. Tia said, “Now we are forever connected,

More Chinese seniors are exploring the use of the payment service of WeChat, China's leading messaging and social media app, according to a study released on Saturday.

The study, conducted by the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, aimed to learn about the digital life of the elderly population in the post-pandemic period. Over 90 percent of the seniors surveyed watch videos online, over 80 percent read novels and articles online, and at least 23.26 percent play mobile games with almost no objections from their children. The study showed a growing number of seniors are using WeChat Pay and their sum total payment via the service increased by 5,227 percent between the first quarter in 2017 and the second quarter in 2021.

The report found in the post-pandemic period, seniors live rather differently depending on their adaptability to new technologies. Some tech-savvy(精通技术的) seniors manage to master skills, including scanning QR codes, mobile navigation and online ride-hailing, while some have to refrain from going outdoors for not knowing how to use digital devices. Still, 95.09 percent of elderly users believe in the importance of learning how to use the Internet in a post-pandemic setting, and 93.36 percent are confident in learning how to get online using smart phones.

The report also said the digital divide for the elderly attracted the attention of the general public after the COVID-19 outbreak and the authorities have taken action to bridge the divide.

In November 2020, the State Council issued a plan to solve the difficulties of seniors in using smart technologies. The Ministry of Industry and Information Technology later issued a one-year action plan on removing obstacles and transforming Internet apps to become more senior-friendly.

Researchers already knew that quantities of wind and solar farms can increase the heat and rainfall in the areas around them. But this new study is to model how wind and solar farms would affect the Sahara, while considering how green plants would respond to these changes. "Previous modeling studies have shown that large-scale wind and solar farms can produce significant climate change at continental scales," study co-lead researcher Yan Li said. "But the lack of vegetation(植被) feedbacks could make the modeled climate impacts very different from their actual behavior."

The model showed that wind farms caused localized air temperatures to warm. The solar farms would also have a positive effect on temperature and rainfall, the researchers noted. "We found that the large-scale installation(安装) of solar and wind farms can bring more rainfall and promote vegetation growth in these regions," study co-lead researcher Eugenia Kalnay, a distinguished professor at the University of Maryland, said in the statement. "The rainfall increase is a consequence of complex land-atmosphere interactions that occur because solar panels and wind turbines create rougher and darker land surfaces."

The study authors also modeled what would happen if wind and solar farms covered more than 3.4 million square miles of the Sahara. On average, the wind farms would generate about 3 terawatts(万亿瓦), while the solar farms would generate 79 terawatts of electrical power in one year, they found. That's a lot of energy. One terawatt can power about 10 billion 100-watt light bulbs at the same time. In 2017, the global energy demand was only 18 terawatts, so this is obviously much more energy than is currently needed worldwide.

If this model ever becomes a reality, the increase in rainfall and vegetation, combined with clean electricity as a result of solar and wind energy, could help agriculture, economic development and social well-being in the Sahara, Sahel, Middle East and other nearby regions.
