范文二

Paragraph 1: *A complicated look came over Mr Arable's face.* The words his daughter just said still echoing in his head, never did he know the weakling meant so much to her. He lowered his head with an unprecedented wave of hesitation only to catch sight of her daughter's determined eyes and firm grip. Reflecting that killing the small pig may hurt her daughter deeply, he was stuck in a dilemma. After seemingly a long time, there came a sigh of Mr Arable, "All right! He's yours!" (83w)

Paragraph 2: *Fern loved the little pig more than anything.* The following days witnessed Fern fed the pig devotedly and inexhaustibly. When the sky barely dawned, she warmed his milk, tied his bib on, and held the bottle for him with love, then at noontime, and again at suppertime. Simultaneously, the pig would grunt, leap forward to sniff Fern and gaze up at her with adoring eyes. 【应用文评分标准】

三个要点, 一个要点 3 分, 覆盖全部要点, 表达基本到位给及格分 9 分; 如要点齐全, 表达词汇有限, 句式单调语法错误多的较多, 给 6 分; 如表达出色, 但遗漏个别要点最高给 12 分。

附评分标准:

1. 总分 15 分, 按 5 个档次给分;
2. 从内容, 词汇语法, 篇章结构三个方面考虑:
 - 1) 交际: 对内容要点的覆盖情况, 表述的清晰程度与合理性;
 - 2) 语言: 词汇和语法结构应用的准确性, 恰当性及多样性;
 - 3) 语篇: 上下文衔接和全文的连贯性。
3. 评分时, 先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次, 然后以该档次的要求来衡量, 确定或调整档次, 最后给分。
4. 词数少于 60 词的从总分中减去 2 分。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面, 评分时, 应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写和词汇用法均可接受。
6. 如书写较差, 以至影响交际, 将分数降低一个档次。
7. 内容要点可用不同方式表达, 对紧扣主题的适当发挥不予扣分。

各档次的给分范围和要求

第五档(很好): (13 — 15 分)

1. 完全完成了试题规定的任务。
2. 覆盖所有内容要点,
3. 应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。
4. 语法或词汇方面有些许错误, 但为尽力使用较复杂结构或词汇所致。具备较强的语言运用能力。
5. 有效地使用了语句间的连接成份, 使全文结构紧凑。
6. 完全达到了预期的写作目的。

第四档(好): (10 — 12 分)

1. 完全完成了试题规定的任务。
2. 虽漏掉一、两个次重点, 但覆盖所有主要内容。

- 3.运用的语法结构或词汇方面能满足任务的要求。
- 4.语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。5.应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。
- 6.达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档(适当): (7-9 分)

- 1.基本完成了试题规定的任务。
- 2.虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖所有主要内容。
- 3.应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。
- 4.有一此语法结构或词汇方面的错误、但不影响理解。
- 5.应用简单的语句间的连接成分、使全文内容连贯。
- 6.整体而言,基本达到了预期的写作目的。

第二档(较差): (4-6 分)

- 1.未恰当完成试题规定的任务。
- 2.漏掉或未描述清楚-些主要内容,写了一些无关内容。
- 3.词法结构单调,词汇项目有限。
- 4.有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响了对写作内容的理解。
- 5.较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性。
- 6.信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

第一档(差): (1-3 分)

- 1.未完成试题规定的任务。
- 2.明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,原因可能是未理解试题要求。
- 3.语法结构单调,词汇项目有限。
- 4.较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解。
- 5.缺乏语句间的连接成分,内容不连贯。
- 6.信息未能传达给读者。

不得分(0 分)

完全抄袭的:未能传达给读者任何信息的:内容太少,无法评判的,写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清的。

【读后续写评分标准】

- 1) 本题总分为 25 分,按 5 个档次给分。
- 2) 评分时,先根据所续写短文的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次,最后给分。
- 3) 词数少于 130 的,从总分中减去 2 分。
- 4) 评分时,应主要从以下四个方面考虑:
 - 与所给短文及段落开头语的衔接程度;
 - 内容的丰富性和对所标出关键词语的应用情况;
 - 应用语法结构和词汇的丰富性和准确性;
 - 上下文的连贯性。
- 5) 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个重要方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
- 6) 如书写较差以致影响交际,可将分数降低一个档次。
