21.【答案】D

【命题意图】推理判断题

【解析】根据 Moon Man 介绍中的第二句"Witnessing the catastrophic hit from the moon, Dugu believes the Earth is completely destroyed and he's the last human in the universe."可知, Moon Man 是一部科幻电影。

22.【答案】A

【命题意图】推理判断题

【解析】根据各部电影的上映时间(release date)可以得出答案。

23.【答案】C

【命题意图】细节理解题

【解析】根据第一段最后一句"Here are some top films at the box office in 2022."可知,这几部电影都取得了票房上的成功。

【语篇导读】本文是一篇记叙文。文章介绍了作者高龄的母亲想要举办一场盛大的生日宴会,可由于母亲生日前不久受伤住进了康复中心,条件受限,孩子们只能为她举办小型的生日宴会。令人惊喜的是,她生病的丈夫的出现和适时清醒给她的生日宴会增添了更多美好的瞬间。

24.【答案】B

【命题意图】细节理解题

【解析】根据第一段第二句"But because of a fractured hip just 3 weeks before, we could only arrange a small one at the rehab instead of giving her a big celebration in a restaurant."可知,母亲因为臀骨断裂而住进康复中心,条件受限,所以没有办法举办大型生日宴会。

25.【答案】C

【命题意图】推理判断题

【解析】根据第二段第二句中的"these visits distressed her because he was usually asleep and did not respond to her"可知,Fred 在康复中心里的大部分时间都没有意识。

26.【答案】D

【命题意图】推理判断题

【解析】根据第三段第四句"Because the party was held in the nursing facility, we had taken him to the party, too."可知,护理人员把 Fred 推到餐厅是为了让他陪妻子过生日。

27.【答案】A

【命题意图】标题归纳题

【解析】通读全文可知,文章主要介绍虽然由于母亲的身体原因,"我们"没能按照她的愿望为她举办一场大型生日宴会,但 Fred 的出现和适时的清醒为母亲的生日宴会带来了惊喜。倒数第二段中的"his presence was the best gift of all"为点题之笔。

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。情绪自由疗法:轻敲或者叩击,可以帮助人们应对焦虑和压力。

28.【答案】B

【命题意图】主旨大意题

【解析】根据第二段第二句中的"It draws on the idea of energy meridian lines from Chinese medicine"可知,本段主要讲的是叩击的起源。

29.【解析】D

【命题意图】词义猜测题

【解析】根据画线词下文的定语从句"which can help tell the brain you are safe and turn off the stress response in the body"可知, amygdala 的作用是告知大脑你是安全的,关闭身体对压力的反应,由此推知, amygdala 是大脑中管理战斗、逃避和压力反应的一个部位。

30.【解析】B

【命题意图】态度观点题

【解析】根据最后一段最后一句中的"but as long as it's practiced with care and as a complementary practice the risks are very low"可知,作者认为轻敲叩击的风险还是比较低的,因此作者的态度是支持的。

31.【答案】B

【命题意图】标题归纳题

【解析】通读全文,尤其是第一段中的"help manage stress and anxiety"可知,本文主要介绍了轻敲叩击作为一种疗法对于人们缓解压力和焦虑的作用。

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。作者通过一段人工智能聊天机器人创作的文章段落介绍了 ChatGPT 的概念以及功能,进而阐述了 ChatGPT 对人类职业方面的影响。

32.【答案】B

【命题意图】细节理解题

【解析】根据第二段第二句"It was generated by a chatbot called ChatGPT, an artificial intelligence technology designed to mimic human conversation and language while drawing upon a vast wealth of knowledge to answer questions and solve problems."可知, ChatGPT 的功能是回答问题并帮助人们解决问题。

33.【答案】B

【命题意图】主旨大意题

【解析】根据第四段第一句"While ChatGPT is not infallible, Oxford's Wooldridge compares its output to well-written undergraduate work."和第四句"This level of output poses a threat to those at the lower end of the employment market."可知,ChatGPT 并非完全可靠,但目前它的产出水平已经对低端就业市场的从业人员构成了威胁。

34.【答案】D

【命题意图】推理判断题

【解析】根据第五段第一、二句 "Those least likely to see machines taking over their jobs include legal professionals, doctors and university lecturers. Such occupations are classed as highly skilled."可知,法律人士、医生和大学讲师等高技能职业不会被人工智能机器人取代。由此推知,选项中的教育者、律师和音乐家都属于高技能职业,不会被取代,而仓库管理员这种例行重复性的工作最有可能被取代。

35.【答案】A

【命题意图】标题归纳题

【解析】通读全文可知,本文通过介绍 ChatGPT 的概念以及功能,进而表达了 ChatGPT 会对人类职业造成影响甚至取代一部分职业的观点。同时,根据第二段最后一句"What ChatGPT offers seems more capable — and is potentially even more of a threat to jobs — than existing AI chatbot technology."可知,A项"ChatGPT,一个会对低端工作构成威胁的强大机器人"最适合作为本文标题。

第二节

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文。如今的动物园起着作为保护动物中心的重要作用,动物园专业人员为保护动物,付出了巨大的努力,为动物提供各种刺激,并对动物进行一定程度的行为训练。动物园不断寻找方法以支付其运转费用。

36.【答案】F

【命题意图】细节句。

【解析】上文提到大多数人来动物园是为了娱乐;下文提到某个动物园最近新增的喂长颈鹿的平台。故F项"动物园必须保持公众的兴趣,因此他们一直在努力开发新的项目和展览"承上启下,符合语境。

37.【答案】G

【命题意图】细节句。

【解析】上文提到居住环境得到改善的动物比居住环境没有得到改善的动物表现更好;下文提到动物可能对动物园管理员花费数月开发的改善形式不感兴趣。故 G 项"改善的目的是尽可能久地保持对动物的刺激,这一过程需要经历多次的尝试与失败"承上启下,符合语境。

【命题意图】细节句。

【解析】上文提到了一种"刺激自然行为"的方法。B项中的"Other forms"照应上文,"stimulate the senses"照应下文的味觉刺激,符合语境。

39.【答案】D

【命题意图】总结句。

【解析】根据上文可知,本段主要介绍许多动物园对动物进行了一定程度的行为训练以使员工能为它们提供更好的护理。D项"这样的训练能帮助兽医提供更好的、侵入性更小的护理"总结本段。

40.【答案】A

【命题意图】细节句。

【解析】前文提到饲养和照顾动物园动物、维护展品和支付员工工资需要巨额资金。由此可知, A项"动物园必须不断寻找支付开支的方法"符合语境。

Jigme Dorje has endured bitter cold and has even been trapped in heavy snow several times. In his eyes, however, these difficulties are a small price to pay for the smiles he enjoys when people receive their parcels.

For three decades, he has always offered to help transport materials for railway and road construction workers and often shared his medicine with tourists in need. "We not only deliver mails to their destinations, but also help those in need," he said. "This is the tradition of postal delivery workers in snowy mountains that has been passed down across generations, and we mustn't forget it."
