### 听力部分录音稿

(Text 1)

M: What time does the concert start?

W: Seven o'clock. We've only got twenty minutes.

(Text 2)

21. C 细节理解题。根据每小节中的时间计算可知,伦敦文学节持续的时间最长。

22. A 细节理解题。根据 **Bloomsbury Festival** 中 "Vitality(活力) is the theme of this year's Bloomsbury Festival, celebrating creativity of the locals." 可知,布卢姆斯伯里节的目的是庆祝当地人的创造性。

23. C 数字计算题。根据 **EFG London Jazz Festival** 中 "Tickets: Adults: 100 dollars each; Children under 6: free; Students: half price" 可知,一对夫妇带着两岁的儿子去参加 EFG 伦敦爵士音乐节需要花 200 美元。

24. A 代词指代题。根据第二段 "... the boy carefully dug up the flower." 可知,此处代词 it 指代 the flower。

25. C 细节理解题。根据第二段“It seemed to the boy that maybe the flower could survive there. . . Then he went to the moon with the little red flower.”可知,小男孩去月球是为了给这朵花寻找一个合适的生长环境。
26. B 推理判断题。根据最后一段“Maybe it’s telling us that if we don’t look after our planet, a day will come when flowers will only be able to grow on the moon.”可推断,作者意在告诉读者保护地球是我们义不容辞的职责。
27. D 推理判断题。通读全文可推测,本文是一篇短篇小说。
28. D 细节理解题。根据第二段“Singlish, short for Singaporean English. . . It has a heavy Chinese influence.”可知,新加坡英语深受中文的影响。
29. A 细节理解题。根据第四段“As is known to all, each month that ends in ‘-ber’ means the rainy season.”可知,英语月份表达中以“-ber”结尾的(September, October, November, December),在新加坡就意味着这几个月是雨季,余下月份则为旱季。
30. C 推理判断题。根据第五段“Open-air eating areas where hawkers sell their goods are very popular. . . The 2018 film. . .”可推断,作者在此提及《摘金奇缘》这部电影是为了说明新加坡商厦中心很受大众欢迎。
31. A 写作意图题。通读全文,尤其是第一段“Singapore is one of the world’s major tourist destinations.”及最后一段可知,本文旨在介绍世界著名旅游胜地——新加坡。
32. A 词义猜测题。根据画线词后“Nowadays nearly three quarters of American households subscribe to(订阅) at least one video streaming service.”可推断,画线词与 Common 的意思最接近。
33. B 细节理解题。根据第二段“A quarter of its subscribers, who were against price increases, said they would cancel their subscriptions. Few did.”及第三段“A major reason: streaming networks have become home to many of the most popular TV series. . .”可知,Netflix 用户未取消订阅是因为用户很看重 Netflix 提供的高质量节目。
34. B 推理判断题。根据第三段,尤其是“In fact, streaming has changed the Oscar competition. . .”可推断,流媒体给传统电影行业带来极大的改变。
35. D 主旨大意题。通读全文,尤其是第二段及最后一段可知,本文主要介绍流媒体的利弊。
36. G 根据选项关键词 dangerous 和空后照应词 dangers 可知,G 项“为什么我们要花这么多的时间和金钱去探索危险的环境”符合。
37. F 根据小标题 **Medical benefits** 和选项中照应词 The medical benefits 及空后内容可知,F 项“太空探索的医学益处覆盖到人体的每个部分”符合。
38. B 根据小标题下的关键词 technological advancements 可知,B 项“新技术的发展”适合作本段的小标题。
39. D 根据空前句“... such as vacuum-sealed(真空密封的) food, fireproof materials and modern vacuum cleaners.”和选项中关键词 use them 可知,D 项“今天,我们仍然在日常生活中使用它们”符合。
40. E 根据空前关键词 the highest-paid jobs 和选项中照应词 high-paid jobs 可知,E 项“因此,不断发展的太空产业创造了高薪工作”符合。
41. B 根据空后“Half of it is a post office.”可知,这栋建筑(building)坐落在公路边。
42. A 根据空后“Rachel Luster took over this library four months ago. . .”可知,另一半是只有一个房间大小的图书馆(library)。
43. C 她的目标(goal)是把这里打造成该小镇与外界连接的桥梁及孩子们的学习(learning)中心。
44. D 见上题解析。
45. A 根据下文“I looked and looked. But we didn’t have”可知,她的第一个工作就是查找(searching for)《奥德赛》这本书。
46. B 当她发现图书馆的图书十分有限时,她开始利用社交媒体筹集(raise)资金。
47. C 迄今为止,她已经为图书馆添加了(added)一千多本书。
48. D 尽管该图书馆接受(receives)公共资金,但是每个月仅有 200 美金。



49. B 根据下文可知, 大部分的居民家里没有网络链接(access), 所以该图书馆成了小镇居民与外界联通的生命线(lifeline)。
50. C 见上题解析。
51. D 因此, 她希望让社区与外界联结(connectedness)起来。
52. A 根据下文“Now, as soon as I step off the school bus, I come here to...”可推断, Blake Brooks 是这里的常(regular)客。
53. C 这个小读者说, 在未发现(discovering)这个图书馆前, 他总是在家看电视。
54. B 现在, 他一放学就会到这里来阅读(read)。
55. D 他总是想象着(imagine)自己在书中遨游。
56. worried 考查动词的时态。根据空前的时间及谓语的时态“In elementary school, he didn’t speak up for himself...”可知, 该句叙述的是过去发生的事, 故用所给动词的过去式。
57. to develop 考查非谓语动词。make up one’s mind to do sth 意为“决心做某事”, 为固定搭配。
58. of 考查介词。make fun of 意为“取笑”, 为固定短语。
59. people’s 考查名词所有格。根据句意可知, feeling 与 people 之间存在所属关系, 故此处用所给名词的所有格形式。
60. was shocked 考查动词的时态和语态。根据时间状语 Then one day 可知, 此处用一般过去时, 又因为 shock 与 I 之间存在逻辑上的动宾关系, 故此处用被动语态。
61. absolutely 考查词形转换。此处用所给形容词的副词修饰空后的形容词, 作状语。
62. how 考查名词性从句。分析句子结构可知, 该空引导的是一个宾语从句。结合句意“‘我’开始留意别人对‘我’的幽默有何反应”可知, 此处用连接副词 how 作状语, 意为“如何”。
63. however/though 考查副词。根据句意可知, 此处表示转折关系, 故用 however 或 though。
64. being 考查非谓语动词。on 为介词, 故用所给动词的动名词 being 作宾语。
65. a 考查冠词。kind 为可数名词, 又因为该处是泛指, 故用不定冠词 a。
