21. A 细节理解题。根据 **Bodiam Castle, England** 一节 "Its visitor activities are dressing up in medieval clothes, afternoon tea with cakes..." 可知, 游客可在 Bodiam Castle 喝下午茶。

22. D 细节理解题。根据 **Castillo de Chapultepec, Mexico** 一节 "Nowadays Chapultepec is home to Mexico's National Museum of History." 并对比另外三个古堡信息可知, 如今 Castillo de Chapultepec 已成为墨西哥国家历史博物馆。

23. C 细节理解题。根据 **Castello Aragonese, Italy** 一节“... the castle can date back to the 5th century BC.”并对比另外三个古堡的建造时间可知, Castello Aragonese 历史最悠久。
24. B 细节理解题。根据第一段“**But one Texas high schooler wants to use that digital footprint to save lives.**”、第二段及第三段“... Pachipala... designed an app—SuiSensor...”可知, Siddhu Pachipala 开发这款应用软件是为了挽救年轻人的生命。
25. A 细节理解题。根据第三段“**People could download the app to take a self-assessment(评估) of their suicide risk. They could know their specific health care needs...**”及第四段“**It’s one of many efforts under way to use AI to help young people with their mental health...**”可知, 这款应用软件可以改善年轻人的心理健康。
26. D 推理判断题。根据最后一段“... Matt Nock... He adds Pachipala’s app could raise self-awareness about mental health issues that might otherwise go unrecognized.”可推断, Matt Nock 认为 SuiSensor 这款应用软件可以提高人们对易疏忽的心理健康问题的自我意识, 因而具有一定的实际意义。
27. C 文章出处题。通读全文可知, 文章主要介绍了美国得克萨斯州一名高中生开发一款用于检测青少年自杀倾向的应用软件。故本文可能出自报纸的科技板块。
28. B 细节理解题。根据第一段“**More than 5,500 deep-sea species live in the area... and around 90 percent of them have never been identified...**”可知, 在 CCZ 海域发现的深海物种当中, 约有 90% 是科学界尚未知晓的新生物。
29. C 词义猜测题。根据画线词后“**The species in this region share their home with one of the ocean’s largest known reserves of precious minerals(矿物) like nickel(Ni).**”及第五段可推断, 画线词与 A problem 的意思最接近。
30. A 细节理解题。根据第五段及第六段“**In the face of so many risks, over 700 scientists have signed a letter calling for an end to seabed mining operations...**”可知, 700 多位科学家联名写信叫停深海采矿作业是为了保护这些已被发现的深海生物。
31. D 推理判断题。根据最后一段“... we need further science to figure out what the damage might be.”可推断, Glover 的团队可能将开展深入研究以弄清深海采矿作业的影响。
32. A 段落大意题。通读第二段, 尤其是“**The challenge calls on people from around the world to create technologies to help feed astronauts on future long-term space missions.**”可知, 本段主要介绍此次挑战赛的目的。
33. B 细节理解题。根据第四段“**Phase 2 tasked over ten teams with showing new food production technologies... that use minimal(极少的) resources and create little waste while producing safe, healthy, and tasty foods for astronauts.**”可知, 在比赛的第二阶段参赛者的主要任务是利用最少的资源来产出食物。
34. C 细节理解题。根据第五段“... said Denise Morris... ‘The possibilities presented in this challenge could benefit our explorers on future missions, and even probably help out right here on Earth in areas where food is hard to produce.’”可知, Denise Morris 认为经此次大赛确认的解决方案可能有助于地球上的粮食生产。
35. B 推理判断题。通读最后一段, 并结合上文可推断, 作者意在补充此次深空食品挑战赛相关的背景信息。
36. C 根据空前“**There are many reasons to...**”及空后“**Other families may want to address a specific health concern.**”可知, C 项“有些家庭选择一起健身仅仅为了消遣”符合。
37. G 根据本节小标题及空前“... your challenge could be about any factor...”可知, G 项“花点时间确定你的健身目标, 这样可以帮你找到合适的健身挑战项目”符合。
38. F 根据本节小标题、空前“**You have decided what you are hoping to achieve for your family.**”及空后“**You can hold a family meeting to...**”可知, F 项“然后提出一些与这个目标契合的健身金点子”正好起到承上启下的作用。
