Sparky was able to save the baby's life, but the furry hero died from serious injuries just after coming out of the burning building. 21. A 推理判断题。根据 **Vancouver** 部分“Plus, its breath-taking mountains and beaches have been the setting for a group of popular television shows.”可知,温哥华令人叹为观止的山脉和海滩一直是受欢迎的电视节目的背景。由此可推断,温哥华吸引着制作电视节目的人。

22. D 细节理解题。根据 **Québec City** 部分“Since then, travelers have flooded here to experience this UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization) World Heritage site’s charm for themselves.”可知,魁北克市是联合国教科文组织授予的世界遗产地。
23. C 细节理解题。根据 **Montreal** 部分“Just when you thought you’d seen it all, a short elevator(电梯) ride exposes you to a huge consumer shopping center located several floors below ground level.”及 **Toronto** 部分“The city is... the world’s largest underground shopping mall, PATH.”可知,这两个城市的共同点是都有地下购物中心。
24. D 细节理解题。根据第二段“... their classroom doesn’t move like other classrooms to ensure Nehal consistently has a comfortable access to the facility every year.”可知,为了便于 Nehal 行动,他的教室不进行轮换。
25. A 细节理解题。根据第三段“To adapt to Nehal’s physical impairment(障碍), he has a special and lower desk positioned against a wall that he can lean on for additional back support.”可知,学校为 Nehal 安排特殊的桌子是为了照顾他的身体情况。
26. C 推理判断题。根据第五段“From being a shoulder to lean on as he walks around the school to making sure he joins in class projects, his classmates are always on hand to ensure Nehal is included in the day-to-day activities at school.”可推断,Nehal 的同学们对他的帮助很大。
27. B 推理判断题。Nehal 所在的学校为了照顾他把教室安排在离厕所近的地方。他的同学们给他提供了很大的帮助,老师们也很关注他的学习。此外他的父母认为他是上帝送给他们的礼物,所以他是幸运的。
28. A 细节理解题。根据第二段“In the Qing Dynasty, wood drifting became bamboo drifting because of bamboo’s lower price.”可知,到了清代,由于竹子的价格低于楠木,所以独“木”漂变成了独“竹”漂。
29. C 词义猜测题。画线部分所在句意为“因为掌握这门技艺需要具备出色的体能及平衡能力,所以‘独竹漂’被列入国家级非物质文化遗产代表性项目名录”可知,画线部分与 Master 的意思相近。
30. D 细节理解题。根据第四段“Yang said the most challenging part of bamboo drifting was keeping one’s balance.”可知,独竹漂最具有挑战性的是保持身体平衡。
31. A 推理判断题。根据最后一段“Yang also produces new ideas when spreading the culture of bamboo drifting. For example, she connects dance with bamboo drifting...”可推断,她创造性地继承了这一古老的技艺。
32. D 细节理解题。根据第二段“... the testing of the new high-tech tool in the battle to save some of the world’s most endangered species.”可知,机器人树獭的开发是为了拯救濒危物种。
33. B 代词指代题。根据画线词前后句意“慢是树獭机器人的设计原则,这不是当今机器人的典型设计方式,但缓慢和节能将使机器人在该环境中长期运转……”可知,此处 That 指的是 Slowness。
34. C 细节理解题。根据第五段“About three feet long, SlothBot’s imaginative 3D-printed shell helps protect...”可知,树獭机器人的外壳是用于保护内部装置的。
35. D 标题判断题。文章介绍了一款树獭机器人,它虽然行动缓慢,却身负重任。在不干扰环境的情况下,它能对研究对象进行全天候的监测,以便于人类更好地保护自然生态。
36. E 根据空前及文章正文可知,E项“本文列出了一系列生活中削减成本的有用方法”符合。
37. G 根据本段小标题及内容可知,G项“总的来说,在家做饭可以节省 20%或更多的就餐费用”符合。
38. C 根据空前“Spending \$1 or \$2 on bottled water or twice that much on a cup of coffee may not seem like much.”可知,C项“但这可能很快就会多达每周 20 美元或更多”符合。
39. B 此处缺少小标题。根据本段内容的关键词 a shopping list, go to the store 可知,B项“列出购物清单并按清单购物”符合。
40. F 根据空前“Add up how much you spend each month on fuel, parking and upkeep for your vehicle, and then compare that to public transportation costs.”可知,此处是两种方法进行比较,故 F 项“通过采用第二种

方法,你在方方面面都可以节省不少钱”符合。
