- 21. B 细节理解题。根据第三段第三句 The museum's exhibits are the best introduction to Alaska's diverse wildlife, people and lands.可知,博物馆的展品是对阿拉斯加各种野生动物、人民和陆地的最好介绍。
- 22. C 细节理解题。根据 Museum Hours 部分的"WINTER HOURS 2023 August 20 to March 30 (Open 7 days a week; 10 a.m.—5; 30 p.m.)"可知,在 10 月的 20 号上午 11 点可以去参观。
- 23. C 细节理解题。根据本文最后部分中 Free admission for one year.可知,会员可以免费参观一年。
- B篇 本文是一篇记叙文。在喀麦隆长大的 Darrin 从小对中国武术着迷。他梦想着有一天能学习中国武术并到访中国,最终他梦想成真。

24-27 DABC

- 24. D 细节理解题。根据第二段第二句"Aside from martial arts, he got to know about the country through photos and videos."可知,除了武术,他还通过照片和视频了解了中国。
- 25. A 推理判断题。根据第四段大意可知,自 2017 年以来, Darrin 参加了武术比赛, 特别是太极拳比赛, 并获得了多个奖项。他说, 太极拳可以帮助他变得强壮、健康、保持良好状态并培养出色的注意力。据此可知, 本段主要介绍的是太极拳对他的影响。
- 26. B 推理判断题。根据倒数第二段可知, Darrin 以他的中文名字刘汴京在一档电视节目中获得第二名。他说, 开封以前在中国古代被称为汴京。据此可知, 他称自己为汴京, 是表达对这座城市的热爱。
- 27. C 推理判断题。根据文章大意可知, 喀麦隆的 Darrin 对中国武术着迷, 并在武术领域取得很多奖项, 后又潜心学习汉语、豫剧, 并获奖。由此可知, 他雄心勃勃又多才多艺。
- C篇 本文是一篇说明文。"数盲症",亦称作"计算障碍症",是一种鲜为人知的学习障碍。研究人员统计,学生中高达 15%的人都有计算障碍,他们在处理数字时会感到极其困难。

- 28. D 推理判断题。根据第一段第二句可知,这些学生可能难以掌握数字符号的含义或理解空间处理,例如物体 在他们脑海中的旋转。据此可知,"数盲症"患者更难应对抽象数学问题。
- 29. A 细节理解题。根据第三段最后一句可知,根据倡导者的说法,对这种疾病的研究在 1990 年代随着 MRI 技术的广泛使用而开始。由此可知,随着技术的应用,该研究得以开始。
- 30. C 推理判断题。根据倒数第二段中 Cladek 说的话"Growing up with dyscalculia greatly affected my self-worth and not feeling like I am enough,"可知,患有计算障碍的成长极大地影响了 Cladek 的自我价值,总感觉自己不够好。由此可知,对一个成长过程中的人来说"数盲症"是一个巨大的挑战。
- 31. B 推理判断题。根据文中提到的 students、math teachers 以及 K-12 等关键信息词汇可知,本文是有关学生和教师的,故本文应出现在教育板块。
- D 篇 本文是一篇说明文。最近的一项研究通过显示世界变暖和世界范围内人类与野生动物冲突的增加之间的 联系,证明了人类与环境的交织性。

32. C 词句猜测题。根据划线词前后语境可知,"我们发现人类与野生动物之间的冲突因气候变化而在六大洲,

五个不同的海洋,海洋系统,淡水系统中"___"——涉及哺乳动物,鸟类,鱼类等等"。结合选项,确定"加剧"最符合语境。

- 33. A 推理判断题。根据第二段后半部分的举例可知,例如,北极地区的变暖导致了海冰的消失,使北极熊缺乏食物。它们越来越多地在陆地上行走,有时会进入人类居住区并攻击人,最近在阿拉斯加发生的事件就说明了这一点。据此推知,作者提及北极熊的例子旨在说明:气候变化可以通过改变动物栖息地来推动冲突。
- 34. B 推理判断题。根据第四段可知,随着气候变化的加剧,这些类型的冲突可能会上升,特别是随着人和野生动物的大规模迁移增加和资源的转移。据此可知,资源的转移可能导致冲突上升。
- 35. D 推理判断题。根据最后一段最后一句可知, Abrahms 认为, 一旦你知道冲突的根本原因, 你就可以设计干预措施, 以帮助人类和野生动物。据此可知, 他认为干预措施是有益的。

七选五 本文是一篇说明文。文章讲述了在灾难降临之后如何尽自己的一份绵薄之力。

- 36. G 上文提到如果您了解受影响的人,它会产生更深的影响;下文讲到找到办法帮助他们很有用。选项 G"如果灾难发生在家附近或影响您认识的人,压力可能会更大"承上启下,符合语境。
- 37. C 下文提到查看红十字会等团体的网站。或者联系当地社区中心、礼拜场所或其他为提供帮助而设立的组织。选项 C"了解人们需要什么样的帮助"总领本段主旨。
- 38. F 上文提到你可以以家庭为单位做一些事情。选项 F"或者你可以在学校做点什么,或者和你所属社区的人一起做点什么"紧承前文,符合语境。
- 39. B 本段主题是"计划你要做什么,并实现它"。下文提到在你找到需要的东西后,你会想要发布一份清单,列出要携带的物品以及何时何地投递,选项 B"假设您计划收集补给品"引起下文并呼应主题。
- 40. A 下文提到给予是给人们的生活带来积极变化的一种方式。即使是小小的善举和给予也会产生影响。选项 E"你的行为帮助了他人"符合语境。

M: Four children who were missing and feared dead after a plane crash a month ago have been found alive and well. The children, aged 13, nine, four and a one-year-old baby, were on a plane that crashed in the Amazon jungle in Colombia on May the first. The children's mother, the pilot and co-pilot died in the crash. Before the plane disappeared, the pilot issued a mayday alert, citing engine failure. Moments later, it disappeared from radar screens. The children had been missing for 40 days when members of Colombia's military found them. Colombia's President said news of the children's discovery was "a joy for the whole country" and a "magical day". He added: "They were alone. They themselves accomplished an example of total survival which will remain in history. These children are today the children of peace and the children of Colombia." The children's knowledge of what can be eaten in the jungle and their experience probably gave them a better chance of survival.
