作文评分细则:

优秀(22-25): 紧扣主题, 覆盖所有要点, 内容充实; 语法结构多样, 词汇丰富, 行文流畅, 显示出较强的语言运用能力, 允许有个别语言错误, 但不影响意思表达。

良好(18-21): 紧扣主题, 覆盖所有要点, 内容较充实, 行文较流畅, 语言有少量错误, 但基本不影响意思表达。

一般(15-17): 紧扣主题, 基本覆盖所有要点, 语言错误已影响了部分意思的表达, 但多数句子基本正确; 基本达到预期写作目的。

较差(11-14): 要点不全, 内容不完整, 行文不够连贯; 语言错误较多, 半数句子基本正确。

差(6-10): 内容混乱, 或主要内容偏离主题, 尚能够写出少数与内容相关的可读句。

极差(0-5): 只能写出与内容相关的词语, 没有有效信息; 抄写其他文章, 或只是写出与作文无关的内容。

29.D 考查细节理解。根据第二段内容可知疫苗在肌肉组织中能够产生更好的免疫反应, 从而产生抗体, 因而 D 正确。

30.B 考查词义猜测。根据后文 side effect, 以及上下文理解可知 irritation 指疫苗接种引起的异常反应, 因而 B 正确。

31.C 考查篇章理解。由本文最后一句 Yet another deciding factor in vaccine administration location is the size of the muscle as well as convenience.可知接下来文章会讲接种疫苗的位置在肌肉大小和方便性方面的考虑。

32.C 考查细节理解。根据第二段内容 So far in 2021, the island's melted area (8.2 million square miles) is way above the 1981 to 2010 average-to-date...可知 C 项正确。

33.A 考查细节理解。根据第三段内容 That's because the melt in Greenland is getting more extreme with every decade due to human interference with the climate.可知 A 正确。

34.B 考查推理判断。根据倒数第二段内容可知, 格陵兰岛作为世界上最冷的地方之一, 冰天雪地, 竟然下雨, 说明气候已经剧变, 因而 B 正确。

35.B 考查文章大意。本文主要内容讲述了格陵兰岛比过去历史上任何时期都严重的大面积融化事件, 因而 B 正确。
