- 25. A 推理判断题。根据第三段"She explained that these dreams tend to pop up when the dreamer is anxious in waking life, particularly when evaluated by an authority figure."可知,当做梦者在清醒状态下处于焦虑状态,尤其是当自己的表现被权威人士评估的时候,这种梦就会出现。
- 26. B 推理判断题。根据最后一段"'So much stuff happens in school that really sets your foundational beliefs and really sticks there in your unconscious mind. It can be very hard to let go of those beliefs,' she said"可知,学校经历中形成的基础性信念会很难舍弃,会牢牢地保留在一个人的无意识思维中。这表明学校经历对人们生活的影响是持久而且重要的。
- 27. C 推理判断题。根据最后一段"feeling tested in life, feeling that you have to respond to other people's expectations, and feeling that you're not meeting those expectations."可知,接受考验,不断需要满足别人的期望, 甚至感觉无法满足一些人的期望,这表明关于学校压力的梦可能表示梦者在生活中遇到困难或失望。

- 28. A 细节理解题。根据第三段"With the release of the news that nearly 90 million Facebook users' information was passed on to political ad targeting firm Cambridge Analytica without their permission, tech companies are defending themselves."可知,近期 Facebook 用户隐私泄露事件的披露促使大型科技公司进行自我辩护。
- 29. D 细节理解题。根据第四段可知:苹果公司声称其处理用户数据的方法与其他大型科技公司不同,它收集的用户数据比其他公司少,将大部分数据存储在用户设备上,而不是在苹果服务器上,并且对这些数据进行加密,只能通过密码访问。
- 30. B 词义猜测题。根据第四段"it collects less data about us than the other big tech companies and then ensures the security by scrambling it so it doesn't identify who it comes from"可知,苹果公司通过"scrambling"这些数据来混 淆它们,使其不能识别数据来源。在这里,"scrambling"意味着将数据随机混合以保护用户隐私。
- 31. C 主旨大意题。根据第一段"Is Apple the shining knight when it comes to privacy collection, as it wants us to believe?"引出话题,虽然苹果公司在处理用户数据方面做出了努力,整篇文章全是苹果公司单方面宣传自己的数据系统多么安全,但是从文章开头句就能看出来作者对其是怀疑的。

文章讨论了尼古丁如何影响发育中的青少年大脑,以及它如何导致青少年在心理和行为方面的问题。

- 32. B 细节理解题。根据文章第二段"The area of the brain responsible for emotions and controlling our wild impulses is known as the prefrontal cortex(前额叶皮层)."可知,前额叶皮层是负责调节情绪和控制冲动行为的大脑区域。
- 33. C 细节理解题。根据文章第五段"the brains of teens who smoke or vape may create more receptors to handle the flood of nicotine they have come to expect"可知,吸烟或使用电子烟的青少年的大脑可能会制造更多的接受尼古丁的受体来处理其预期的尼古丁洪流。随着接受受体数量的增加,青少年需要更多的尼古丁才能获得相同的感觉。A 选项是错误的,文章没有提到这一点;B 选项也是错误的,文章指出尼古丁可以在吸烟或电子烟吸入后7秒内到达大脑;D 选项也是错误的,文章没有把尼古丁对青少年大脑的影响和其他年龄的人进行对比。
- 34. D 观点态度题。根据文章最后一段得知, Garry Sigman 对青少年接触尼古丁的态度是关心的。
- 35. A 文章标题题。文章探讨了尼古丁如何影响大脑功能,以及反复接触尼古丁后青少年的大脑可能会发生变化。因此 A 选项是最合适的标题。

七选五

- 36. B 根据空格前"why adults have set the rules in the first place"并结合空格后的"Kids don't always realize this and can get into a lot of trouble ..."可知,空白处是家长制定规则的原因和目的,故只有 B 项"通常,这是为了保护孩子们免受伤害"符合。
- 37. C 根据空格后的内容可知此处是说孩子们从小时候就被告知要遵守相应的规则。故选 C 项。
- 38. F 此题有一定难度。根据第四段首句 "As a result, children may become upset that they've been bound by rules that they have no say over."可知,空格处应填造成孩子被束缚而感到生气的句子,故只有F项符合文意。干扰项D说孩子们认为家长定规矩只是对家长自己更有益,虽然承前,但是不能和第四段段首句形成因果关系,故排除。
- 39. G 根据空格后"Nevertheless, the effects of doing this could be damaging for them."可知,空格处应是某个造成 负面后果的行为,故只有 G 项合适。
- 40. E 空格前说明此段为解决措施,且空格后有一个问句,是以 what if 并列的排比句,再根据文章后面"had a voice"可知,选项 E 中的"让孩子们参与"是同义替换,能够完整对应。选项 A 只是一个针对该现象的具体提问,和段首句的意思重复,故排除,因此选 E。

- 42. A. contacted 根据语境,"加拿大儿童心愿基金会"联系了作者,所以用 contacted(联系)比较恰当。B. followed 追随, C. introduced 介绍, D. commanded 命令,均不符合题意。
- 43. C. battling 此处意为"她与癌症作斗争已经两年多了",因此应选择 battling(与……作斗争)。A. competing 竞争,B. staying 停留,待,D. compromising 妥协,折中,均不符合题意。
- 44. C. request 根据文章, "儿童心愿基金会"接到了 Nicole 的请求,因此应该选择 request(请求)。A. attraction 吸引, B. response 反应, D. attachment 依恋, 均不符合题意。
- 45. A. arranging 根据语境, "儿童心愿基金会"答应了 Nicole 的请求,并安排她与作者见面。因此应选择 arranging (安排)。B. ordering 命令, C. launching 发起, D. designing 设计, 均不符合题意。
