As the summer vacation approaches, Wu Ruixing, 21, a junior from Shanghai Jiao Tong University (SJTU), is in the middle of preparing for the upcoming exams and also thinking about his VEX robotics team's future.

Founded in 2018, the SJTU VEX team has an enviable record in VEX Robotics Competitions at all levels, during which students in more than 20,000 teams from 50 countries compete against other teams. For the 2022-2023 competition season, the student participants from SJTU won several awards, including the EXU Robot Skills Challenge World Champion and the Design Division Champion.

"For most of us, it was our first time taking part in the World Championship. We had been burning the midnight oil for a while to prepare for the competition, but it became worth it when we got the championship trophy," Wu said. During the competition, Wu was deeply impressed by the unique robotic designs from other universities. "They were both strong opponents. The University of Wisconsin was a good defender and Team Pyro from Arizona State University provided a brand-new game strategy that really blew my mind." Wu recalled.

For Wu, the competition helped him find a deeper passion for robotics. He has had a love for robotics since childhood. So when he heard that there was a robotics competition on campus a year ago, he and his friends signed up. "During that competition, I found a big gap between me and the top players, which motivated me to join the team," he said. Driven by his interest, Wu began participating in various competitions, which also helped him with his coursework studies.

Returning home with fruitful results, the team became celebrities on campus, but Wu hasn't let the success get to his head. "Now we need to prepare for the new competition season," he said. As a world champion, Wu is even more determined to pursue an academic career in robotics, and he hopes that his team will continue to interact with more robot lovers in the future.

Tell a charming story. This can be a personal anecdote about why you are passionate about the topic, or an anecdote about another person who the audience can learn from. Make sure that the story comes from your heart rather than your head. 36

Ask a rhetorical question. When rhetorical questions are crafted and delivered well, they can persuade an audience to side with your position. 37 You can ask, for example, “Would you like to see a loved one suffer for no reason at all?”

Use powerful quotes. 38 Moreover, quotes demonstrate that you are knowledgeable about the topic. Your quote should be related to the topic, and relevant to the audience. Also, try to quote well-known people, or people your audience knows.

Establish definitions. The key terms in the debate need to be explained and defined by the first speaker. Also, define key terms that the audience might not know very well. Identify the key terms in your argument and look up their definitions in a range of dictionaries. 39

Make eye contact with audience members. Practice holding eye contact with someone you know for a minute or two. Repeat the exercise 5 or 6 times—that will really help a lot. 40 By making eye contact, you can also judge their reactions by reading their facial expressions.
