应用文写作评分标准

一、评分细则

1. 本题总分为15分，分五个档次进行评分。
2. 评分时应主要从内容组织、词汇语法和篇章结构三个方面考虑。具体为：
 - (1) 对于内容要点的覆盖情况以及表述的清楚程度和合理性。
 - (2) 使用词汇和语法结构的准确性、恰当性和多样性。
 - (3) 上下文的衔接和全文的连贯性。
3. 评分时，先根据作答的整体情况初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来综合衡量确定或调整档次，最后给分。
4. 评分时还应注意：
 - (1) 词数少于60的，酌情扣分。
 - (2) 单词拼写和标点符号是写作规范的重要方面，评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑，英美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
 - (3) 书写较差，以至影响交际的将分数降低一个档次。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求

- 第五档：(13-15) 能写明全部要点，语言基本无误，行文连贯，表达无误。
- 第四档：(10-12) 能写明全部或绝大部分要点，语言有少量错误，行文不够连贯，表达基本清楚。
- 第三档：(7-9) 能写明基本要点，语言虽有较多错误，但能基本达意。
- 第二档：(4-6) 能写出部分要点，语言错误多，影响意思表达。
- 第一档：(1-3) 只能写出一两个要点，里面错误很多，只有个别句子正确。

读后续写评分标准

一、评分原则：

1. 本题总分为 25 分, 按五个档次进行评分。
2. 评分时, 应主要从内容、词汇语法和篇章结构三个方面考虑, 具体为:
 - (1) 续写内容的质量、完整性以及与原文情境的融洽度。
 - (2) 所使用词汇和语法结构的准确性、恰当性和多样性。
 - (3) 语句间的衔接和全文的连贯性。
3. 评分时, 应先根据作答的整体情况确定其所属的档次, 然后以该档次的要求来综合衡量, 确定或调整档次, 最后给分。
4. 评分时还应注意:
 - (1) 词数少于 120 的, 酌情扣分;
 - (2) 书写较差以致影响交际的, 酌情扣分;
 - (3) 单词拼写和标点符号是写作规范的重要方面, 评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑, 英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求:

档 次	描 述
第五档 (21-25)	——创造了丰富、合理的内容, 富有逻辑性, 续写完整, 与原文情境融洽度高; ——使用了多样且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 表达流畅, 可能有个别小错, 但完全不影响理解; ——有效地使用了语句间的衔接手段, 全文结构清晰, 前后呼应, 意义连贯;
第四档 (16-20)	——创造了比较丰富、合理的内容, 比较有逻辑性, 续写比较完整, 与原文情境融洽度较高; ——使用了比较多样且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 表达比较流畅, 可能有些许错误, 但不影响理解; ——比较有效地使用了语句间的衔接手段, 全文结构比较清晰, 意义比较连贯;
第三档 (11-15)	——创造了基本合理的内容, 有一定的逻辑性, 续写基本完整, 与原文情境有关联; ——使用了简单的词汇和语法结构, 有一些错误和不恰当之处, 但基本不影响理解; ——基本有效的使用了语句间的衔接手段, 全文结构基本清晰, 意义基本连贯。
第二档 (6-10)	——内容和逻辑有一些重大问题, 续写不完整, 与原文情境有一定程度的脱节; ——所用的词汇有限, 语法结构单调, 错误较多, 且比较低级, 影响理解; ——未能有效的使用语句间的衔接手段, 全文结构不够清晰, 意义不够连贯;
第一档 (1-5)	——内容或逻辑有较多重大问题, 或部分内容抄自原文, 续写不完整, 与原文情境基本脱节; ——所使用的词汇有限, 语法结构简单, 错误较多, 严重影响理解; ——几乎没有使用语句间衔接手段, 全文结构不清晰, 意义不连贯;
0	——未作答, 所写内容太少或无法看清以致无法评判; ——所写内容全部抄自原文或与题目要求完全不相关。
