"For me, autumn is like a wise man, teaching us to appreciate the efforts, to accept the gift of nature and prepare for whatever comes our way.

一、 作文评分原则

- 1. 本题总分为15分,按5个档次进行评分。
- 2. 评分时, 先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次, 然后以该档次的要求确定或调整 档次,最后给分。评分时,应注意的主要内容为:
- (1) 内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的数量和准确性。

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- (2) 上下文的连贯性及语言的得体性。
- (3) 拼写和标点符号是语言准确性的一方面,评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
- 英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
- (4) 如书写较差,以至影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
- (5) 内容要点可用不同方式表达,对紧扣主题的适当发挥不予扣分。

二、 各档次的给分范围和要求

档次	描述
第五档(13~15 分)	一完全完成了试题规定的任务,覆盖所有内容要点。一应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。一语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误,但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致;具备较强的语言运用能力。一有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。一完全达到了预期的写作目的。
第四档(10~12 分)	——完全完成了试题规定的任务,虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点,但覆盖所有主要内容。——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。——语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。——应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。——达到了预期的写作目的。
第三档(7~9 分)	一基本完成了试题规定的任务,虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖所有主要内容。 一一应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。 一一有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,但不影响理解。 一一应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文内容连贯。 一一整体而言,基本达到了预期的写作目的。
第二档(4~6 分)	——未恰当完成试题规定的任务,漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容,写了一些无关内容。 ——语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。 ——有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解。 ——较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性。 ——信息未能清楚地传达给读者。
第一档(1~3 分)	——未完成试题规定的任务,明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,原因可能是未理解试题要求。 ——语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。 ——较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解。 ——缺乏语句间的连接成分,内容不连贯。 ——信息未能传达给读者。
零分	未能传达给读者任何信息;内容太少,无法评判;写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法读懂。

一、 读后续写评分原则

- 1. 本题总分为 25 分, 按五个档次进行评分。
- 2. 评分时,应主要从内容、词汇语法和篇章结构三个方面考虑,具体为:
- (1) 创造内容的质量,续写的完整性以及与原文情境的融洽度。
- (2) 使用词汇和语法结构的准确性、恰当性和多样性。
- (3) 上下文的衔接和全文的连贯性。
- 评分时,先根据作答的整体情况初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来综合衡量,确定或调整档次,最后给分。
- 4. 评分时还应注意:
- (1) 词数少于 120 的, 酌情扣分。
- (2)单词拼写和标点符号是写作规范的重要方面,评分时应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。 英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
- (3) 书写较差以致影响交际的, 酌情扣分。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求

第五档(21~25 分)	——创造了丰富、合理的内容,富有逻辑性,续写完整,与原文情境融治度高。 ——使用了多样并且恰当的词汇和语法结构,可能有个别小错,但完全不影响理解。 ——有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构清晰,意义连贯。
第四档(16~20 分)	——创造了比较丰富、合理的内容,比较有逻辑性,续写比较完整,与原文情境融洽度较高。 ——使用了比较多样并且恰当的词汇和语法结构,可能有些许错误,但不影响理解。 ——比较有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构比较清晰,意义比较连贯。
第三档(11~15 分)	——创造了基本合理的内容,有一定的逻辑性,续写基本完整,与原文情境相关。 ——使用了简单的词汇和语法结构,有一些错误或不恰当之处,但基本不影响理解。 ——基本有效地使用了语句间衔接手段,全文结构基本清晰,意义基本连贯。
第二档(6~10 分)	一内容或逻辑上有一些重大问题,续写不够完整,与原文情境有一定程度脱节。一所使用的词汇有限,语法结构单调,错误较多,影响理解。一未能有效地使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不够清晰,意义不够连贯。
第一档(1~5 分)	——内容或逻辑上有较多重大问题,或有部分内容抄自原文,续写不完整,与原文情境基本脱节。——所使用的词汇有限,语法结构单调,错误很多,严重影响理解。——几乎没有使用语句间衔接手段,全文结构不清晰,意义不连贯。
零分	未作答;所写内容太少或无法看清以致无法评判;所写内容与题目要求完全不相关。

- 21. C 细节理解题。根据表格 Boom Season 一栏可知,最佳旅游季节是"May to October",故选择 C 项。
- 22. B 细节理解题。题干提到的 nightlife 对应 **Must-See Attractions** 下的第二个景点 Canal Ring,故选择 B 项。

23. D 细节理解题。根据 **Money Saving Tips** 中的 "Look for accommodations in Amsterdam's South District,where rates are generally cheaper than in the city center. "可知,在南区预订酒店可以省钱。

【语篇导读】本文主要介绍了作者在其儿子在芝加哥上大学期间,向厨师 Benny Moy 学做中国菜的经历和感受。

- 24. D 推理判断题。根据第二段 "The dishes Benny prepared were unique, and everything was in his mind when he was cooking." 以及 "Just by changing, adding or removing an ingredient or two, he could come up with an entirely new dish."可推测出 Benny 的菜肴 很特别和与众不同。A. Nutritious and salty. 营养丰富,咸味十足;B. Conventional and tasty. 传统美味;C. Original and spicy. 原汁原味,辛辣可口。故选择 D 项。
- 25. C 推理判断题。根据第一段 "One of them was a Chinese restaurant called The Bird. It was owned and operated by Chef Benny Moy who happened to be an old friend of George's." 可知 Benny 经营了一家中餐馆。
- 26. A 词义猜测题。根据后文"I would just follow him around, trying very hard not to get in his way. Besides, I would talk into my hand-held recorder to document everything he did; in effect, I had all his recipes."以及"And I just watched and learned everything he did by heart."可知作者学习中国菜一切进展顺利。B. Be in chaos. 陷入混乱; C. Take a downturn. 有些衰退; D. Get worse gradually. 越来越糟。故选择 A 项。
- 27. D 最佳标题题。通读全文可知,本文主要介绍了作者在其儿子在芝加哥上大学期间,向厨师 Benny Moy 学做中国菜的经历和感受。A. Creating Innovative Dishes 创造创新菜肴; B. Observing Cooking Procedures 观察烹饪流程; C. Appreciating Favorite Recipes 欣赏喜爱的食谱。故选择 D 项。

体裁: 说明文 **题材:** 研究与发现 **主题**: 莫高窟壁画的年代测定新方法

【语篇导读】本文主要介绍了研究人员开发出一种新的测定方法来确定中国莫高窟古代壁画的年代。

28. C 细节理解题。根据第一段的"However, some are still left with the creation era(年代) uncertain due to the lack of reference materials or the disagreement of art experts."可知,一些壁画未能确定年代的原因是缺乏参考资料或艺术专家的意见分歧。故选择 C 项。

知,本段主要介绍新的确定莫高窟壁画年代的方法。

30. C 推理判断题。根据后文 "To figure out the creation era of these paintings, Qin Zou, a researcher from Wuhan University, collected 3,860 mural paintings from 194 different grottoes with confirmed creation-era labels. To find the visual codes that can identify the era in these paintings, the authors built a deep convolutional neural network (卷积神经网络) and classified these painting images into the right eras. Based on the classification model, a dating method was built and applied to date the seven paintings." 可知,研究人员收集了 3860 个已知年代的壁画,并以此创作视觉代码,研究人员还建立卷积神经网络并将这些壁画分类到正确年代。这些壁画在分类模型的基础上,建立了一种年代测定方法,并将其应用于七幅画的年代测定。所以推断出本段解释壁画分类模型的创造。故选择 C 项。

31. A 细节理解题。根据最后一段"'To the best of our knowledge,' wrote the researchers, 'this work represents the first account of a scientific and quantitative manner to support the era prediction and reduce the uncertainties in dating ancient paintings by using deep learning.'"可知,这项工作首次以科学和定量的方式支持时代预测,并通过深度学习减少古画年代测定的不确定性。因此这是一个突破,故选择 A 项。

D

体裁: 说明文 题材: 科普知识 主题: 番茄受到攻击时能向其母株发出警报

【语篇导读】最近发表的一项研究表明当番茄果实感应到附近的昆虫时,会释放出信号到达植物的其他部分,并因此做好防御入侵者的准备。

32. A 推理判断题。根据第一段 "A study published recently shows that tomato fruits are able to transmit alerts to their mother plant when attacked by caterpillars." 和最后一段 "The scientists now plan on investigating whether other fruiting plants behave in the same manner as tomatoes, and whether their fruits respond to threats other than insects."可知,本文主要介绍番茄受攻击时能向其母株发出警报的新发现,复合 A 项的 Frontiers in Sustainable Food Systems 《可持续食物系统前沿》;B. Extraordinary Architects《非凡建筑师》;C. National Geographic《国家地理》;D. The Economist《经济学人》。故选择 A 项。

pathways,which are generally transmitted through the sap" 以及 "sap typically only runs

from the plant to the fruit — not back and forth between the two — it has long been

unclear whether or not fruits can transmit information to the plant. "可知,树液可以传递

信息。A. 可以传送信号的往返车; B. 可以防止攻击的防火墙; C. 存放信息的庇

护所; D. 水流的通道。故选择 A 项。

34. D 细节理解题。根据第四段 "The tomato fruit, sensing a nearby insect, released electrical

signals to reach the rest of the plant. "可知,番茄果实在受到昆虫袭击时会释放出信号。

35. C 推理判断题。根据最后一段第一句 "The scientists now plan on investigating whether other fruiting plants behave in the same manner as tomatoes, and whether their fruits respond to threats other than insects."可知,科学家计划调查其他果树植物及其对昆虫

以外的其他威胁的反应,从而得知科学家要扩大研究领域。故选择C项。

第二节

体裁: 说明文 题材: 人与动物 主题: 养宠物存在的普遍错误及解决办法

【语篇导读】本文讲述的是养宠物的人常犯的几种典型错误以及对应的解决办法。

36. G 设空处前一句提到所有的宠物都需要定期的锻炼和精神刺激来保持健康和快乐,空后说明精神刺激同等重要及其具体做法。由此推知,此处应指出宠物没有充分锻炼所招致的后果。G项(没有充分的体育锻炼,宠物可能会变胖或感觉无聊)符合语境。故选 G 项。

37. D 设空处前一句提到过度喂养弊大于利,由此推知,此处应具体说明过度喂养的弊端。 D 项(它可能会导致肥胖以及其他严重的疾病)符合语境,且其中"It"指代上文中的"overfeeding"。故选 D 项。

- 38. C 上文讲到社交是让狗狗表现良好和快乐的关键。根据空前"Make sure to introduce your puppy to different people, animals and situations."可知,设空处应给出这样做之后的好处。C项(它可以帮助它们变得自信且能很好地适应环境)符合语境,且其中"It"指代上文中的做法。故选 C 项。
- 39. A 分析文章结构可知,设空处应为本部分的小标题。下文提到宠物很擅长隐藏它们的 痛苦和不适,因此观察它们的行为和食欲的变化是很重要的。如果你发现有什么不对 劲,不要犹豫,告诉你的兽医。A项(忽视疾病的征兆)符合本段的主旨。故选 A 项。
- 40. F 本段的小标题是解决潜在的焦虑原因,空后提到给你的宠物提供大量有趣的活动和玩耍时间,以保持它们身心活跃和快乐,由此可知, F 项(基于焦虑的行为可能源于缺乏关注或刺激)符合语境。故选 F 项。

【语篇导读】本文讲述的是作者在非洲长大的经历,在成长的过程中作者意识到一个人要获得自尊就要先学会接受自己本来的面目。

- 41. C 根据下文内容并结合最后一段可知,此处应表示回首过去,"我"意识到了接受自己有多么重要。accept 意为"接受",符合语境。forgive 原谅; examine 检查; rescue 营救。
- 42. B 根据下文内容可知,此处应表示"我"在非洲出生和长大,一直把"我"的非洲血统当作负担。burden 意为"负担",符合语境。trouble 麻烦; honor 荣耀; advantage 优势,有利条件。
- 43. D 根据下文内容可知,此处应表示在移居挪威后,"我"的自我厌恶加剧了。fueled 意为"加剧",符合语境。weakened 削弱: hidden 隐藏; explored 探索。
- 44. A 根据下文 "To my _____48 ___, she had a thin sheet of sweat on her nose too, and it was in November!"可知,此处是原词复现,句意为:不管天气如何,我的鼻头上总是有一层薄汗。sweat 意为 "汗水",符合语境。freckle 雀斑; spot 斑点; mark 印记。
- 45. C 根据上下文可知,此处应表示导致"我"自我厌恶的还有"我"的口吃。contributed to 意为"导致",符合语境。sped up 加速; washed away 冲走; held back 抑制。
- 46. A 根据上文可知,此处应表示"我"把它当作逃避任何公开演讲的借口。excuse 意为 "借口",符合语境。trick 诡计; lie 谎言; plan 计划。
- 47. C 根据下文可知,此处应表示幸好,转折点出现了。Fortunately 意为"幸好",符合语境。Naturally 自然而然地;Obviously 显然地;Constantly 经常性地。
- 48. B 根据上下文可知,此处应表示令"我"惊讶的是,"我"见到的小女孩鼻头也有一层薄汗,而且这是在 11 月。astonishment 意为"惊讶",符合语境。delight 高兴; horror 恐惧; disappointment 失望。
- 49. C 根据上文可知,此处应表示"我"自言自语地说,这不是遗传疾病,这很正常。normal 意为"正常的",符合语境。suitable 合适的; necessary 必要的; significant 意义重大的。
- 50. A 根据上下文可知,此处应表示"我"人生中的又一个转折点出现了。twist 意为"转折",符合语境。route 路线; direction 方向; risk 冒险。
- 51. B 句意为:上网寻找口吃的治疗方法时,我偶然间了解到像牛顿和丘吉尔这样的名人也患有口吃,我感到极大的宽慰。accidentally 意为"偶然地",符合语境。secretly 暗暗地; originally 最初,原来; deliberately 故意地。

- 52. B 请见 51。amused 被逗乐的; confused 困惑的; touched 感动的。
- 53. D 根据上文可知,此处应表示当"我"知道奥普拉·温弗瑞,著名的主持人兼作家也是一位黑人时,我又一次增强了自信。boost 意为"增强",符合语境。threat 威胁; key 关键; blow 打击。
- 54. D 根据上下文可知,此处应表示今天,"我"已经很骄傲地接受了自己,它只是给我一种独特的感觉。uniqueness 意为"独特",符合语境。loneliness 孤独; warmth 温暖; satisfaction 满意。
- 55. C 根据上文可知,此处应表示自爱的理念给"我"呈现了一种全新的意义。take on 意为"呈现",符合语境。take up 开始从事,占据; take away 带走; take in 吸收,欺骗。

- 56. aged 考查非谓语动词。分析句子结构可知,句中已有谓语 joined 和 glided,且与设空之间无连词连接,设空处应填非谓语动词;而过去分词 aged 表示"……岁的",表状态。故填 aged。
- 57. gradually 考查词性转换。此处修饰后面的动词 moved,应用副词形式。故填 gradually。
- 58. who 考查定语从句。分析句子结构可知,设空处引导非限制性定语从句,先行词 Liu 指人,关系词在从句中作主语,应用关系代词 who。故填 who。
- 59. from 考查介词。句意为: 但是技巧源于练习。come from 为固定搭配。故填 from。
- 60. Wearing 考查非谓语动词。分析句子结构可知,句中已有谓语 adds,且与设空之间无连词连接,设空处应填非谓语动词; wear 与 Liu 之间为逻辑上的主动关系,应用现在分词形式。故填 Wearing。
- 61. protection 考查词性转换。此处为固定短语 under the protection of sb., 意为"在某人的保护下"。故填 protection。
- 62. Although/Though 考查从属连词。句意为: 虽然她滑雪的次数比往年少了, 但她决心坚持下去。Although/Though 引导让步状语从句。故填 Although/Though。
- 63. to persevere 考查非谓语动词。此处为固定短语 be determined to do sth., 意为"下定决心做某事"。故填 to persevere。
- 64. has brought 考查动词的时态及主谓一致。根据句中 over the past years 这一时间状语可知,应用现在完成时,又因为主语是 doing sports,为单数概念,谓语应用第三人称。故填 has brought。
- 65. courageous 考查词性转换。分析句子结构可知,此处应填形容词,与后面的 optimistic 保持一致。故填 courageous。
