University of Auckland

With 30,000 full time students, and 10,000 distant learners, it is the largest university in New Zealand. Established in 1883, it is also one of the oldest ones. It ranks number one in the country, and among top 236 universities worldwide. It comprises of 7 campuses altogether that spread across Auckland. Each campus offers specific courses in different areas of study.

University of Otago

It is the oldest university of New Zealand. Established in 1869 in Otago, the university continues to offer the best educational practices. It is ranked among the top 2 universities of New Zealand, and among 309 universities in the world. The students could enroll(报名) in one of its 5 campuses. Currently, around 20,000 students study in the university, and thousands apply every year.

University of Canterbury

One reason for around 15,000 students join Canterbury University is the fact that it is ranked as the third best university of New Zealand, and among the top 450 universities in the world. Founded in 1873, it is the second oldest university of the country. The university comprises of mainly five colleges or departments. The university offers more than 100 qualifications from undergraduate to doctoral levels in around 80 different subject areas.

Massey University

It is situated in Palmerston North, however, its campuses are spread across Auckland, Albany, Manawatu and Wellington. Established in 1927, it ranks among the top 4 universities of New Zealand, and top 531 universities in the world. The university is a heaven for international students as more than 3,000 students from around 100 countries study here. It also offers distant education programs through which around 13,000 students from all over the world have joined the institution.

1 The Appalachian Trail(AT) winds some 2,190 miles across 14 states in the eastern US. Crossing almost continuous wilderness, the popular hiking trail follows the Appalachian Mountains. Although it attracts thousands of serious hikers each spring, only one in four hikers completes the entire trail.

2 The Sutton family recently finished hiking the entire trail. They are a unique trio(三人一组) as their son Harvey turned five on the trail, making him the youngest to complete the 2,100 Appalachian Trail.

3 When Harvey turned three, he took to the trail so well and flourished in the outdoor life, and later the family planned a hike on the Appalachian Trail, which generally takes five to seven months to complete.

4 Since the Suttons were hiking with their four-year-old boy, they decided to get a head start and hit the trail in Georgia on January 13, 2021. The first weeks were cold. The trail was icy and snow-covered, and the weather was often cloudy and bitter, yet they trudged north. They would wake up early each day, pack up everything, and then start walking. They had many miles to cover each day, and had to be inventive and imaginative to keep the Little Man motivated.

5 Having made the final climb up Mount Katahdin in Maine, the family completed their journey on August 9, 2021. Little Man learned to count all the way to 2,193, the total miles his little feet traveled, and a big number for someone who just started kindergarten. "I would do it again because I like it so much," said Harvey.

On May 20, there was an explosion on a large container ship from Singapore called the MV X-Press Pearl. The ship caught fire while it was anchored off the coast of Sri Lanka, waiting to enter the port in Colombo. The 25 members of the ship's crew were able to leave the ship safely. As a result of the explosion and fire, more than 30 of the ship's nearly 1,500 containers have fallen overboard. Many of these have spilled their contents into the sea, covering the country's best known beaches with plastic. A cleanup effort has begun, but there are worries that the pollution could grow worse.

Beaches in the area are being covered with burnt oil and millions and millions of tiny plastic pellets, which are normally used to make packaging and other plastic items. The plastic pellets — some new, others burned or melted — are now covering Sri Lanka's beaches, including its famous beaches in Negombo, which are popular with tourists.

Thousands of workers, including members of Sri Lanka's Navy have been working to clean the beaches. The workers are wearing special "hazmat" suits to protect themselves from any chemicals that may have been released by the ship. Bulldozers are being used to collect huge amounts of the plastic pellets, which are being put into large sacks and removed.

Many people are worried that the plastic pellets will cause problems for fish and other sea life. The government has banned all fishing along 50 miles of coast. This is a huge problem for thousands of people in the area who depend on fishing for their living. It's not yet clear what effect the oil and plastic will have on the mangroves in the shallow waters along the shore or the corals below the sea. Both of these offer protected areas that are important for fish.
