22. D 根据文章 Meet the Otters(水獭)部分中的"Fifty years ago, the UK rivers suffered from pollution by organo-chlorine pesticides(杀虫剂). This resulted in otters disappearing from almost the entirety of the country." 五十年前,英国河流遭受有机氯杀虫剂污染。这导致了这种水獭几乎从整个国家消失。因此,水獭几乎灭绝是环境污染造成的。
23. C 根据文章 BBC Springwatch Experience 部分中的"把你的知识展现在镜头前,用你的手机拍下来,通过与朋友和家人分享你的视频,向每个人展示你是多么擅长做一名野生动物节目主持人。"可知答案。
24. C 根据第一段可知,Thunberg 在船上已经待了两周,刚刚下船踏上陆地,且下文第三段说明船上非常颠簸,因此当 Thunberg 刚刚踏上陆地时,应该是步伐还不稳,因此该词与 shaky 意思相近。
25. A 根据第二段的"She's in New York to speak at the United Nations Climate Action Summit(峰会) next month. There, she'll join world leaders who will present plans to reduce greenhouse gas emissions at the conference." 可知,Thunberg 来纽约参加联合国气候行动峰会。
26. C 根据第三段的"There is no toilet or fixed shower aboard, no windows below deck and only a small gas cooker to heat up freeze-dried food...it's very, very bumpy(颠簸的) and you just try to hold on and not fall,"可推知,Malizia II 船只装备简陋且航行不稳。
27. C 根据最后一段中的"But far simpler things took priority in her first hours in Manhattan. She said she could finally rest, take a shower and enjoy meals of 'fresh vegetables, not freeze-dried food' like 'canned beans and corns'." 可知,她在到达曼哈顿后首先要做的是休息,享用新鲜蔬菜。
28. B 第一段主要介绍古人处理工作和饮食的关系,然后与现代人的做法对比,得出结论:从古至今,工作和吃饭是紧密相连的。
29. D 根据文章第三段的"The first example of a brick-and-mortar(实体的)'restaurant' came during the merchant economy in the 15th and 16th centuries, according to Elias. During this stage in European, African, and East and South Asian history, hotels allowed merchant businessmen to rest—and of course, eat"可知,酒店于15世纪至16世纪不仅能提供住宿也开始提供餐饮。
30. B 根据文章倒数第二段的"Coffee Houses remained providers of tradesman staples(主食) throughout the early 19th century, with simple menu items like rolls and meat pies."可知,咖啡馆在刚出现时,提供的食物极其有限。
31. A 通读文章可知,本文主要讲述餐饮与贸易和工作是紧密相连的,城市的工业化也是城市的餐饮化,故A选项做标题合适。
32. C 根据第一段中的"Then there's Sophia, a robot whose widespread attraction lies not in big, dramatic actions (her body is often fixed to a rolling base), but rather an unsettling human-like appearance and the complex ability to express emotions(情感)."可知,Sophia 区别于其他机器人在于其外形外貌和其复杂的情感表达能力。
33. B 根据第三段中的"According to Hanson, Sophia now has simulations(仿真)... Besides..."可知,第三段主要介绍 Sophia 能够表现出各种表情的原因。
34. D 根据第四段中的"When Hanson first began sculpting Sophia, he wanted her form to attract people from around the world. To that end, he looked to old statues of Nefertiti (queen of Egypt), ancient Chinese paintings, Audrey Hepburn and even his wife as inspiration." 可推断,Sophia 被设计能够拥有普遍的吸引力。
35. A 根据最后一段中的"Controversially, she was even granted Saudi Arabian citizenship, becoming the first robot to have a nationality." 可知,机器人 Sophia 拥有自己的国籍引起了人们的争议。

63. in one in three 意为“三分之一”,因此应该填入介词 in。
64. difficultly 此处是“have difficulty doing sth.”结构,表示“做某事有困难”,因此应该填入所给词的名词形式。
65. that 此处是一个同位语从句,对 fact 的内容作进一步的解释说明,因此应该填入连接词 that。
66. affecting 此处是在句中作伴随状语,因此应该填入所给词的现在分词。
67. have lost 句意表示“可能没有意识到他们已经丧失了部分听力”,故应该使用现在完成时,因此应该填入 have lost。
68. embarrassed 此处是在句中作系动词 feel 的表语,且句意表示“感到尴尬”,表示人的心理感受应该使用过去分词式的形容词,因此应该填入 embarrassed。
69. worse 句意表示“听力问题,如果被忽视或不加以治疗,就会变得更糟糕”,因此应该填入所给形容词的比较级。
70. are 此处是陈述一种客观事实,故应该使用一般现在时,且句子的主语为 Hearing aids, special training, certain medicines, and surgery,因此应该填入 are。

作文评分标准

1. 本题总分为 25 分,按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时,先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量,确定或调整档次,最后给分。
3. 词数少于 80 和多于 120 的,从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时,应注意的主要内容为:内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的数量和准确性、上下文的连贯性及语言的得体性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
6. 如因书写较差而影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
7. 内容要点可用不同方式表达,对紧扣主题的适当发挥不予扣分。

【各档次的给分范围和要求】

第五档(很好):(21—25 分)

1. 完全完成了试题规定的任务。
2. 覆盖所有内容要点。
3. 应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。
4. 语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误,但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致;具备较强的语言运用能力。
5. 有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。
6. 完全达到了预期的写作目的。

第四档(好):(16—20 分)

1. 完全完成了试题规定的任务。
2. 虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点,但覆盖所有主要内容。
3. 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。
4. 语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。
5. 应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。
6. 达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档(适当):(11—15 分)

1. 基本完成了试题规定的任务。
2. 虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖所有主要内容。
3. 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

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
