- 21. B。细节理解题。根据"Visiting time"中的"It is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day."可知,芝加哥艺术会馆在独立日是开放的。
- 22. C。细节理解题。根据"Hidden Histories"中的内容可知,参观者可以了解到一些鲜为人知的艺术家的故事和作品。
- 23. D。细节理解题。根据最后一段中的"Assemble(组装) puzzles based on masterpieces in the museum, build architectural wonders with colorful blocks..."可知.孩子们能参加一些需要动手的活动。

【语篇导读】本文是一篇新闻报道,主题语境为人与社会之灾后救援。本文主要讲述了16岁土耳其女孩 Melda 被救的过程。

- 24. D。推理判断题。根据第一段内容可知,地震后72小时为黄金救援时间,超过这个时间幸存者存活希望渺茫。
- 25. C。细节理解题。根据第三段中的"For Melda and others in Antakya, the biting cold worsened an already desolate situation."和第四段中的"When rescuers discovered Melda, she was stuck under a wall that had collapsed." 可知,低温天气和坍塌的建筑物增加了救援难度。
- 26. A。推理判断题。根据第六段中的"Working in silence to maintain contact with Melda, the rescuers removed one obstacle after another"和第七段中的"Several rescuers, wearing helmets, covered in dust and with tired faces, held the stretcher, protecting Melda with a blanket against the cold and prying eyes."可知救援队在救援过程中既专业又考虑周全。

- 28. C。细节理解题。根据第三段可知,早期的马体形变小是为了对抗气温升高。
- 29. B。词义猜测题。根据第四段可知,在温度高的地区,动物体形会变小,这是他们应对气候变化的生存技巧,因此 spike 意为"升高"。
- 30. A。观点态度题。本文围绕气候变化对哺乳动物体形带来的影响,呈现了两方观点:第二段指出 Prof Steve Brusatte 认为哺乳动物为了应对气温升高而体形变小。最后两段提到 Prof Adrian Lister 持质疑观点。因此,作者的态度应是客观的。
- 31. C。写作意图题。文章第一段提出气候危机可能导致人类体形变小,第二段至第六段讲到由 Prof Steve Brusatte 的研究发现气温是导致哺乳动物体形变化的主要因素。最后两段提到 Prof Adrian Lister 持质疑观点,认为人类体形变化主要与食物和资源变化有关。
