第一节

M: Oh. I'm sorry to hear that. Is it the flu?

W: No, I think I ate something bad yesterday.

W: I see. **Just take a sick day, then.**

Text 4

W: Sam, our guests are running late. They want us to order for the table.

M: Wow, the pressure is on. Well, we have 6 people. ④ **How about 4 cold dishes and 4 main dishes?**

W: Sounds good.

W: What's the difference between "you go first" and "after you"?

M: Generally, ⑤ **it's more polite to say "after you" instead of "you go first".**

W: I see. I didn't know that. What about when we are eating? Can I say "you eat first"?

Instead, ⑱ we need to accept that all emotions are useful. Admitting that you're not okay might not be comfortable. But it's essential for growth.

If you're going through a hard time, talk to somebody about it. If you truly feel that you have no one to talk to, ⑲ then write your feelings down on paper. Trust me, it's better than trying to ignore them! Having emotions doesn't make you weak. It makes you human. The worst thing that we can do is try to pretend that we don't have emotions. And usually the easiest way to move forward is to move through.
