Performance Award at the Palm Springs International Film Festival, and was nominated for awards at the British Academy Film Awards, the MTV Movie Awards, and the Teen Choice Awards. In 2011, Pinto starred in four films, including *Rise of the Planet of the Apes* with James Franco. In 2013, her voice could be heard on the documentary *Girl Rising*, a film about giving girls chances to receive education around the world. Alongside her acting career, Pinto is involved in a few good causes. She works with the Agassi Foundation, an organization that provides education for poor children. In February, 2016, she announced that she would join the non-profit organization "We Do It Together", which finances feature films that focus on women and their achievements.
