第一节 (共 15 小题;每小题 2.5 分,满分 37.5 分)

【文章大意】本文是一篇应用文。文章向我们介绍了世界上的四个创意图书馆。

21.【答案】D

【解析】细节理解题。根据 Beach Library (Albena, Bulgaria)下面的内容“The white, weather-resistant shelves lined up not far from the surf”可知答案。

22.【答案】B

【解析】细节理解题。根据 The Camel Library Service (North Eastern Province, Kenya)下面的内容可知答案。

23.【答案】D

【解析】细节理解题。根据 Seikei University Library (Tokyo, Japan)下面的内容“but this one encourages conversation”和“they serve as perfect spots for study groups and lively discussions”可知答案。

【文章大意】本文是一篇新闻报道。文章讲述了 San Diego 最受喜爱的治疗犬周五去世了的故事。

24.【答案】A

【解析】细节理解题。根据第一段“a pioneer of canine-assisted surf therapy”可知答案。

25.【答案】B

【解析】推理判断题。根据第二段“but the energetic pup was more fond of chasing birds than assisting with household chores”可知 Ricochet 是淘气的,根据第三段“Throughout her life, the beloved dog touched the lives of kids with special needs, wounded service members and families of fallen veterans.”可知 Ricochet 是关爱他人的,故选 B。

26.【答案】C

【解析】段落大意题。第五段主要讲 Ricochet 的受欢迎程度。

27.【答案】C

【解析】推理判断题。根据全文的主要内容和第一段“died on Friday, owner Judy Fridono said Saturday”可知文章最可能来自报纸。

【文章大意】本文是一篇说明文。近年来欧美国家出现了一些用拼接木材建造的高楼,其中一栋去年完工的大楼是目前全世界最高的木制建筑。

28.【答案】D

【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段“so the team worked with the Forest Products Laboratory to optimize the columns to meet this standard. ‘We think it was the first three-hour fire testing on columns,’ said Fernandez”可知答案。

29.【答案】A

【解析】细节理解题。根据第五段“Much of the wood was sourced from Austria”可知答案。

30.【答案】A

【解析】推理判断题。根据第五段“Korb estimated that the project used about 25 per cent of the onsite labour required for a concrete structure and that it was completed in about half the time.”可知这个项目是省时的。

31.【答案】B

【解析】推理判断题。根据最后一段“Both Fernandez and Korb believe that the tower will provide further proof of concept for developers who are looking to create innovative structures from timber.”可以推测出,木塔是创新结构的一个很好的例子。

【文章大意】本文是一篇说明文。人们在手机上耗费了大量的时间,频繁查看手机。手机的使用对大脑产生负面影响。要避免手机分散自己的注意力,唯一的办法是彻底远离手机。

32.【答案】D

【解析】推理判断题。根据第一段第一句话“One recent report found that”可知答案。

33.【答案】D

【解析】词义猜测题。根据第二段后文“手机越有用,我们就用得越多。我们用得越多,大脑中的神经通路就会越多,这些神经通路会导致我们不管手头上有什么事要处理,都会拿起手机。并且我们也会更想看手机,即使没有必要”的描述可以推测出此处 vicious 的含义是:恶性的。

34.【答案】C

【解析】细节理解题。根据最后一段“The only ‘fix’, the researchers found, was putting the device in a different room entirely.”可知,唯一的“解决办法”是把手机完全放在另一个房间。换句话说,要避免手机分散自己的注意力,唯一的办法是彻底远离手机。

35.【答案】B

【解析】标题归纳题。本文主要讲手机的使用对大脑产生负面影响。故选 B。

第二节 (共 5 小题;每小题 2.5 分,满分 12.5 分)

【文章大意】本文是一篇说明文。文章告诉我们确保美妙的迪拜旅行的 5 条建议。

36.【答案】G

【解析】根据关键词“shopping”可知此空选 G。

37.【答案】F

【解析】根据此空前一句“public displays of affection are strictly forbidden”的提示可知此空选 F。

38.【答案】B

【解析】此空选标题。本段主要讲着装要求,故此空选 B。

39.【答案】C

【解析】根据关键词“beach”可知此空从 A 和 C 中选,A 项和下一句不衔接,故此空选 C。

40.【答案】D

【解析】本节讲迪拜地道的美食,故此空选 D。

第三部分 语言运用(共两节,满分 30 分)

第一节 (共 15 小题;每小题 1 分,满分 15 分)

【文章大意】本文是一篇记叙文。文章告诉我们:当你的习惯不再为你服务时,要抛弃旧习惯,养成对自己有益的新习惯。

41. **【答案】**C

【解析】考查名词。根据最后一段“Even the best routines”的提示可知答案。

42. **【答案】**A

【解析】考查名词。跑步使“我”在精神和身体上都变得更轻松了,“我”注意到“我”一整天都有更多的精力。

43. **【答案】**D

【解析】考查动词。但大约一年后,“我”的脚踝和膝盖开始受伤——没有什么大的伤痛,但足以让“我”不断怀疑“我”的身体是否受到了更大的伤害。

44. **【答案】**A

【解析】考查形容词。根据“but”的提示可知此空选 A。

45. **【答案】**B

【解析】考查动词。没有什么大的伤痛,但足以让“我”不断想知道我的身体是否受到了更大的伤害。

46. **【答案】**A

【解析】考查动词。“我”的跑步习惯开始扰乱“我”的日常生活,所以“我”决定做一个改变。

47. **【答案】**B

【解析】考查名词。解析同上。

48. **【答案】**C

【解析】考查名词。根据下文“when I don't do full workouts”的提示可知答案。

49. **【答案】**D

【解析】考查动名词。根据下文“When I first started writing”的提示可知答案。

50. **【答案】**A

【解析】考查名词。根据下文“talked to people in the publishing world”的提示可知答案。

51. **【答案】**B

【解析】考查副词。“我”经常与出版界的人交谈,并每天强迫自己写一页又一页。

52. **【答案】**C

【解析】考查动词。解析同上。

53. **【答案】**B

【解析】考查形容词。根据下文“in these shorter pieces”的提示可知答案。

54. **【答案】**D

【解析】考查动词。然而,很快,“我”注意到了一个转变。

55. **【答案】**C

【解析】考查动词短语。读者们不断告诉“我”,他们发现这些短篇的价值,结果,这也正是“我”最喜欢写的内容类型。It turned out that...结果是,证明是。

第二节 (共 10 小题;每小题 1.5 分,满分 15 分)

【文章大意】本文是一篇记叙文。文章向我们讲述了盲人滑板运动员 Ryusei Ouchi 的故事。

56. **【答案】**what

【解析】考查名词性从句。根据句子结构可知,句中缺少引导表语从句并在表语从句中作主语的连接代词。连接代词 what 具有这一功能,相当于 the things that。

57.【答案】completely

【解析】考查副词。用副词修饰形容词。

58.【答案】an

【解析】考查冠词。此处修饰单数可数名词 eye condition,且 eye 一词首字母为元音音素,需用不定冠词 an,表示泛指。故填 an。

59.【答案】of

【解析】考查介词。be aware of 意识到。

60.【答案】started

【解析】考查时态。主语和谓语之间是主动关系,该句叙述的是发生在过去的事情,故此空填 started。

61.【答案】before

【解析】考查连词。句意:他意识到他想在为时已晚之前学习。

62.【答案】himself

【解析】考查代词。与朋友一起滑滑板给了 Ouchi 一个表达自己情感的出口。express oneself 表达自己的情感。

63.【答案】times

【解析】考查名词复数。several 修饰复数。故填 times。

64.【答案】to become

【解析】考查固定句式。It took sb. +时间+to do sth. 是固定句式,意思是:某人花多长时间做某事。

65.【答案】freeing

【解析】考查非谓语动词。空格处所填单词与主语 he 之间是逻辑上的主动关系,需用现在分词作状语。故填 freeing。

第四部分 写作(共两节,满分 40 分)

第一节 应用文写作(满分 15 分)

【第一节 应用文写作评分标准】

在评分时,应注意以下几个方面:

1. 本题总分为 15 分,按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时,先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次,最后给分。
3. 词数少于 60,从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时,应注意的主要内容有内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的丰富性和准确性及上下文的连贯性。

5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
6. 如书写较差,以致影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。

第二档 (4~6 分)	未适当完成试题规定的任务。 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容,写了一些无关内容;• 语法结构单调、词汇有限;• 有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响了对写作内容的理解;• 较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性。 信息未能清楚地传达给读者。
第一档 (1~3 分)	未完成试题规定的任务。 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,原因可能是未理解试题要求;• 语法结构单调、词汇有限;• 较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解;• 缺乏语句间的连接成分,内容不连贯。 信息未能传达给读者。

- 6. 如书写较差,以致影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
