#### 第一节

##### A

【语篇解读】本文为说明文，主题语境为人与社会。文章介绍了四个生活费不高但幸福指数较高的国家。

21. C 细节理解题。根据第三段第三句中的 cost-effective healthcare 可知，Costa Rica 拥有经济划算的医疗保健服务，故选 C 项。来源：高三答案分众号
22. C 细节理解题。根据对四个国家的介绍及第四段第一句可知，只有 Uruguay 拥有不同的四个季节，其他国家的气候都是温和的，故选 C 项。
23. D 推理判断题。根据第五段第二句可知，Panama 的生活费 \$1 040 低于美国的一半，故美国的生活费高于 2 080 美元，故选 D 项。

##### B

【语篇解读】本文为说明文，主题语境为人与社会。文章介绍了美术馆及艺术家对自拍和社交媒体的认同和支持。

24. A 细节理解题。根据第一段最后一句可知，一个美术馆创造了一个时间段去帮助游客拍照和拍视频去和他们的粉丝分享，故选 A 项。
25. D 细节理解题。根据第二段可知，“Social Media Mondays”一方面可以吸引情绪容易被感染的人，同时也能够为那些在欣赏过程中可能被打扰的人开放一周别的时间以满足大家的需求。故“Social Media Mondays”的目的是满足不同游客的需求，故选 D 项。
26. D 推理判断题。根据本段可知，每个人都是自媒体，故选 D 项。
27. B 主旨大意题。根据全文可知，文章介绍了美术馆对自拍的支持，故选 B 项。

##### C

【语篇解读】本文为说明文，主题语境为人与自然。文章主要讲述盖察机构将对宣传不实的人造草公司进行惩罚整改。

28. D 细节理解题。根据第二段第一句中的“for saying that one of its products was ‘eco’ with ‘no evidence’ to back it up”可知，Perfectly Green 被责备的原因是该公司声称他的产品是环保的，但是没有证据支持，即：广告与产品实际不符，故选 D 项。
29. A 推理判断题。根据第四段中的“we expect advertisers for artificial grass to take note of our decision and act accordingly”可知，watchdog 的主要职责是对供应商的产品及其宣传手段进行监督，故选 A 项。
30. C 观点态度题。根据第六段 Storey 说的话可知，Storey 认为大多塑料废物都没有被回收利用，由此推知其对人造草持反对态度，故选 C 项。
31. A 标题归纳题。根据全文内容，尤其是第一段内容可知，本文主要讲相关部门要求一些本不环保却声称其产品环保的人造草公司进行整改并督促执行，故选 A 项。

##### D

【语篇解读】本文为说明文，主题语境为人与社会。文章主要说明了发表在杂志上的一篇学术论文的观点——智能技术实际上可以帮助人们变得更优秀而不是更愚钝。

32. D 细节理解题。根据文章第一段最后一句“it actually assists people to become more excellent rather than less intelligent”可知，智能技术会让人们变得更优秀而不是更愚钝，故选 D 项。
33. D 推理判断题。第二段的举例主要是进一步说明第一段的观点，结合第一段的观点可知，举例是为了强调智能技术的优势，故选 D 项。
34. A 词义猜测题。结合上一段内容以及本段的最后一句“However, these impacts were all ‘relevant, not causal.’”可以推断出，划线词句子的含义为“研究人员确实认识到，长期使用智能技术确实会降低人们执行认知任务的能力”，故选 A 项。
35. C 推理判断题。文章主要说明了智能技术实际上可以帮助人们变得更优秀而不是更愚钝，因此可推断本篇文章最可能出现在科学栏目，故选 C 项。

## 第二节

【语篇解读】本文为说明文，主题语境为人与自然。文章主要讲述了动植物的杂交。

- 36.D 根据上文杂交物种出现在电影或书里和下文杂交出现在植物和动物中，可以看出此处起着承上启下的作用，故选D项。
- 37.G 根据本段第一句和第三句中的“what's more”可以看出，此句谈论植物的杂交，表示承接与递进关系，故选G项。
- 38.C 根据空前一句“杂交有时出现在动物正常领域部分重叠的地方”可知，此处应提及重叠的原因，属于语法衔接，故选C项。
- 39.F 根据下文可能出现的健康问题可推断，此处是对杂交的消极看法，根据语义场理论，故选F项。
- 40.E 根据下文的“the evolutionary process”可推断，此处是积极的态度和看法，故选E项。

## 第三部分 语言运用

### 第一节

【语篇解读】本文为记叙文，主题语境为人与社会。作者主要讲述了一位前历史老师通过创建 Front Yard Bike Shop，给当地数以百计的孩子提供了锻炼和就学的机遇。

- 41.B 考查动词。根据上一句 a bike was always a vehicle of opportunity 可知，他和哥哥经常骑自行车上下学。故选B。
- 42.C 考查动词。根据下文语境，当地的孩子们会到他的院子里找工具、自行车零件等，以及他创建了“Front Yard Bike Shop”可推断出，她经常花好几个小时修理自行车。故选C。
- 43.B 考查动词。根据文章内容，LaFont 创建“Front Yard Bike Shop”是受当地孩子们的启发，他们经常会到他的院子里寻求建议、找工具、自行车零件等。故选B。
- 44.C 考查名词。根据 LaFont 创建的“Front Yard Bike Shop”这一名字可推断出，当地孩子们经常聚到他家的院子里。
- 45.D 考查动词。根据上下文语境，LaFont 创建了“Front Yard Bike Shop”。故选D。
- 46.C 考查名词。根据语境可知，每年参与他的自行车项目的人数都在增加。故选C。
- 47.B 考查名词。根据上下文语境以及关键词 safe, lazybones 可以推断出，此空填 troublemakers。故选B。
- 48.A 考查形容词。根据上下文语境，两年后，LaFont 把“Front Yard Bikes”变成了一个全职工作，并离开了他的教学工作，把他所有的时间都奉献给了它。故选A。
- 49.B 考查动词。解析同 48 题。

50.D 考查名词。根据上下文语境，LaFont 离开他的教学工作是个相当大的风险，但是他觉得这样做有意义。

51.D 考查形容词。解析同 50 题。

52.A 考查动词。根据文章内容可知，现在，学生们可以来到 Front Yard Bike Shop，学习锯、钻、量、切、绘图、设计和计划。show up 出现。故选 A。

53.A 考查动词。根据语境可知，LaFont 最近开了一家自行车修理店，年长的学生可以在那里获得机械师资格证书，接受手工实践培训，并在店里找到工作，帮助他们为将来的工作建立简历。故选 A。

54.C 考查动词。根据下文语境可知，迄今为止，已有 50 名学生获得了机械专业的资格认证，2 000 名学生从该项目中受益。因此可以推断出，Front Yard Bike Shop 每年为近 400 名年轻人提供服务。故选 C。

55.B 考查动词。解析同 54 题。

### 第二节

【语篇解读】本文为新闻报道，主题语境为人与自然。文章主要讲述了中国正在研制新一代运载火箭，以便将宇航员送上月球，该项目将于 2030 年完成。

56.to send 考查非谓语动词。根据语境可知，此处用动词不定式作目的状语。

57.held 考查非谓语动词。此处为过去分词短语作后置定语，修饰 Airshow China。

58.was displayed 考查动词的时态和语态。根据句意可知，在此期间，火箭模型被展示，所以此空用过去时的被动语态。

59.its 考查代词。此处表示“它的核心直径”，所以用 its。

60.powerful 考查词性转换。the most powerful launch vehicle 意为“最强大的运载火箭”。

61.with 考查介词。根据句意可知，“长征”五号运载火箭是中国目前在役的最强大的运载火箭，近地轨道最大有效载荷能力为 25 吨。此处使用了 with 的复合结构。

62.weighing 考查非谓语动词。根据句意可知，中国空间站的三个模块重约 65 吨。本句中的 weigh 意思为“重量是……”，是不及物动词，three space station modules 和 weigh 构成主动关系，所以此处用现在分词短语。

63.the 考查冠词。此处表示特指，所以用定冠词 the。

64.which 考查非限制性定语从句的关系词。关系代词 which 代替先行词 a new crewed capsule and a lunar lander 在定语从句中作主语。
