2.语法或用词方面错误较多,严重影响了对写作内容的理解。

不得分(0分)

未传达任何信息;写的内容与要求无关。

- 3.比较有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使所续写短文结构紧凑。

第三档(11—15分)

- 1.与所给短文关系较为密切,与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接;
- 2.应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求,有一些错误,但不影响意义表达;
- 3.应用简单的语句间连接成分,使全文内容连贯。

第二档(6—10分)

- 1.与所给短文有一定的关系,与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接;
- 2.语法结构单调、词汇项目有限,有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误,影响了意义的表达;
- 3.较少使用语句间的连接成分,全文内容缺少连贯性。

第一档(1—5分)

- 1.与所提供短文和开头语的衔接较差;
- 2.语法结构单调、词汇项目很有限,有较多语法结构和词汇方面的错误,严重影响了意义的表达;
- 3.缺乏语句间的连接成分,全文内容不连贯。

不得分(0分)
