##### A

【语篇导读】这是一篇应用文。文章介绍了在线讲座的内容,时间安排以及报名方式等信息。

21. B 【解析】理解具体信息。根据材料中“12 May, 6:00 p. m. SGT (Singapore)”可知,新加坡的学生可以在5月12号下午6点参加这个讲座。故选B项。  
22. C 【解析】理解具体信息。根据材料中“Register here: <https://bit.ly/36pjkD2>”和“Register for that event here: <https://bit.ly/3KOTXty>”可知,参加这个讲座需要网上报名。故选C项。  
23. D 【解析】作出判断推理。阅读短文可知,本文介绍了在线讲座的内容,时间安排以及报名方式等信息。再根据材料中两个网址可知,本文应出自一个网站。故选D项。

##### B

【语篇导读】这是一篇说明文。文中主要介绍了《Never Let Me Go》这部小说以及它的电影版本和它的作者Kazuo Ishiguro。

24. B 【解析】理解具体信息。根据第二段最后一句“A frightening reality is revealed; ... to donate their organs once they grow up.”可知,这所学校之所以奇怪是因为它服务于一个邪恶的目的。故选B项。  
25. C 【解析】理解具体信息。根据最后一段最后一句“Although audiences generally praised the movie and the actors' performances”可知,这部小说的电影版本得到了广泛的赞扬。故选C项。  
26. D 【解析】作出判断推理。根据第三段第二句“He has also written six other novels, a number of short stories, four screenplays, and a handful of song lyrics.”可知,作为作者,Ishiguro是一位多产的作家。故选D项。  
27. B 【解析】作出判断推理。阅读全文可知,文中主要介绍了《Never Let Me Go》这部小说以及它的电影版本和它的作者Kazuo Ishiguro。因此本文是一则影评。故选B项。

##### C

【语篇导读】这是一篇说明文。文中主要介绍了芬兰的一个研究小组发现:受气候变暖的影响,一些鸟类的繁殖期缩短了。

28. C 【解析】理解具体信息。根据第一段最后一句中“birds are not only breeding earlier, but their breeding windows are also narrowed—some by as many as 4 to 5 days”以及第三段描述可知,这些科学家发现受气候变暖的影响,一些鸟类的繁殖期缩短了。故选C项。  
29. B 【解析】词义猜测。根据第二段首句“On average, the beginnings and ends of the breeding periods are occurring earlier in the year”可知,此处指“随着气候变化,遵循最佳的条件。”也就是“恰当的条件”。故选B项。  
30. A 【解析】理解具体信息。根据第四段首句中“because it's one of the few ways to measure the breeding period duration”可知,Lucyna Halupka把这项研究认为是“非常重要的一页”是因为这个小组是以不同的方式进行了这项研究。也就是这项研究的意义所在。故选A项。  
31. D 【解析】理解主旨要义。阅读全文可知,文中主要介绍了芬兰的一个研究小组发现,受气候变暖的影响,一些鸟类的繁殖期缩短了。因此D项“鸟类的繁殖期受到全球变暖的影响。”可为本文最佳标题。故选D项。

##### D

【语篇导读】这是一篇议论文。文中主要介绍了2022年6月6日,国务院未成年人保护工作领导小组办公室印发《未成年人文身治理工作办法》的消息以及人们对此的看法。

32. A 【解析】理解具体信息。根据第三段中“All agencies that provide tattooing services should clearly display signs refusing minors, and ask customers to show their IDs if it's hard to judge their age based on their appearance”可知,文身商店应该拒绝为未成年人提供文身服务。故选A项。  
33. C 【解析】理解具体信息。阅读本段可知,青少年更对文身感兴趣。故选C项。  
34. C 【解析】作出推理判断。根据第五段中Amanla的话“But more deeply, it's also disrespectful for

people to do something merely to be cool without knowing what they really want or understanding the pattern being drawn on their body”可知,他会赞同在文身之前对文身进行了解。故选 C 项。

35. D 【解析】作出推理判断。根据最后一段中“But it takes a learning process among the local authorities for the guideline to be effective”可知,这个条例要产生效果还有很长的一段路要走。故选 D 项。

### 第二节

【语篇导读】这是一篇记叙文。文中主要讲述了作者参加跳水考试的故事。

36. B 【解析】根据上一句“我总是坐在教室后面。”可知,B 项“这样我就不会被要求阅读了。”符合语境,上下文之间是因果关系。故选 B 项。
37. F 【解析】联系上一句“当老师宣布将对我们最难的跳水项目——屈体跳水进行期末评分时,我的心都凉了。”以及下一句“随我望去,每个学生似乎都毫不费力地完成了这个具有挑战性的跳水动作,很快我就不得不尝试一些我以前从未练习过的动作。”可知,F 项“当通往可怕的跳板的队伍缩短时,我感到很紧张。”与上下文构成顺承关系,符合语境。故选 F 项。

38. G 【解析】上一句描述了跳水的几个动作,G 项“最后,他们像箭一样直着身子,准备跳入水中。”介绍了一连串动作的最后一个,与上文构成顺承关系,符合语境。故选 G 项。

39. A 【解析】上一段介绍了一个同学顺利地完成了跳水动作,下一句介绍了作者紧张地走上踏板,因此 A 项“然后,就轮到我了。”与上下文构成顺承关系,符合语境。故选 A 项。

40. E 【解析】联系下一句“有时候,你需要的可能只是一次尝试!”可知,E 项“永远不要低估你完成某事的能力。”符合语境,上下文构成顺承关系。故选 E 项。

43. A 【解析】根据下文“We depended upon strangers... to helping others”可知,本文作者谈论陌生人的善良。故选 A 项。
