Firstly, paper shopping bags are better than plastic ones. Is it true? Actually, making a paper bag uses four times as much energy as making a plastic one and produces more greenhouse gases. So a reusable bag is the best choice.

Secondly, when you turn off a device, it stops using power. Really? If you turn off the television or air conditioner, it goes into the standby mode. Devices in this mode still use power. So to make sure your appliance is in fact off, you should remove the plug from its power supply.

## 第二部分 阅读

### 第一节

#### A

**【语篇导读】**本文是一篇应用文，文章介绍了一个读书俱乐部本月的讨论话题以及参与讨论的注意事项。

21. **【答案】**B

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据第一段的“including access to talks on culture & art, art & travel, geography & science and travel & writing completely for free”“The topic of this month’s event is making art through the seasons”和下文的内容可知，本月读书俱乐部的讨论话题是创作不同季节话题的艺术作品。话题同艺术与治疗有关。故答案选B项。

22. **【答案】**D

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据文章“Meet the Host, Sarah”这一个要点可知，萨拉擅长通过一些活动帮助别人享受大自然的美妙之处，从而让别人实现身心健康的目的。故答案选D项。

23. **【答案】**A

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据文章“Online Zoom event”和“Preparing for the Event”可知，参与者须提前注册成会员。故答案选A项。

#### B

**【语篇导读】**本文是一篇记叙文，文章讲述了José Andrés和女儿们一起拍摄有关西班牙美食电视节目的故事。

24. **【答案】**D

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据第二段的“In the show, he travels with his three America-raised daughters through Spain.”和第三段的“The new program is a travel show, a cooking show and a parenting show, all at once.”可知，José Andrés新的电视节目内容与西班牙美食有关。故答案选D项。

25. **【答案】**B

**【解析】**推理判断题。根据第四段的“He includes both respected restaurants and street food in the new show.”和“Tapas, which are small plates of food often served in Spanish restaurants, are a good representation of Andrés’ philosophy on eating.”可知，塔帕斯(tapas)是西班牙的餐前小吃，José Andrés在节目中介绍了该小吃，其目的是表达自己的喜欢和尊重。故答案选B项。

26. **【答案】**C

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据最后一段的José Andrés所说的话可知，人们认为到遥远的地方旅游、拥有终身难忘的经历和拍摄难忘的照片才能体会到兴奋。而兴奋实际上来自于人们用心体会一些事情。故答案选C项。

27. **【答案】**A

**【解析】**主旨大意题。本文主要讲的是José Andrés和女儿们一起拍摄有关西班牙美食的电视节目。比较选项可知，A项最能概括本文大意。

#### C

**【语篇导读】**本文是一篇说明文，文章介绍了底特律市由过度开发造成环境破坏到再野生化的转变过程。

28. **【答案】**C

**【解析】**细节理解题。根据第二段的“Thousands of houses and other buildings were left empty over the years.”可知，底特律市的许多房子和建筑物都无人居住或使用了。故答案选C项。

29. **【答案】**B

**【解析】**推理判断题。根据第一段的“The American city of Detroit is an example of how human actions can increase rewilding”以及第二段和第三段的内容可知，底特律市由过度开发转变为再野生化，表明人类所采

取的行动在环境的再野生化过程中能发挥一定的作用。故答案选 B 项。

30. 【答案】 C

【解析】推理判断题。根据第三段和第四段的 “It used to be that you had to go to some remote location to get exposure to nature... Now that’s not the case. Like it or not, rewilding will occur” 可知，底特律市已经成为人们亲近大自然的地方。故答案选 C 项。

31. 【答案】 B

【解析】词义猜测题。根据下文的 “the presence of more and more wildlife” 和 “After all, many city people have lost their tolerance to live with wildlife.” 可知，之前的底特律市环境遭到破坏，人们看不到野生动物。所以要等待野生动物的造访，城市需事先准备好适宜的环境供这些野生动物栖息。该词意为 “期待，期盼”，与 B 项同义。

## D

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文，文章介绍了学生在引用别人著作时应如何避免抄袭嫌疑的风险。

32. 【答案】 C

【解析】细节理解题。根据第二段的 “Therefore, students can include a small part of copyrighted works in their writing and research if they provide credit, or citation, to the creators of the works.” 可知，为了避免抄袭，在引用别人的著作时，学生必须标注出引文的原创者。故答案选 C 项。

33. 【答案】 A

【解析】细节理解题。根据第三段的内容可知，对教授来说，判断学生是否抄袭是一件简单的事。只需仔细比对文章的内容及学生的词汇和写作风格等，就可以判断出来。故答案选 A。

34. 【答案】 B

【解析】推理判断题。最后一段的内容主要介绍了一些引文检索工具和途径，这些工具和途径可以让引用者避免抄袭嫌疑。故答案选 B 项。

35. 【答案】 D

【解析】标题概括题。本文主要讲的是学生在引用别人著作时，应如何遵守规则，避免抄袭嫌疑。比较选项可知，D 项最能概括本文的大意。

## 第二节

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文，文章介绍了与低血压有关的知识，如低血压的症状、根源和预防措施等。

36. 【答案】 F

【解析】考查顺承关系。根据本段的小标题 “Normal values” 和下文的 “For women, this translates to a blood pressure lower than 100 over 60. For men this is slightly higher: 110 over 70.” 可知，空格处的内容应该和 “影响血压高低的因素与年龄和性别有关”。比较选项可知，F 项符合语境。

37. 【答案】 A

【解析】考查总分关系。第三段主要讲的是低血压的人常常会碰到像头晕、视线模糊、头昏眼花、乃至昏厥等症状。空格处的内容应该与 “低血压的症状” 有关。比较选项可知，A 项能概括该段的内容。

38. 【答案】 D

【解析】考查转折关系。根据下文的 “but it is not a sign of a potential disease” 可知，空格处应该与 “低血压出现的常见症状” 有关，并且 it 指代空格处出现的名词。比较选项可知，D 项符合语境。

39. 【答案】 G

【解析】考查并列关系。根据小标题 “Possible causes” 和上文 “Women are more likely to suffer from low blood pressure... If you have been very sick and have thrown up, your blood pressure may also have dropped.” 可知，空格处的内容应该与 “出现低血压的原因” 有关，比较选项可知，G 项符合语境。

40. 【答案】 E

【解析】考查顺承关系。根据上文的 “Drink enough water, especially in warm weather.” 和下文的 “In this way

you can prevent dizziness and blurred vision.”可知，空格处的内容应该与“预防低血压的措施和注意事项”有关。比较选项可知，E项符合语境。

### 第三部分 语言运用

#### 第一节

**【语篇导读】**本文是一篇夹叙夹议文，文章通过讲述克里斯蒂·耶格的书 *Harley's Harlequin Heart* 传达一个信息：人类的大爱可以战胜不幸和其它问题。

41. **【答案】** B

**【解析】**根据上文的“written by Christy Jaeger”和下文的“through the narration (叙述) of the dog Harley”可知，克里斯蒂·耶格的书 *Harley's Harlequin Heart* 是以故事的主角哈利自述形式展开的。故答案选 B 项。present 意为“(以某种方式)展现，显示”。

42. **【答案】** A

**【解析】**根据第二、三段的内容可知，本文讲述的是爱的力量可以战胜生命旅途中的不幸，这里指的是一只叫哈里的狗得了骨癌但经过手术之后康复的事情。misfortune 意为“不幸、厄运”。

43. **【答案】** D

**【解析】**根据下文的“from growing up, being trained, to going to dog shows”可知，哈里讲述了自己成长、被主人训练到参加狗展所有的经历。故答案选 D 项，adventures 意为“冒险经历，奇遇”。

44. **【答案】** C

**【解析】**根据上文的“Then one day, Harley is diagnosed with bone cancer.”和“Fortunately”可知，尽管哈里得了骨癌，但幸运的是还有足够的时间去治疗。故答案选 C 项。cure 意为“疗法，治疗”。

45. **【答案】** D

**【解析】**根据下文的“Looking back, I'm glad she paid attention to her 46 warning.”可知，每个人都有第六感，当某些不妙的情況发生时，第六感提醒我们。故答案选 D 项。

46. **【答案】** B

**【解析】**根据上文的“Jaeger told me everyone has a sixth sense”可知，哈里庆幸自己主人注意到了内心的警告。故答案选 B 项。

47. **【答案】** A

**【解析】**根据上文的“Through surgery”和下文的“It isn't easy and he tells us about his pain and fears. But chances of 48 look promising.”可知，经过手术之后，哈里挺过来了。push through 意为“挺过来，排除困难办好事”，符合语境。

48. **【答案】** B

**【解析】**根据上文的“Through surgery, this smart dog 49.”可知，哈里很有希望得到康复。故答案选 B 项。

49. **【答案】** C

**【解析】**根据上文的“After this experience”和下文的“realizes”可知，通过这次经历，哈里逐渐明白了一个道理。故答案选 C 项。

50. **【答案】** A

**【解析】**根据上文的“when someone has cancer, the entire family will”和下文的“However, all the people playing a part in the process form an unbreakable connection.”可知，哈里知道：当家里有成员得了癌症，整个家庭都跟着受罪。故答案选 A 项。

51. **【答案】** B

**【解析】**根据上文的内容及下文的“with cancer”可知，哈里与癌症抗争的故事有教育意义，可能会让成年人想把书分享给孩子们。故答案选 B 项。battle with “与……搏斗或斗争”。

52. **【答案】** C

【解析】根据上文的“Harley’s 51 with cancer might concern adults considering reading this book with their children.”可知，书中讲述的友善和爱的故事对孩子有教育意义，值得孩子们一读。故答案选 C 项。

53. 【答案】B

【解析】根据上文的内容及上文的“it helps greatly”可知，哈里患了骨癌，但最终得到治疗并且好转。因此这个故事的结局是圆满的。故答案选 B 项。

54. 【答案】D

【解析】根据下文的“in the human and animal worlds”可知，爱是微小的元素，但却能在人与动物的世界里产生影响。influential 意为“有影响力的，有支配力的”。

55. 【答案】C

【解析】根据上文的“Love can defeat all”可知，书中传送着这么一个信息：爱可以打败一切，包括不幸与灾难。故答案选 C 项。

## 第二节

【语篇导读】本文是一篇说明文，文章介绍了我国首个深远海浮式风电平台建设进展情况以及浮式风电未来的发展前景。

56. 【答案】has completed

【解析】考查时态。“invested in and built by the China National Offshore Oil Corporation (CNOOC)”是非谓语动词短语，在句中充当定语，修饰 floating wind power platform。分析句法可知，此处是谓语位置，根据下文的“so far”可知，空格处填现在完成时 has completed。

57. 【答案】an

【解析】考查冠词。step 是可数名词，前面须填不定冠词，再考虑到 important 是元音音素开头，故空格处填不定冠词 an。

58. 【答案】with

【解析】考查介词。下文的“a water depth of over 100 meters and an offshore distance of over 100 kilometers”是“海上风电项目”所具备的特点，故空格处填 with。本句的句意为“这标志着全球首座水深超 100 米、离岸距离超 100 公里的‘双百’海上风电项目建设取得重大进展”。

59. 【答案】where

【解析】考查定语从句。空格处及下文的“strong winds and big ocean waves caused a huge challenge to the design of the wind power platform.”在句中充当定语，是定语从句。空格处在句中充当地点状语，故填关系副词 where。

60. 【答案】is put

【解析】考查时态和语态。After 引导的从句缺少谓语，再结合下文的“...will be connected...”，空格处遵循“主将从现”的原则，须填一般现在时。主语与谓语为被动关系。故填 is put。

61. 【答案】directly

【解析】考查副词。副词在句中修饰 connected。...will be directly connected to...意为“将被直接连接到……”。

62. 【答案】reducing

【解析】考查非谓语动词。空格处作结果状语，故填 reduce 现在分词形式 reducing。

63. 【答案】broader

【解析】考查形容词的比较级。根据下文的“than expected”可知，空格处填 broad 的比较级 broader。

64. 【答案】consumption

【解析】考查词形转换。根据上文的“local”和下文的“power supply”可知，空格处填 consumption。local consumption 意为“本地消耗量”。该空容易误填 consumers，这里不是指消费者，而是指电力消耗。

65. 【答案】to develop

【解析】考查非谓语动词。根据上文的“It can be used”和“not only ... but also...”可知，空格处充当目的状语，故填 to develop。
