Nick tried some prosthetics (假数) but they were more of restriction than aid because they limited his movement. Apparently, he had learnt how to do some things without them. Unfortunately, he severely battled with depression at age 8. He felt he would always be a burden for the rest of his life. These thoughts made his prospects in life as a fantasy. He just had one desire—arms and legs, that's all.

At age 10, though his home was a refuge from the external storms, he couldn't manage to deal with the rejections he faced outside.
