各档次的给分范围和要求

**第五档 (13-15 分)**

完全完成了试题规定的任务。

—覆盖所有内容要点。

—应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。

—语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误，但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致；具备较强的语言运用能力。

—有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使全文结构紧凑。

完全达到了预期的写作目的。

**第四档 (10-12 分)**

完全完成了试题规定的任务。

—虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点，但覆盖所有主要内容。

—应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

—语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确，些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。

—应用简单的语句间的连接成分，使全文结构紧凑。

达到了预期的写作目的。

**第三档 (7-9 分)**

基本完成了试题规定的任务。

—虽漏掉一些内容，但覆盖所有主要内容。

—应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

—有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误，但不影响理解。

—应用简单的语句间的连接成分，使全文内容连贯。

整体而言，基本达到了预期的写作目的。

**第二档 (4-6 分)**

未恰当完成试题规定的任务。

—漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容，写了一些无关内容。

—语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。

—有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响了对写作内容的理解。

—较少使用语句间的连接成分，内容缺少连贯性。

信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

**第一档 (1-3 分)**

未完成试题规定的任务。

—明显遗漏主要内容，写了一些无关内容，原因可能是未理解试题要求。

—语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。

—较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响对写作内容的理解。

—缺乏语句间的连接成分，内容不连贯。

信息未能传达给读者。

未能传达给读者任何信息：内容太少，无法评判；写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。

**（二）读后续写评分参考标准**

评分时关注以下方面：

1. 与所给短文及段落开头语的衔接程度；
2. 续写内容的丰富性、合理性；
3. 应用语法结构和词汇的丰富性和准确性；
4. 上下文的连贯性。

第五档 (21~25 分)

- 创造了丰富、合理的内容, 富有逻辑性, 续写完整, 与原文情境融洽度高。
- 使用了多样并且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 可能有个别小错, 但完全不影响理解。
- 有效地使用了语句间衔接手段, 全文结构清晰, 意义连贯。

第四档 (16~20 分)

- 创造了比较丰富、合理的内容, 比较有逻辑性, 续写比较完整, 与原文情境融洽度较高。
- 使用了比较多样并且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 可能有些许错误, 但不影响理解。
- 比较有效地使用了语句间衔接手段, 全文结构比较清晰, 意义比较连贯。

第三档 (11~15 分)

- 创造了基本合理的内容, 有一定的逻辑性, 续写基本完整, 与原文情境相关。
- 使用了简单的词汇和语法结构, 有一些错误或不当之处, 但基本不影响理解。
- 基本有效地使用了语句间衔接手段, 全文结构基本清晰, 意义基本连贯。

第二档 (6~10 分)

- 内容或逻辑上有一些重大问题, 续写不够完整, 与原文情境有一定程度脱节。
- 所使用的词汇有限, 语法结构单调, 错误较多, 影响理解。
- 未能有效地使用语句间衔接手段, 全文结构不够清晰, 意义不够连贯。

第一档 (1~5 分)

- 内容或逻辑上有较多重大问题, 或有部分内容抄自原文, 续写不完整, 与原文情境基本脱节。
- 所使用的词汇有限, 语法结构单调, 错误很多, 严重影响理解
- 几乎没有使用语句间衔接手段, 全文结构不清晰, 意义不连贯。

零分: 所写内容太少或无法看清以致无法评判; 所写内容全部抄自原文或与题目要求完全不相关。未作答。

白卷、内容太少无法评判或所写内容与所提供内容无关。
