As the country's first large scale serial documentary shot in 8K ultrahigh-definition, *The Forbidden City*, a 12 episode documentary, has recently run on Beijing Satellite TV, which is in part as a celebration of the 601st anniversary of the founding of the imperial (帝王的) palace during the Ming and Qing dynasties (1368-1911).

The documentary gathered 12 first class singers to respectively render(演唱) theme songs for each episode, creatively interpreting milestone historical chapters with meaningful music.

Wu Zhiyong, the chief producer and chief director, recalled that he visited the Forbidden City for the first time when he was a youngster, feeling it a pity upon discovering that the guide he followed offered a flawed introduction to the site.

"Since then I had wished for many years that I could make a documentary to retell the real

history of the Forbidden City in detail. Luckily with the Palace Museum's support, our crew managed to learn a lot of knowledge, interviewing many historians and shooting the most beautiful, tranquil moments of the imperial palace," said Wu.

The crew, consisting of nearly 150 people, had spent around three years to conduct investigations, polishing the script with the help of more than 30 experts from multiple departments of the Palace Museum, covering a wide range of areas including ancient architecture, drawing and calligraphy, court wares and royal history.

Aside from the Forbidden City, the crew made up of three camera teams to simultaneously work on different sites also traveled to dozens of cities, such as Nanjing and Suzhou in Jiangsu province as well as Fuzhou, Xiamen and Quanzhou in Fujian province, to obtain more content about Chinese history related to the stories happening inside the great palace.

Have you ever imagined that your simple T-shirt could cool you down by up to 5°C on these hot summer days? Thanks to a recent discovery, the possibility is getting closer. While there are many alternatives that manage to keep the body warm, this amazing invention aims to offer real relief for those who are eager to feel comfortable and fresh in the outdoors on extremely hot days.

Its inventors, engineers Ma Yaoguang of Zhejiang University and Tao Guangming of Huazhong University of Science and Technology in China, took a completely innovative approach. They designed a special textile (纺织物) that can absorb body heat and re-emit (重发出) its energy into space as mid-infrared radiation (MIR). This textile cools both the objects and their surroundings through a technique that is known as radiative cooling. Science reveals. This means that even when it looks like you are wearing a regular shirt, you are actually wearing a device that works like a mirror.

Research conducted at Stanford University in 2017 had already managed to cool the wearer by 3°C, but this previous trial was limited. So researchers still need to test the new approach to determine how effectively the new fabric cools while the wearers are standing or walking, and not directly facing the sky, like in their trials. They also need to examine and measure how well it works when T-shirts are not in close contact with the skin.

Inventors Yaoguang and Guangming are now looking out for textile manufacturers and clothing brands that are interested in using their fabric. They estimate that the new material will increase clothing manufacturing costs by just 10 percent. "We can make it with mass production, which means everybody can get a T-shirt and the cost is basically the same as



their old stuff," Yaoguang said.

So if you are an athlete or simply someone that has to deal with the extremely high temperatures, be patient because your days of feeling hot and bothered may be coming to an end!

The proposal for a new Indonesian capital city has been on the cards ever since the country gained independence from the Dutch in 1945. The political and economic crises which followed have long delayed the plan, but current president, Joko Widodo, now appears determined to make the move a reality. The government officially confirmed that the capital will be moved from Jakarta to a new location within Kalimantan, part of the island of Borneo in Indonesia.

A number of factors are likely to have influenced the decision to forge (艰苦做成) ahead with the move, but it seems likely that Jakarta's environmental problems are chief among them. Built on swampy(沼泽的)ground, Jakarta is sinking, in some parts at a rate of 20cm a year. Experts predict that most of northern Jakarta could sink beneath the sea by 2050. What's more, Jakarta is rarely mentioned without reference to its extreme levels of traffic jams and air pollution. There could be other reasons too. John McCarthy, an expert on land use in Kalimantan at the Australian National University Crawford School points to a potential desire to spread wealth throughout Indonesia. "Jakarta is the most highly developed core of Indonesia which sucks all the money and opportunities from other areas," he says. "I think there's logic in splitting the economic and political capital."

But the location of this new political center is proving controversial. Some environmental groups are concerned that the chosen location in East Kalimantan will increase logging and destruction of nearby forests, home to orangutans and other endangered species. Indonesia's planning minister previously told reporters that the new capital will be a sustainable "forest city" that won't result in the destruction of protected forest, but how exactly this would work has not yet been explained.

Despite these challenges, the government is now putting its plan in motion. But even if this new capital is built, Jakarta will still need protection. Home to ten million people, the city simply can't be neglected.

Living an Adventurous Life

Nearly ten years ago, I was told that I had a brain tumor (瘤), and this experience changed my attitude about 41 forever. I thought that I was going to die and that all my adventures were 42 .

I did not have a brain tumor, it 43 out, but rather multiple sclerosis (多发性硬化症), which meant that, 44 they were not over, the definition of my adventures could have to 45.

Each morning that I wake up is a fresh event, something that I might not have had. Each 46 that I make carries the weight of uncertainty and 47 significant attention: buttoning my shirt, changing a light bulb, 48 down stairs. I might not be able to do it this time. If I could not 49 in them, they would likely drown me in anger and in self-pity.

I admire the grand adventures of others. I read about them with interest. With Peter Matthiessen I have 50 across the Himalayas to the Crystal Mountain. I have walked with Annie Dillard up, down, into, and across Tinker Creek in all seasons. David Bain has gone with me along 110 miles of Philippine coast, and Ed Abbey has 51 me down the Colorado River. I enjoy the adventures of these 52 figures, who can strike out on difficult trips—2 miles, 250 miles, 3000 miles—ready to bear cold and 53, indeed not just to bear but to celebrate.

But as for me, I can no longer walk very far from the 54 in which I read. Some days I don't even make it to the backyard. And yet I'm 55 to give up the adventurous life, the difficulty of it, even the 56, the anxiety and fear, and the sudden brief lift of 57 that makes a hard journey more attractive.

I 58 adventure, make it smaller and smaller. And now, whether I am moving on my hands and knees across the dining room to help my cat, lying 59 in the dark battling another period of sadness, gathering flowers from the garden, 60 a friend for lunch, I am always having the adventures that are mine to have.
