

- W: It's about time. Everyone is so worried I'll get hurt, but I earned this spot. Plus, I'm already the fastest runner they have. (1)

Text 2

- W: I'd like to thank my new student council vice president, **Jim**, for all his help. Together, we have redesigned a whole new lunch menu and started the school store.
- M: Thanks, Janet. After seeing you start twelve new clubs last year, I was inspired to join the council. (2)

Text 3

- M: I'm going on holiday next month and my passport is out of date. I heard it can take 3 weeks to get a new one.
- W: I lost mine and I had a replacement in 2 weeks, (3) but you can pay extra to get it done in 7 days.

Text 4

- W: In Brazil they have a festival that the whole country participates in. It's called "Carnival". A lot of world travelers attend and everyone wears fancy masks.
- M: If I was going to travel all the way there it would be to see what kind of meals they would serve. (4)

Text 5

- W: What topic should I add to my speech? I am already going to talk about the football team's great teamwork this year. I also have a section thanking the coaches for their hard work.

- W: I'm lucky to be in this position, (8) so of course I will do my best at it. I just practice all the time. This way in a few years I'll be able to speak in front of thousands of people.

Text 10

My favorite interviewer of all time is named Jon Stewart. He began his career by telling jokes on stage, (17) and then he got a job hosting a news show called *The Daily Show* in 1999. (19) For many years, he would mix jokes with world news stories. Usually, he would have someone famous like a film star or a government official on at the end of the show. Jon would ask them questions about what they did, but also the important topics he spoke about on the show. He found it was a way for the viewers to connect better with the topics he spoke about because even though he made jokes, the topics were very serious. Though he became famous and helped spread important news to many people, Jon was unfulfilled. He realized that famous people and government officials were not the people he needed to give a voice to. After hosting *The Daily Show* for sixteen years, Jon decided to retire in 2015. He took a year off to enjoy himself, and then quickly jumped back into interviewing in 2016. Since then, Jon has fought for the men and women who are ignored in America. (18) One of the most important things he has done was get new laws passed that help pay the health bills of the firefighters and police — heroes who saved people during national tragedies. (20)
