The modern American holiday of Mother's Day was first celebrated in 1908. (17) It is on the second Sunday in May. It is a day to honor mothers. On that day mothers usually receive flowers and cards. On the cards, children often write, "Thanks, Mom", "To the best mother in the world" and so on. Then where did the idea for the holiday come from? We should thank Miss Anna Marie Jarvis. It is she who brought up the idea of having such a day. She lived in West Virginia. Anna's mother was a peace activist who cared for wounded soldiers on both sides of the Civil War and created Mother's Day Work Clubs to address public health issues(问题). (18) Her mother died on May 9th, 1905. On the anniversary of her mother's death, she invited some friends to an informal memorial meeting. In 1907, a church service was held on her mother's death anniversary. Anna's love for her mother moved other people. Besides, she wrote letters to important persons of the country suggesting a public holiday to honor all mothers. In 1914, the United States Congress agreed that the second Sunday in May should be appointed as Mother's Day. Finally, the decision was announced by President Wilson. (19)

【解析】

【导语】本文是一篇应用文。短文介绍了希腊三个度假胜地。

【21 题详解】

细节理解题。根据 Lovely Ithaca 中的 "For motorists, Kaminia beach, hidden in a peaceful cove, is the perfect destination for a day of relaxation." (对于驾车者来说, 隐藏在宁静海湾中的卡米尼亚海滩是放松一天的理想目的地) 可知, 米尼亚海滩位于 Ithaca。故选 B 项。

【22 题详解】

细节理解题。根据 Breathtaking Meteora 中的“Meteora’s landscape is made special by the rocks shaped like columns (柱状物) over time, on which the Monasteries (修道院) of the area were built around the 14th and 16th centuries.”(随着时间的推移,梅托拉的景观因岩石形状如圆柱而变得特别,该地区的修道院建于 14 世纪和 16 世纪左右)可知,在 Meteora 游客可以看到历史建筑。故选 A 项。

【23 题详解】

细节理解题。根据 Ios—the favorite destination of the future 中的“Of course, Ios is an absolute destination for party-goers even in midsummer.”(当然,即使在盛夏,伊俄斯也是派对参与者的绝对目的地)可知, Ios 岛很受参加聚会的人的欢迎。故选 B 项。

【解析】

【导语】这是一篇记叙文。文章主要讲述作者在成为作家的路上,给一些著名的作家写信,他们的建议和反馈让作者受益良多。

【24 题详解】

细节理解题。根据第二段的“‘It all started in my 18th year, when I was entertaining my own imagination of success as a writer. I was full of high expectations, believing that becoming an author was simply a matter of putting my thoughts onto paper, sending the works to a publisher and waiting for fame to come. Then came the great disappointment. I wrote to famous children’s author Lloyd Alexander, describing my fruitless yearlong effort at publication and asking him for direction.’(这一切都始于我 18 岁的时候,当时我正沉浸在自己作为一名作家的成功想象中。我充满了很高的期望,认为成为一名作家只是把我的想法写在纸上,把作品寄给出版商,然后等待名声的到来。然后是巨大的失望。我写信给著名儿童作家劳埃德·亚历山大,描述了我一年来徒劳的出版努力,并向他寻求指导。)”可知,作者 18 岁时的一部作品未能出版。故选 C。

【25 题详解】

细节理解题。根据第三段的“‘When you mention that you’ve been writing for a year without being published, I hasten to tell you that I wrote seven times that long without being published! So, perhaps one piece of advice is: Patience.’(当你提到你已经写了一年没有发表,我赶紧告诉你,我写了七倍的时间没有发表!所以,或许有一条建议是:耐心)”可知, Lloyd Alexander 给作者的建议是继续尝试并且要有耐心。故选 D。

【26 题详解】

推理判断题。根据最后一段的“‘We actually had an ongoing correspondence (通信) for a while. I wrote to him asking if he would be so kind as to autograph one of his books for me. His reply brought an immediate smile to my face: ‘I am eagerly ready to autograph and return a book — it makes me feel like an author.’”(事实上,我们有一段时间一直保持通信联系。我写信给他,问他是否愿意为我在他的一本书上签名。他的回答立刻让我脸上露出了笑容:“我迫不及待地准备好签名并归还一本书——这让我觉得自己像个作家。”)”可知, William Stafford 非常乐意给作者寄一本签有自己名字书。由此推知,作者认为 William Stafford 是友好、和蔼可亲。故选 B。

【27 题详解】

主旨大意题。通读全文可知,文章主要讲述作者在成为作家的路上,给一些著名的作家写信,他们的建议和反馈让作者受益良多,结合第一段“‘Over the years, when a book has spoken to me with particular power, I have put pen to paper and send word off to the author, communicating what their work meant to me.’(多年来,当一本书对我产生了特殊的影响时,我就会动笔写信给作者,告诉他他们的作品对我意味着什么)”可知, A 项“Writing to the Writers in My Life(给我生命中的作家写信)”可以作为本文的最佳标题。故选 A。

【解析】

【导语】本文是一篇新闻报道。周三,一支名为 Endurance22 的搜索队宣布,他们在海面下 1.87 英里处已经找到了“耐力”号沉船。在它在南极洲附近沉没一百多年后,这艘船终于被发现了。

【28 题详解】

细节理解题。根据第三自然段最后一句“Scientists say that the small organisms (微生物) that normally break down wooden objects underwater don't live in cold water around Antarctica. (科学家表示,通常在水下分解木制物体 小型生物并不生活在南极洲周围的冷水中。)”可知,分解木制品的微生物无法在南极洲附近的寒冷水域生存,所以冷水帮助“耐力”号保持了良好的状态。故选 D。

【29 题详解】

推理判断题。根据第六自然段“The robots were looking for anything sticking up above the seafloor. Last Saturday, the ship was found. (机器人正在寻找海底上方的任何东西。上周六,这艘船被发现了。)”可知,机器人在上周六发现沉船。故选 C。

【30 题详解】

推理判断题。根据第五自然段“For the last two weeks, the Sabertooths robots have been scanning the seafloor in a 150-square mile area around the Endurance's last known location. (在过去的两周里, Sabertooths 机器人一直在“耐力”号最后一个已知位置周围 150 平方英里的海底进行扫描。)”和最后一段“The Endurance22 team plans to create a digital 3D model of the wreck site, using a careful scan they made. (Endurance22 团队计划通过仔细扫描,创建沉船现场的数字 3D 模型。)”可知,在寻找“耐力”号的过程中,科技起着最重要的作用。故选 A。

【31 题详解】

主旨大意题。文章主要介绍了 Endurance22 搜索队找到“耐力”号沉船。全文围绕科学家借助机器人来定位沉船的位置展开。C 项“Locate the Endurance.(定位“耐力”号)”最能概括本文主旨。故选 C。

【解析】

【导语】本文是一篇说明文。未来多达 3 亿全职工作岗位可能受到人工智能的影响,以某种方式实现自动化。虽然这可能导致失业,但长远来看,这可以减少劳动力成本、创造新的就业岗位、提高劳动生产率。

【32 题详解】

细节理解题。根据第二段中的“Administrative workers and lawyers are expected to be most affected, the economists said, compared to the ‘little effect’ seen on physically demanding or outdoor occupations, such as construction and repair work.(这些经济学家们表示,与建筑和维修等对体力要求高或户外的工作表现出的‘几乎没有影响’相比,行政工作者和律师预计将受到最大影响。)”可知,行政工作者和律师这些白领员工受到的影响比建筑工作者和维修工作者高,所以结合选项,维修工受到的影响较小。故选 A。

【33 题详解】

细节理解题。根据第五段中的“While workplaces may shift, widespread adoption of AI could ultimately increase labor productivity—and boost global GDP by 7% annually over a 10-year period, according to Goldman Sachs economists.(高盛经济学家表示,虽然工作场所可能会发生变化,但广泛采用 AI 最终可能会提高劳动生产率,并在 10 年内每年将全球 GDP 提高 7%。)”可知,AI 可能会提高劳动生产率。故选 C。

【34 题详解】

推理判断题。根据第六段中的最后一段中的“Although the impact of AI on the labor market is likely to be significant, most jobs and industries are only partially exposed to automation and are thus more likely to be complemented rather than replaced by AI(尽管人工智能对劳动力市场的影响可能很大,但大多数工作和行业只是部分受到自动化的影响,因此更有可能被人工智能补充而不是取代)”由此可推测出,提到美国工人是为了说 AI 的一些好处。故选 A。

【35 题详解】

标题归纳题。文章首段“As many as 300 million full-time jobs around the world could be automated in some way by the newest wave of artificial intelligence that has made platforms like ChatGPT, according to Goldman Sachs economists.(高盛经济学家表示,全球多达 3 亿个全职工作岗位可以通过最新一波的人工智能以某种方式实现自动化,这一波人工智能已经造就了像 ChatGPT 这样的平台。)”点明主旨,

指出人工智能会对全球许多工作产生影响。再结合接下来的内容可知, 高盛经济学家具体讨论了人工智能对工作岗位和劳动生产率的影响。由此可推测出, 本文围绕“人工智能的影响”展开。A 项“人工智能的影响”最适合做文章标题。故选 C。

【解析】

【导语】这是一篇说明文。文章主要介绍了唱歌的好处。

【36 题详解】

上文“From improving your mood to making you healthier, there is scientific evidence that singing is good for your body and your mind.(从改善你的情绪到使你更健康, 有科学证据表明, 唱歌对你的身体和心灵都有好处。)”指出唱歌对我们的身体和心灵都有好处, 空处承接上文, 鼓励人们唱歌, D 项“所以尽情歌唱吧。”符合, 故选 D。

【37 题详解】

上文“Singing can help relieve stress by reducing cortisol(皮质醇), a hormone that is known as the “stress hormone”. It is naturally produced by your body.(唱歌可以通过减少皮质醇来帮助缓解压力, 皮质醇是一种被称为“应激激素”的荷尔蒙。)”这说明皮质醇是一种荷尔蒙, G 项“它是由你的身体自然产生的。”符合, 故选 G。

【38 题详解】

此处是本段小标题, 根据下文“People who sing use deep breathing and control the use of the muscles in their breathing systems. While singing cannot treat lung diseases? anything that helps to strengthen the throat muscles could help people breathe easier.(唱歌的人会深呼吸, 控制呼吸系统中肌肉的使用。而唱歌不能治疗肺部疾病? 任何有助于加强咽喉肌肉的东西都可以帮助人们更容易呼吸。)”可知, 唱歌能改善肺功能, A 项“它可以改善肺功能。”能概括本段内容, 故选 A。

【39 题详解】

上文“If your sleep is interrupted by snoring(打鼾), try singing.(如果你的睡眠被打鼾打断, 试着唱歌。)”指出唱歌能改善打鼾, 空处承接上文, 对此作出解释, F 项“这是因为唱歌可以增强喉部肌肉, 从而减少打鼾。”符合, 故选 F。

【40 题详解】

根据本段标题“It may improve memory.(它可以改善记忆)”可知, 本段主要介绍唱歌可以改善记忆, E 项“患有失忆症的老年人经常能回忆起歌词。”符合, 同时和下文“A study found that besides remembering the lyrics(歌词), singing brought back other memories too.(一项研究发现, 除了记住歌词, 唱歌还能唤起其他记忆。)”是顺承关系, E 项“recall song lyrics”和下文“remembering the lyrics”相呼应, 故选 E。

考查动词词义辨析。句意: 在收银台, 一位白发老人已经开始打包他的货物。A. bag 装进袋子; B. check 检查; C. list 列清单; D. receive 收到。根据上文“At the cash desk, a white-haired man had begun to”可知, 指在收银台打包自己要买的物品。故选 A。

【42 题详解】

考查动词词义辨析。句意: 有时是有很多优惠券顾客, 或者是忘记称水果重量的人。A. fetch 取来; B. slice 切成薄片; C. weigh 称重; D. taste 品尝。根据上文“Sometimes it’s a customer with multiple coupons, or someone who forgot to”主要描述了收银台存在的问题, 即有时是有很多优惠券的顾客, 或者是忘记称水果重量的人。故选 C。

【43 题详解】

考查形容词词义辨析。句意：这个人没有足够的钱。A. adequate 足够的；B. pocket 袖珍的；C. extra 额外的；D. bonus 奖金。根据后文“to keep and which to hand back”可知，老人没有足够的钱买下所有的东西。故选 A。

【44 题详解】

考查名词词义辨析。句意：于是，他开始选择哪些要保留，哪些要归还。A. tools 工具；B. items 物品；C. drinks 饮料；D. snacks 小吃。此处指第一段中“his goods”提到的物品，他开始选择哪些要保留，哪些要归还。故选 B。

【45 题详解】

考查动词词义辨析。句意：是留下来还是放弃。A. buying 买；B. abandoning 放弃；C. selling 卖；D. breaking 打破。根据前文“to keep and which to hand back”可知老人没钱买下所有商品。故选 B。

【46 题详解】

考查副词词义辨析。句意：最终，他选完了。A. fortunately 幸运地；B. unbelievably 难以置信地；C. eventually 最终；D. Generally 普遍地。根据后文“came to an end”可知，整个过程终于结束了。故选 C。

【47 题详解】

考查名词词义辨析。句意：最终，他选完了。A. evaluation 评估；B. selection 选择；C. delay 推迟；D. checkup 检查。根据后文“The man turned back to us as he left”可知，老人终于选完了东西。故选 B。

【48 题详解】

考查形容词词义辨析。句意：那人离开时转身对着我们，尴尬而又抱歉。A. thrilled 激动的；B. anxious 焦虑的；C. embarrassed 尴尬的；D. satisfied 满意的。根据后文“and apologetic”指老人因为耽误了别人的时间尴尬而抱歉。故选 C。

【49 题详解】

考查形容词词义辨析。句意：但我不知道前面那一家三口是多么富有同情心，直到轮到他们。A. helpless 无助的；B. sympathetic 同情的；C. patient 耐心的；D. annoyed 生气的。根据后文提到这家人买下了老人的东西送给老人，可知很有同情心。故选 B。

【50 题详解】

考查形容词词义辨析。句意：这名妇女要求收银员尽快把所有剩下的货物加到她的账单上。A. expensive 昂贵的；B. thrown-away 信口开河的；C. left-behind 被遗忘的，遗留的；D. major 主要的。对应上文“before keeping or abandoning it”指老人丢下的东西。故选 C。

【51 题详解】

考查动词词义辨析。句意：然后，这两个男孩拿着那小包食品从出口冲了出去。A. dashed 猛冲；B. slipped 滑动；C. walked 散步；D. moved 移动。根据上文“goods to her bill as quickly as possible”可知，时间紧急，这两个男孩拿着那小包食品从出口冲了出去。故选 A。

【52 题详解】

考查动词词义辨析。句意：当他们回来时，很明显他们的任务已经完成了。A. accomplished 完成；B. failed 失败；C. postponed 延期；D. started 开始。根据上文“When they returned, it was clear that their mission had been”可知，男孩回来说明东西已经送到了，即任务已经完成了。故选 A。

【53 题详解】

考查动词词义辨析。句意：然后我意识到，要见证这一瞬间的善意，只需要在收银台前多等一会儿。A. reacted 反应；B. considered 考虑；C. memorized 记住；D. realized 意识。根据后文“all it took to witness this flash of kindness was waiting a little longer in a checkout line”可知，我意识到了这个道理，故选 D。

【54 题详解】

考查名词词义辨析。句意：然后我意识到，要见证这一瞬间的善意，只需要在收银台前多等一会儿。A. tenderness 柔软；B. courage 勇气；C. kindness 善良；D. tolerance 忍受。根据上文“Then I realized all it took to witness this flash of”指见证了这一家人的善良。故选 C。

考查介词。句意：在农历正月十五。在具体的某年某月某天应用介词 on。故填 on。

【57 题详解】

考查非谓语动词。句意：根据中国的一些民间习俗，在农历正月十五，在天空高悬的满月的见证下，人们会在晚上点亮各种各样的灯笼来庆祝。分析句子可知，witness(见证)是非谓语动词，与其逻辑主语 people 之间是被动关系，用过去分词表被动。故填 witnessed。

【58 题详解】

考查非谓语动词。句意：这是全家赏月、放鞭炮、猜灯谜、吃元宵、欢度佳节的时刻。It is the time (for sb.) to do... 是固定句型，意为“是(某人)做……的时候了”。故填 to enjoy。

【59 题详解】

考查副词。句意：这是全家赏月、放鞭炮、猜灯谜、吃元宵、欢度佳节的时刻。修饰动词 celebrate，用副词 joyfully 作状语，意为“高兴地，喜悦地”。故填 joyfully。

【60 题详解】

考查冠词。句意：作为一种艺术形式，中国花灯结合了多种技艺、工艺、装饰方法和原材料。a variety of 是固定短语，意为“各种各样的”。故填 a。

【61 题详解】

考查形容词。句意：今天，经济的发展和社会的进步为灯具的设计和创意风格的升级提供了动力。提示词作定语，修饰名词 development，用形容词形式 economic，意为“经济的”。故填 economic。

【62 题详解】

考查名词。句意：今天，经济的发展和社会的进步为灯具的设计和创意风格的升级提供了动力。结合句意和空格前冠词 the 可知，提示词在句中作宾语，用名词 motivation，意为“动力”。故填 motivation。

【63 题详解】

考查连词。句意：无论是纸灯、电灯还是 LED 灯，花灯都见证了时代的变迁。whether...or... 是固定搭配，意为“是……还是……”。故填 or。

【64 题详解】
