The Moon's near side, the one we all see, has been the target of many robotic and human missions. However, its far side, also 36 (call) the dark side because it faces away from the Earth and little 37 (know) about it, has never been explored. That changed on Jan. 2, 2019, when Chinese spacecraft Chang'e 4 made a soft landing on 38 is often referred to as the dark side.
