### Text 10

China's light food sector has witnessed mushrooming development in recent years, serving not only as an icon of a healthy lifestyle, but also a popular way of social networking for young Chinese people. Meanwhile, according to a report released by the Chinese Nutrition Society, 94.9% of the people surveyed consumed light meals at least once a week, and 55.7% enjoyed light food two to four times a week, while the major consumer groups turned out to be ordinary employees and college students. In order to be "slim enough for nice dresses during summer", a young woman named Lu, who works at a financial company in Beijing, frequently goes to several light meal restaurants with her colleagues. "My friends also enjoy having light food, which not only helps them save time but also gives them adequate nutrition," Lu said. To better meet customer demand, canteens in many Chinese universities such as Peking University, Tsinghua University, Sichuan University, Yangzhou University and Yunnan Normal University have also introduced new windows selling light meals.

Zhang Jie, founder and CEO of Huadan Angel Investment, explained that light food, with its low calories, pleasing appearance and healthy concepts, has made its presence felt among young people. He added, "It has now become normal for young people to take photos of light food or drinks, post them on their social network and chat with their friends on this topic."

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
