- 第 21 题 C 细节理解题。根据 Alfie And Me 中由"Carl talks about the remarkable impact the owl Alfie, had on their lives and how their bond led to a fresh perspective on everyday life."可知 Carl 和 Alfie 关系亲近。A 项, on a trip 不对; B 项, 改善 Carl's 的生活条件不对; D 项, just for fun 不对。
- 第 22 题 D 细节理解题 根据 The Strength Of Love 的内容介绍"If you want to tackle the day with assurance, read this book about self-confidence by Kate Garraway."和作者"Kate Garraway"选 D。
- 第23 题 B 细节理解题。根据文章标题"Top recommendations for fans of non-fiction" 选 B。

第 24 题 B 细节理解题。根据文章第 2 段"Without hesitation, he ran down to the waterfront."选 B。

第 25 题 D 推理判断题。根据第 4 段內容可知,落水飞行员站在飞机尾翼上,但是 Gelinne 父子很 难接近他。故得出结论救助过程非常困难。选 D。

第 26 题 C 细节理解题。根据第 4、5 段内容可知, Gelinne 韵儿子参与了救助,故 A 不对:根据"But each time Gelinne tried, the kayak broke through the ice."可知,皮划艇没有坏,但是冰破了,故 B 不对,C 正确;根据"With his son nearby, Gelinne focused on keeping the pilot calm, joking, ...和 The pilot grabbed the kayak's bow."可知飞行员没有精疲力尽, D 不对。选 C。

第 27 题 C 推理判断题。根据全文的描述,可知 Gelinne 是一位乐于助人的老人,而且幽默风趣。全文讲述救人,所以 C 项 helpful 正确,根据第 5 段"With his son nearby... joking, 'Just hang on to the kayak as if you were hugging your wife."可以推断 Gelinne 是个幽默的人。选 C。

- 第 28 题 C 细节理解题。根据题干中的 the brain's response 定位到第二小节。Page 的研究结果表明 体重和性别是影响大脑对人造甜味剂反英的两个重要因素。
- 第 29 题 A 理解段落主旨要义。第四节的首句 Page and her team measured the response to diet soda in three ways.提出了 Page 使用了三种方法来测量大脑对无糖汽水的反应,下面分别介绍了这三种 方法。所以本节介绍了研究方法。
- 第 30 题 B 推理判断题。根据第六节 Susan Swithers 的话: These results are consistent with patterns that we've actually seen in my lab in animal studies (这些 (Page 的)研究结果和我们在实验室动物研 究中实际看到的模式一致)可知 Swithers 认可 Page 的研究。
 - 第 31 题 D 推理判断题。文章介绍了关于无糖汽水的最新研究成果。无糖汽水会



使女性和肥胖消费 者吃的更多,起不到减肥效果。所以文章可能出处是关于健康的杂志。

第 32 题 C 推理判断题。作者在第一节中举关于意大利人的玩笑"Tie an Italian's hands behind his back, and he'll be speechless. (把一个意大利人的手绑在背后,他就不会说话了。)",是为了引 出本文话题: Susan Goldin-Meadow 关于手势的研究。所以此处作者的写作意图是为了说明手 势和对话之间的关系。

第 33 题 D 推理判断题。第三节中关于男女平等的例子是为了说明上文观点: Gestures that accompany speech are a second channel of information. (伴随说话的手势是传递信息的第二渠道。) 所以,例子主要是为了说明有时人们说话是的手势传递了说话人的真实想法,即使他本人并没 有意识到。

第 34 题 B 猜测词义题。Some students who fail at a tricky mathematics problem may gesture in a way that indicates they are on the point of getting it; they should be taught differently from the ones whose gestures suggest that they are entirely at sea. 前半句说有些学生的手势表明他们就要解出 数学题了,后半句是与前半句的对照,有些学生的手势暗示他们还找不到解题的头绪,所以 confused(困惑)正确。

第 35 题 A 定位文章倒数第二段 Goldin-Meadow believes that gesturing could play a larger role in education by addressing the student's needs better.与正数第一段 This is well explained in the book's last section. 可知作者提出了手势的合理运用可以更好的帮助学生们解决问题这一论点,并以此作为书籍最后一部分的理论支撑,即说明了书籍最后一部分分别从教师、父母等角度出发,给出的在教育学生的过程中如何运用手势建议的合理性。

第 36 题 C 上文是关于如何保护心脏、骨骼和皮肤的,而下文都是关于如何保护眼睛,所以应该考 虑选项 A 和 C。下一句话说"有很多方法",与 A 选项内容重复,所以选择 C。

第 37 题 F 上句话说暗色的眼镜未必有保护的作用,所以接下来应该解释暗色眼镜存在的问题。所 以选 F。

第 38 题 G 本节下文讲述的是食用哪些食物可以获得维他命、锌和 omega-3 脂肪酸 G 选项总述了 这些物质与降低眼睛疾病的风险有关联。所以选 G。

第 39 题 E 根据本节段首句 Take a break from screens 可知,下文将介绍长时间看屏幕的害处和如何 缓解跟晴的疲劳。E 选项讲的是佩戴防屏幕蓝光的眼镜并无效果,与上下文相关。所以选 E

第 40 题 B 最后一节提出最后一种防护眼睛的方法: 去找眼科专家治疗。选项 B 的意思是: 所有的 眼睛疾病都是早发现早治疗。所以选 B。

第 41 题 C 根据上文"My childhood was mostly silent.",结合下文提到"her silent world",可推知 作者的家庭虽然与其他家庭一样充满喜怒哀乐,但是这一切都在无声的世界里静静地发生。

第 42 题 A 作者通过观察母亲得以传承她的知识。pass down 使世代相传; bring up 培养,提出; lay down 放下,停止使用; make up 组成,编造,化妆,补偿。

第 43 题 D 由于失聪,母亲用她的双手去展示如何打理菜园,从而传授知识给作者。

第 44 题 D 呼应最后一段中 I now have gardening hands, with cuts and scars, and cherish their 55.

第 45 题 B 上文提到"Sometimes, those same hands spoke to me literally. 有时母亲用她的手和我交流",可推知、母亲使用了手语,此处"sign language"指的是"手语"。

第 46 题 C 根据下文,母亲坚持认为 lip-reading 唇读比手语更好。可推知,手语交流开始得很突然,但是结束得也很快。

第 47 题 B 见 46 题解析。

第 48 题 A 上文提到母亲用唇读交流,因此此处选择"mouth",作动词,意为"(动嘴唇)不出 声地说"。

第 49 题 C 句意: 我们经常会像这样度过几个小时,几乎没有讲一个字,然而我们一直在用各种方式进行交流。

第 50 题 B 句意: 随着我长大, 我开始懂得妈妈为什么喜欢呆在她的菜园里。

第 51 题 C 上文提到"little tolerance for diversity", 再结合下文"demanding and unforgiving", 可 推知当时人们对残疾人的不认同。disapproval 不赞成,反对。

第 52 题 句意: 母亲在自己的菜园里找到了宽容与认同。acceptance 接纳,接受。

第 53 题 D 句意: 相对于苛刻与排斥的外面世界, 母亲觉得她的菜园是她唯一可以掌控的地方。

第54题 B 第一段提到 The knowledge instilled (灌输) in me was 42 by watching my mother as she moved through her silent world. ,可推知,此处在讲母亲传授的知识深深地埋在了作者的心 里。

第 55 题 A 此处回应第二段中的"The hands were rough with cuts and 44, but filled with wisdom." roughness 粗糙,flexibility 灵活,strength 力气,softness 柔软。

- 第 65 题 to hold 本句中考察了形容词 + enough + to do 的结构, 意思是只够容下一个膝盖。




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
