### 听力部分录音稿

(Text 1)

W: Who does the housework in your family?

M: My mother does the most. She cooks, washes the dishes and so on. My father just sweeps the floor. And I do the gardening.

Even though he doesn't talk very much, I think he's the perfect actor for the role. He even does a few of the more dangerous things in the film himself, instead of getting someone else to do them. I did wonder sometimes in the film whether he'd be clever enough to defeat the bad people, but I'm not going to tell you the ending! The actress who stars with Craig gives a fantastic performance, too. I loved all the stylish clothes she wore! The director probably had a hard job making this film as full of action as the earlier ones. But the excitement starts right at the beginning here, with a car crash along a mountain road, and plenty of other thrilling scenes. Unfortunately, I found the story difficult to follow sometimes, and it also seemed to be over very quickly—it lasted under two hours. I also felt there weren't as many jokes as in the old Bond films. And where was all the ridiculous Bond equipment—the underwater car or exploding watch that everyone laughed at? This is a more serious, darker Bond film, but I still really enjoyed it.

21. A 细节理解题。根据 LingQ 部分 "It has a community aspect that rewards you with a backpack for helping your peers(同伴)." 可知,在 LingQ 这个学习项目中帮助同伴的学习者会获得奖励。

22. D 细节理解题。根据 Alison 部分“Stick with a single language or learn several from nine options: Japanese, German, Spanish, French, Chinese, Irish, Arabic, English or Swedish.”及其他三个程序所提供的语言教学种类可知, Alison 提供的语言最少。
23. C 数字计算题。根据 Rosetta Stone 部分“Price: \$7.99 per month”可知, 在 Rosetta Stone 学习十个月需支付 79.9 美元。
24. C 推理判断题。根据第一段“The national bird of Honduras, scarlet macaws(红金刚鹦鹉), which have colorful feathers, groom (理毛) each other as they wait for Anayda Pantin Lopez who has devoted the last 12 years to protecting them.”可推断, 作者在第一段描述了红金刚鹦鹉舒适且安全的生活场景。
25. B 词义猜测题。根据画线词后“At that time, the hunting and sale of wild species was legal and thousands of scarlet macaws disappeared.”可推断, 画线词的意思和 Harmful 最接近。
26. D 细节理解题。根据第四段“However, when Lacuth learned the number of scarlet macaws was sharply decreasing, he decided to become a guardian of them.”可知, Lacuth 改变了自己的行为是为了阻止红金刚鹦鹉的数量减少。
27. A 推理判断题。根据最后一段“Since the project began, the scarlet macaw population has grown from 500 to more than 800. ‘Now we have seen that the number of these birds has increased,’ said Pantin.”可推断, Mabita 项目取得了好的结果。
28. C 细节理解题。根据第三段“‘When we looked at the women and men who consumed the most red meat compared to the least, we found about a 50% increase in risk,’ says study author Dr. Walter Willett of the Harvard T. H. Chan School of Public Health.”可知, 研究者是通过作比较得出结论的。
29. D 细节理解题。根据第四段“It turned out that the participants in the study who consumed high amounts of red meat also had higher body weight.”可知, 吃许多红肉的人可能是肥胖的。
30. A 细节理解题。根据第五段“‘A limit of one serving per week of red meat would be reasonable for people wishing to improve health and well-being,’ Willett says.”可知, Willett 建议一周只吃一次红肉。
31. B 标题判断题。通读全文, 尤其是第一段“People who routinely eat a lot of red meat may be increasing their risk of developing Type 2 diabetes(糖尿病), according to a new study.”可知, 本文主要讲的是吃太多红肉会导致患病风险高。
32. A 细节理解题。根据第二段“The sensor is also soft to the touch, like human skin...”可知, 新传感器的表面摸起来很软。
33. C 段落大意题。根据第三段可推断, 本段主要讲的是新传感器的优势。
34. B 观点态度题。根据第五段“‘Dr. Madden’s lab has significant expertise in flexible sensors and we’re happy to cooperate with this team in developing touch sensors that can be applied to robots,’ said Mr. Ishizaki Ryusuke...”可推断, Ishizaki Ryusuke 对英属哥伦比亚大学团队的态度是“肯定”的。
35. D 推理判断题。根据最后一段“‘... there is a need for robots to be smarter about which sensors to pay attention to and how to respond.’”可推断, 机器人需要进一步的发展。
36. A 此处缺少小标题。根据本段内容, 尤其是“Obviously, fitness is a big benefit.”可知, A 项“强身健体”符合。
37. E 根据空前“‘You learn to play on a team.’”及空后“‘And you learn to be gracious when you win and when you lose.’”可知, E 项“你学会应对挑战和处理困难”符合。
38. G 根据小标题及段落内容可知, G 项“参加团队运动的学生比不参加的学生毕业的可能性更大”符合。
39. F 根据小标题及空前“In team sports, teammates learn to respect each other and encourage everyone to do their best.”可知, F 项“每个人都要学会合作, 因为这对团队来说是最好的”符合。
40. D 根据小标题可知, 本段讲述内容与女性可以在运动中获益有关, 故 D 项“同时, 女性参与运动还有额外的益处”符合。
41. B 来自世界各地的 33 名年龄在 16 岁至 20 岁之间的年轻人聚集在(gathered at)英语口语联盟, 讲述他们的故事, 其中包括来自中国的吴东旭。
42. A 对他来说, 这次活动不仅仅是关于第一印象的演讲(speech), 它也给他留下了深刻的印象。
