
阅读理解

A 篇 本文是一篇应用文。介绍了适合孩子的免费的夏季娱乐活动。

- 21. D 细节理解题。根据第一部分 Portsmouth International Kite Festival 中的内容"Kids can even have a go at building and flying their own masterpiece at workshops dotted around the city."可知,孩子们可以亲自动手体验一些活动。故选 D。
- 22. B 细节理解题。根据第二部分 The Great Big Rhino Trail, South Devon 内容"Print off the route from the website and set off on the trail of these uniquely decorated sculptures. It aims to highlight the threat faced by these magnificent creatures as well as showcase local artists."可知,雕塑家适合去位于 South Devon 的 The Great Big Rhino Trail。故选 B。
- 23. C 细节理解题。根据第三部分内容"And seize a good spot for the Grand Firework Display on Saturday."和第四部分内容"This weekend will also have a funfair and firework display."可知后两个活动都有烟火表演。故选 C。
- B篇 本文是一篇夹叙夹议文。文章讲述了作者的儿子生病,自己和丈夫又是全职,所以感到不堪重负,但作者不愿请求别人帮助, 怕自己成为别人的负担,但和母亲的一次谈话改变了作者的想法,作者告诉我们主动寻求别人帮助可以达到双赢。
- 24. D 推理判断题。根据第一段"My middle child was born and rushed to the newborn intensive care unit (ICU). I was shocked to learn







that he was sick. Suddenly, my life was out of control. My husband and I with two full-time careers were dropping our 2-year-old at day care each morning before racing to visit our son at the hospital."可知,作者的儿子生病了所以作者很震惊,而且作者和丈夫是双职工,必须要照顾新生儿和另一个 2 岁的孩子,作者感觉自己的生活完全失控了,不堪重负,由此可知,作者在儿子出生后的感觉是震惊和不堪重负,D 项"Astonished and overwhelmed."符合。故选 D。

- 25. A 细节理解题。根据第三段作者和母亲的对话"Do you see the person who asks for support as a burden?" I asked my mother."可以得知,作者担心接受别人帮助就意味着自己会成为别人的负担。故选 A。
- 26. D 词句猜测题。根据第四段开头"I felt funny relying on people outside my inner circle. I thought leaning on my closest family and friends would be most comfortable, but they lived an hour or more away"可知,作者更愿意接受来自于"核心圈(inner circle)"的亲朋好友的帮助,但由于他们住得很远,帮不了作者,所以后文提到的"the favors from others"指的是这些帮助作者的人并不是作者的核心圈子的朋友,由此可知,此处"them"代指上句中的"others",即作者核心圈以外的朋友。故选 D。
- 27. C 推理判断题。纵观全文,作者改变想法的转折点来自于母亲的回答——帮助他人本身可以给自己带来快乐,所以寻求他人帮助并不意味着会成为他人的负担。根据第五段的总结"We all wish people could read our minds, know what we need and volunteer it. Actually, they have to understand that we need help, and know what kind you want them to give—that means you really do have to ask. I'm now a pro at asking for help. I don't only rely on my inner circle. I have a large community of resources—which benefits all of us."可知,作者提到自己现在很乐于主动寻求帮助,而且愿意依靠自己核心圈内和圈外的一切朋友,因为寻求帮助可以达到双赢,由此可知,作者想要传达的是寻求帮助可以达到双赢。故选 C。
- C 篇 本文是一篇议论文。人们在选择电子书和印刷书籍的意见上各不相同,文章通过多个角度讨论了电子书和印刷书籍各自的优缺点,并对其未来做出预测。
- 28. C 细节理解题。根据第二段"They are quicker to obtain"、"e-books can be easily and quickly kept up to date"和"It also makes it easier to share this information with families and friends"可知,电子书可以快速地传递信息。故选 C。
- 29. A 推理判断题。根据第三段"futurists have been predicting the development of printed books. The conventional view has been that digital e-books are on the verge of replacing paper books"可知,未来学家认为未来电子书将取代印刷书籍。换而言之,未来学家可能会同意印刷书籍即将消失这个观点。故选 A。
- 30. D 细节理解题。根据倒数第二段"I believe that the online publishing has not taken off because people want real books"可知,在线出版业没有成功的原因是人们对印刷书籍的需求。故选 D。
- 31. D 推理判断题。根据最后一段"the printed book is still very much preferred over its digital cousins"和"People are still very interested in real books and notebooks"可知,印刷书籍仍然比它的数码形式更受青睐且人们仍然对印刷书籍和笔记非常感兴趣。由此可推知,作者认为印刷书籍的未来是有希望的。故选 D。
- D 篇 本文是一篇说明文,讲述了人类对全球变暖的影响。呼吁我们不要打破气候平衡。
- 32. B 细节理解题。根据第二段"things that are dark, like black carbon, absorb the sun's energy and warm up."可知,是因为黑色吸收热量。故选 B。
- 33. A 细节理解题。根据第三段"That's one of the motivations for the study, to quantify the impact of black carbon on regional snow melt, which is important for quantifying the role of black carbon in the global loss of snow and ice."可知,这项研究的目的是测量黑炭对融雪的影响。故选 A。
- 34. C 主旨大意题。根据第四段"But, if it weren't there, in the state that it is meant to be, the balance that we have in the climate system will no longer be,"可知,第四段主要是说明南极现状的影响。故选 C。
- 35. D 细节理解题。根据最后一段"We have to be careful that we don't upset the climate balance."可知,Raphael 建议人们不要打破气候平衡。故选 D。
- 七选五 这是一篇说明文。每个人都害怕失败,我们对失败的恐惧是成功路上最大的绊脚石。文章就如何应对失败提出了几条 建议。
- 36. D 承接句。由下一句的"Here are some tips which can help you get on the positive side of life."可知,作者要给读者提出一些积极应对的建议,与 D 选项"你需要知道如何应对失败"相呼应。故选 D。
- 37. G 细节句。上一句提到"要承诺自己永不放弃。"承接上文,G选项"这个承诺能够帮助你的大脑应对成功或是失败。"与之相呼应。故选 G。

- 38. B 主题句。由本段最后一句"The tenth attempt proves that you have somehow learned from your mistakes"可知,要从之前的失败的尝试中学习,积累经验,B 选项"从错误中学习"切题。故选 B。
- 39. C 过渡句。由上下文中"The worst thing you can do after failing in some project is thinking that it was the only plan you could ever think of.""If Plan A fails, turn to Plan B or Plan C."可知,我们需要做好充足的准备,多准备一些方案以便不时之需。C 选项"总会有其他办法"切题。故选 C。
- 40. F 总结句。由本段中"Keep a positive attitude."和"Always think positive."可知,F 选项"积极性是我们在这个世界上成长立足世界所需要的。"总结本段内容。故选 F。

完形填空 这是一篇记叙文。文章讲述了在 2020 年疫情期间, Rhiannon 创建了 Lasagna Love, 通过送递烤宽面给生活困难的人们提供帮助。

- 41. B 考查动词。根据上下文可知, Rhiannon 想知道她能为那些在困难中挣扎的人们做些什么。
- 42. C 考查动词。根据后文"due to losing their jobs or childcare."可知,是帮助那些在困难中挣扎的人们。
- 43. A 考查动词。根据后文"Cooking is my happy place," she says. She <u>44</u> groceries online and got to work."可知, Rhiannon 没有花 多长时间就决定了做这件事情。
- 44. B 考查动词。根据后文"got to work"可知, Rhiannon 先在网上订购货物, 然后开始工作。
- 45. D 考查动词。根据后文"in a local moms' group on Facebook, offering to __46_ a free home-cooked meal to anyone who wanted one." 可知, Rhiannon 在 Facebook 上的一个当地妈妈群里发帖子,表示愿意给任何需要帮助的人送一份免费的家常便餐。
- 46. A 考查动词短语。根据上文可知,这事发生在疫情期间的事情,烤宽面是运送到家,把食物放下。
- 47. C 考查动词。根据后文"Even more wanted to help them together with Rhiannon."可知,有些人需要一顿饭,更多的人想和 Rhiannon 一道帮助他们。
- 48. D 考查动词。Rhiannon 为每个志愿者制作了一个电子表格,将他们与要求得到食物的家庭进行匹配。
- 49. A 考查名词。根据后文"spread quickly on social media."可知,有关 Rhiannon 事迹的消息很快在社交媒体上传开了。
- 50. C 考查形容词。到夏天为止,他们有了100多个志愿者厨师。
- 51. B 考查动词。根据后文"Someone offered to create an online portal (门户网站) to solve the problem."可知,由于订单太多,Rhiannon 无法跟踪,有人提出创建一个网站来解决。
- 52. D 考查动词。根据前文"This automated system"可知,这个自动系统让 Rhiannon 能够腾出时间做她真正喜欢做的事情:烹饪并联系需要帮助的人。
- 53. A 考查名词。根据前文"For Rhiannon, lasagna is more than just food."可知,对于 Rhiannon 来说,烤宽面不仅仅是食物,随着食物 运送的是一种希望。
- 54. C 考查副词。句意: Lasagna Love 目前在美国,加拿大和澳大利亚已经有25000志愿者了,并且在他们的社区为需要帮助的和家庭运送了150000顿饭。
- 55. B 考查动词。句意同上。

- 59. to share 考查非谓语动词。动词不定式做目的状语。
- 60. further 考查副词。此处应用副词动词 raise the public's awareness of the central axis. 意为:进一步提高公众对中轴线的认识。
- 61. and 考查连词。raise 和 encourage 是两个并列的谓语动词,应用 and 连接。
- 62. stretches 考查动词时态。It 指代 the central axis,在句中作主语,且单数,中轴线从北到南长 7.8 公里,是客观事实。故用一般现在时单三形式。
