- 21. D 细节理解题。根据原文中对 Whippersnapper —词的解释" In its more contemporary version, the word relates to a young person who is too confident and does not show enough respect to older people."可知在如今whippersnapper 指的是过于自信且不尊重老年人的年轻人。故选 D。
- 22. B 细节理解题。根据题干"下列哪一个是因为技术发展变过时的单词"和文中对 **Tape** 一词的解释可知, Tape 一词的过时和技术发展变化息息相关。故选 B。
- 23. A 主题判断题。根据全文内容可知,文章从英语语言发展的角度,列举四个因社会发展而过时的单词,并解释这些单词的定义以及过时的原因,属于语言主题。故选 A。

#### 【主题语境】人与社会。

【语篇解读】本文是一篇记叙文。诺特为数学做出了开拓性的贡献,在那个时代,女性还被排斥在学术界之外,但她坚守数学领域,发表了有关环论的革命性发现,至今数学家们仍在思考和发展她的发现。

#### 【答案解析】

24. B 细节理解题。根据第二段话"She signed up and earned her doctorate in mathematics 可知: Noether"报名并获得了在数学博士学位。故选 B。

25. C 细节理解题。根据第四段话 Bill Nicholl 所说的话"The female brain is unsuitable for mathematical production," he wrote, but Noether stood out as "one of the rare exceptions."可知:"女性的大脑不适合从事数学研究,"他写道,但 Noether 却是"极少的例外之一",Neother 是天生的数学大师人物。故选 C。

26.A 细节理解题。根据第五段话"Mathematicians still use Neother's map today, not just in ring theory, but in other area such as number theory and algebraic geometry"可知,环论在今天依然为数学家所利用。故选 A。

27.C 推理判断题。根据全文内容及第六段话"During those years, she kept doing research and made important contributions to theoretical physics and Einstein's theory of relativity. The university finally granted her lecturer status. Two years later, Neother published revolutionary discoveries in ring theory, which is the study of mathematical objects called rings"可知,Neother 是坚定的且有创意的人。故选 C。

## 【主题语境】人与自然。

【语篇解读】本文是一篇说明文。科学家们开发出一种可诊断阿尔茨海默病的新型血液检测,无需进行昂 贵的脑部影像检查或痛苦的腰椎穿刺(从下背部抽取脑脊液样本)。

28. D 主旨大意题。根据第二段内容可知,目前的医学指南检测三种不同的标志物: 淀粉样蛋白、Tau 蛋白的异常积累,以及神经变性(大脑特定区域神经元细胞的缓慢和渐进性丧失),它们在检测的过程中,可能会出现让患者身体不适,或费用昂贵,或因为仪器不够需要等待很长时间等不足。故选 D。

29. A 细节理解题 根据第三段内容可知,开发可靠的血液测试将是一个重要的进步。"血检更经济、安全、更容易实施,可以提高诊断阿尔茨海默病的临床信心,并为临床试验和疾病监测征选研究对象。"故选 A。 30. B 词义推测题 根据语境和划线单词所在句子可知,下一步研究将在更广泛的患者中验证该血液测试,包括来自不同种族和民族背景的患者,以及那些患有记忆丧失或其他潜在痴呆症状的不同阶段患者。故选 B。

31. C 推理判断题 根据第一段和全文内容可知,科学家们开发出一种可诊断阿尔茨海默病的新型血液检测方法——脑源性 Tau 蛋白的水平与脑脊液中的 Tau 蛋白水平有很大的相关性,能可靠地将阿尔茨海默病与其他神经退行性疾病区分开来。故选 C。

【语篇解读】 本文主要介绍了人工智能对人类的影响。

32. D 推理判断题。文章第二段 As AI increasingly shapes the human experience, how does this change what it means to be human? Central to the problem is a person's capacity to make choices, particularly judgments that have moral implications. 随着人工智能越来越多地影响人类体验,这会如何改变人类的意义呢?这个问题的 核心是一个人做出选择的能力,尤其是具有道德含义的判断。亚里士多德认为,做出实际判断的能力与定期 对习惯和实践做出判断有关。机器作为替代评判者出现在各种日常环境中,我们认为,这对正在自学如何有 效地进行判断的人类构成了潜在威胁。因此引用亚里士多德的观点是为了说明一个观点。

33. B 细节理解题。文章第四段第一句指出,在人们的文化消费中,推荐引擎成为越来越普遍,可能会限 制选择并最大限度地减少运气成分。推荐引擎越来越普遍,与题干中的 increasing application of recommendation engines 语义相同,而推荐引擎具体做的事情就是 may serve to restrict choice and minimize luck(可能会限制选择并最大限度地减少运气成分),推荐引擎限制了选择,也就是消费者会有很有限的选择, 对应选项 A 中的 limited, 因此答案为 B 项。

34. D 推理判断题。最后一段第二句提到随着事情变得越来越可预测,生活在工智能时代的我们会越来越不 像自己了,也就是说人类需要不可预测性,所以人类不再拥有不可预测性就会让我们越来越不像自己,因此答 案为 D。

35. A 主旨大意题。本文主要介绍了人工智能对人类的影响。第1、2段引出文章主旨:人工智能会重塑人类。 第3、4段指出人工智能会影响人们的实际判断能力。第5段指出算法会增加可预测性。第6段指出可预 测性的增加会使人类更加不像自己。故可得出结论:人工智能正在改变人类的意义。故答案为 A。

本文是说明文。文章介绍了水下足球运动的场地及其比赛规则。

- 36. G。设空处前提到, 你是否听说过水下足球, 水下足球被称为世界上最不知名的运动之一, 由此可推 知,设空处应当是给出水下足球的定义,故 G 项内容(它是一项结合足球基本原理和潜水刺激的运动)符 合语境。
- 37. D。设空处前提到, 球只能由完全在水下屏住呼吸的球员持有, 由此可知, 该段在介绍比赛规则, 那 么 D 项内容 (球员浮出水面换气时必须把球传出或放下) 承接上文, 符合语境。 D 项中的 passed or dropped 与设空处前的 possessed 形成对照。
- 38. E。设空处后的内容(当对方球员进入你的领域时,你需要能够迅速识别并采取适当的行动)具体解 释了 E 项内容 (要想踢得好, 你需要具备基本的空间意识和决断力)。
- 39. B。根据设空处后的 team、Just five players 等可知,该段主要介绍与比赛队员相关的信息,故 B 项内 容(水下足球分为两队,每队五名队员)符合语境。
- 40. F。设空处前提到,为了把球嬴回来,或者不让对手控球,你必须在水下使用你所有的力量和能力, 故 F 项内容 (如果你想成为这项令人兴奋的运动的专家, 所有这些技能都需要练习) 承接上文, 符合语境。 完形填空
