The project, called Nemo's Garden, is the brainchild of Sergio Gamberini, a chemical engineer who runs a scuba (水肺) diving business. In 2013, he was chatting with local farmers when he came up with the idea. Several days later, he dived to the bottom of Noli's bay and placed a vase with seeds inside a plastic balloon. After 48 hours, the seeds were coming up and Gamberini decided to scale up the experiment.

Nemo's Garden's key innovation, a sub-water biosphere, is a unique type of underwater greenhouse. It can use the ocean's positive environmental factors, temperature stability, evaporative water generation, CO<sub>2</sub> absorption, the abundance of oxygen, and inherent protection from pests, to create an environment ideal for crop cultivation. The plants are fed by a hydroponic(水耕法) system. Water is generated from salt-water evaporating and then condensing(冷凝), so no additional fresh water source is required. Additional power for lighting, pumps and sensors is provided by wind generators and solar panels situated on the surface. This makes the entire set-up completely eco-friendly and self-sustaining.

Inside the biosphere, it is even more impressive. Each dome has a shelf running the entire circumference on which plants, equipment and tools can be placed. There is oxygen, carbon dioxide and humidity sensors, radio communication, lights, a fresh-water hose and to top it all off, Wi-Fi. You can control everything in the dome via an app on your phone from the surface. You can turn the lights on, check the conditions and even watch a live video stream of the plants growing.

Gianni Fontanesi, Nemo's Garden project manager, has logged nearly a thousand dives to perform underwater farming. He says that being inside the greenhouse is like being in an aquarium turned inside out: "You are the fish looking out into the outside world."

**Get out of your comfort zone.**

38 So, if you're operating the same way every day and finding you're not able to discover your passion, something clearly needs to change! In this case, Spinelli says you'll want to explore areas that may be outside of your comfort zone and include those in your routines—you may just find some new inspiration.

**Reflect on the most meaningful times of your life.**

Another way to identify your passion is to reflect on times in your life that you caught a taste of what passion feels like. Write down the most meaningful experiences you've ever had, including what about them made them so influential. What are the shared themes here that are connected to your passions? 39

You can also do this exercise while particularly focusing on your education and career, thinking about the things you've learned or done professionally that felt meaningful to you.

Along with seeking the guidance of a specialist, you can also seek guidance and inspiration from kindred spirits you value, respect, or admire. Spinelli suggests reaching out to people with similar interests, personalities, and/or anyone you find inspiring. "Take time to speak with them and ask them how they figured out their passion," she suggests.

第三部分 语言运用(共两节, 满分 30 分)

第一节 (共15小题; 每小题1分, 满分15分)

Have you ever heard about Su Yiming? When he was a kid, Su Yiming was an aspiring actor, 41 a part in the 2014 action movie *The Taking of Tiger Mountain*. Su picked up snowboarding when he was just four years old, balancing it with acting until he decided to 42 acting for snowboarding. He really took things up a notch(档次) at the Beijing Winter Olympics.

On February 7, 2022, Su 43 missed out on a gold medal in the slopestyle event(单板滑雪坡面障碍技巧) to Canada's Parrot, eventually claiming 44. However, it would have gone gold if judges had 45. Parrot missed a grab on his first jump—a mistake which would have 46 a points deduction. It was the first of several scoring accidents at snowboarding events in the Beijing Games, spurring an outpouring of 47 from the field.

Despite the 48, Sumatic, head judge for snowboarding, said that he 49 a call after the event from Su and his coach, saying that they “totally 50” the decision made.

Facing the judging drama in such circumstances, Su showed no 51 of being affected, bouncing back to win his own gold in the big air event(单板滑雪大跳台) on February 15. Su started the competition with consecutive 1800s—five spins—first completing the 52 going forward, then backward. He led by 17.5 points entering the 53 heat, and nobody got close in Round 3. Eventually, he won the gold medal by a wide margin.

“I had many dreams when I was a child,” Su said, “To be an Olympic champion was one of them, and today, I have already realized my dream. Snowboarding is not just a competition for me. As a 54, I should not only ride well but should also promote the sport,” he explained, “We have to give everything to pursue our dreams and all those efforts will be 55 one day.”

As the Year of the Dragon is coming, it is necessary to give a clear 65 (interpret) of this term so as to prevent Westerners getting “lost in translation.”
